BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues its six-game road trip this afternoon through Pittsburgh (0-2, 1 to play) and Chicago-AL (3 to play)...The Birds enter play today tied for third place in the AL East, trailing the Yankees (7-1) and Blue Jays (4-4).

⚾ **Shane Baz** did not factor into the decision yesterday after tossing 5.2 innings, allowing one unearned run on three hits and three walks with five strikeouts...He has not allowed a home run in 39.1 consecutive innings dating to August 26, 2025, the longest active streak among all MLB starters ahead of CIN's Graham Ashcraft (39.0 IP).

⚾ Today, the Birds look to avoid their first three-game losing streak to the Pirates since the clubs first met in the regular season in 2005...Baltimore has dropped four straight and seven of its last eight in Pittsburgh since May 21, 2014, with the lone victory during that stretch coming on April 5, 2024.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, the Orioles recalled **Cade Povich** from Triple-A Norfolk and placed **Yaramil Hiraldo** (right shoulder inflammation) on the 15-day Injured List, retroactive to April 2.

NIP AND TUCK: Each of the last seven matchups between the Orioles and Pirates have been decided by one run since April 6, 2024, with Pittsburgh holding a 4-3 advantage in those contests...Neither team has scored more than five runs in any of the seven games.

⚾ The seven-straight one-run games mark the most consecutive such contests against a single opponent in O's team history (since 1954), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The Birds played six straight one-run affairs against the Angels from August 9, 1997-April 20, 1998 and six straight against the White Sox from June 7-August 17, 1973.

⚾ The last two MLB clubs to play seven consecutive one-run games against one another were the Rays and Twins from September 12, 2023-September 3, 2024.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP: **Chris Bassitt** is 4-1 with a 2.27 ERA (9 ER/35.2 IP) in six career starts opposite the Pirates, having thrown 5.0+ innings in each of those outings.

⚾ He has limited **Oneil Cruz** to a 2-for-9 (.222) clip with five strikeouts while holding **Marcell Ozuna** hitless in five at-bats with two strikeouts.

⚾ Others Pirates have found greater success, including **Brandon Lowe** (.550, 11-for-20, 4 HR), **Ryan O'Hearn** (.533, 8-for-15, 1 HR), and **Bryan Reynolds** (.357, 5-for-14).

⚾ Bassitt has allowed 4+ career home runs to two hitters, the aforementioned **Lowe** and **HOU's Yordan Alvarez** (5 HR).

WALKING IT OUT: The O's have drawn 5+ walks in each of their last three games, matching their longest streak of the 2025 season from September 2-5...The Birds last drew 5+ walks in four straight games from June 12-16, 2009 (also 4 G).

⚾ Baltimore has drawn 5+ walks in five of its eight contests, tied for the second-most such games in the majors behind Houston (6 G).

⚾ **Leody Taveras** has four walks in 10 plate appearances this season.

IN A PINCH: Oriole relievers have yet to allow an inherited runner to score (0-for-11), one of three clubs in the majors to accomplish the feat along with the Guardians (0-for-12) and Royals (0-for-8).

⚾ **Rico Garcia** has stranded each of his four inherited runners, while **Yennier Cano** has stranded each of his three.

TRENDING UP: **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first seven games to open the season, slashing .333/.440/.524 (7-for-21) with four doubles, two runs, two RBI, and four walks against two strikeouts...The four doubles are tied for third most in the majors, trailing **HOU's Christian Walker** (6) and **ATL's Matt Olson** (5).

⚾ After going 0-for-8 with one hit-by-pitch, one steal, and five strikeouts in his first two games, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .320/.414/.640 (8-for-25) with two doubles, two home runs, five runs, six RBI, and four walks over his last six contests.

TWO-OUT TENDENCIES: Baltimore hitters have registered an .849 OPS with two outs, the third-highest mark in the AL behind Houston (.923) and Texas (.876).

⚾ **Taylor Ward** is 5-for-8 with two doubles, three RBI, two walks, and zero strikeouts with two outs, while **Adley Rutschman** is 4-for-9 with three doubles, one RBI, two walks, and zero strikeouts.

ODDS AND ENDS: **Adley Rutschman's** 92.9 percent contact rate is fourth highest in MLB (min. 15 PA), trailing CIN's **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (95.2%), CIN's **Dane Myers** (94.7%), and CLE's **Steven Kwan** (93.8%).

⚾ **Taylor Ward's** 11.3 percent chase rate is second lowest in the majors (min. 15 PA) behind CHC's **Alex Bregman** (9.6%), while his 31.3 percent swing rate is tied with **Bregman** for second lowest behind BOS' **Masataka Yoshida** (27.4%).

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: Entering play today, the Birds are one of three teams in MLB that have yet to face a left-handed starting pitcher, joining the Guardians and Tigers.

WELCOME TO BIRDLAND: Eight players on the Opening Day roster have made their O's debut: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...**Nunez** made his major league debut on March 28.

⚾ **Alonso**, **Bassitt**, **Helsley**, and **Taveras** signed as free agents, **Alexander** (AZ), **Baz** (TB), and **Ward** (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while **Nunez** (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

AHOY! The Birds and Pirates conclude their lone series of the 2026 campaign this afternoon... Baltimore swept the three-game set last season at Camden Yards from September 9-11.

⚾ All three matchups between the clubs in 2025 were decided by one run, with the first two contests ending in extra-innings...On September 9, **Samuel Basallo's** RBI-single in the 11th secured a 3-2 Baltimore win...The following night, **Dylan Beavers'** RBI-single in the 10th clinched a 2-1 win.

⚾ Pirates SVP, Assistant General Manager **Sarah Gelles** began her career as an intern in the baseball operations department with the Baltimore Orioles in 2011 and worked with the organization until 2018.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his second start as an Oriole today in the series finale at Pittsburgh after the 11-year veteran signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026...The O's mark Bassitt's fifth team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...Entering the 2026 campaign, he is one of seven major league pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Bassitt took the loss in his first start as an Oriole on March 30 vs. Texas after allowing four runs on six hits, four walks, and one hit batter with three strikeouts in 4.1 innings...Threw 100 pitches (61 strikes), which marked the third time in his career throwing at least 100 pitches in his first start of a season (106 P, 2025; 106 P, 2014)...Bassitt has pitched fewer than 5.0 innings in two consecutive starts dating to his last outing of 2025 (9/18 at TB) for the first time since September 17-23, 2024.

⚡ His 4.1 innings marked his second-shortest outing eclipsing 100+ pitches, following a start on June 15, 2018 vs. Los Angeles-AL (102 P, 4.0 IP).

CITY OF BRIDGES: Bassitt is set to make his seventh career start today against Pittsburgh, going 4-1 with a 2.27 ERA (9 ER/35.2 IP)...He won four consecutive decisions vs. the Pirates from September 7, 2022 to June 2, 2024, but suffered the loss in his last game at PNC Park on August 20, 2025, despite tossing 5.2 innings of two-run ball.

⚡ Bassitt's 2.27 ERA against Pittsburgh is his second-lowest mark vs. any National League opponent (min. 5 GS) behind Philadelphia (2.18).

⚡ Over 46 career starts against Interleague foes, Bassitt is 21-10 with a 3.01 ERA (90 ER/269.0 IP)...His 21 Interleague wins since debuting in 2014 are tied for the ninth most in the majors, trailing leader Clayton Kershaw (27).

2025 RECAP: Bassitt went 11-9 with a 3.96 ERA (75 ER/170.1 IP) on 174 hits (22 HR), 52 walks, 13 hit batters, and 166 strikeouts across 32 appearances (31 GS) with the Blue Jays in 2025...That included an 8-0 record at home, where he held a 2.71 ERA (28 ER/93.0 IP) in 16 home starts with Toronto.

⚡ Limited opponents to a .172 (17-for-99) mark on his curveball last season, the sixth-lowest mark in MLB (min. 90 AB) behind CLE's Gavin Williams (.116), STL's Phil Maton (.136), CLE's Slade Cecconi (.141), MIA's Edward Cabrera (.142), and KC's Noah Cameron (.153).

⚡ Made seven relief appearances during the Postseason, posting a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) and striking out 10 batters...Permitted one run across 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts in five World Series appearances.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Bassitt is 41-33 with a 4.37 ERA (291 ER/598.2 IP) over 116 career away games (108 GS)...He's currently on a five-decision losing streak on the road dating back to last season, which is one loss shy of his career high (6, 7/25/15-6/22/18 [G2]).

⚡ Bassitt went 3-9 with a 5.47 ERA (47 ER/77.1 IP) on the road in 2025 compared to his 8-0 mark at home, where he held a 2.71 ERA (28 ER/93.0 IP).

IN GOOD COMPANY: Bassitt spent only three seasons (2023-25) with Toronto but still etched his name into the history books...He threw at least 6.0 scoreless innings over nine starts in 2023, tying Roger Clemens (1997) for Toronto's single-season franchise record...That same season on May 22, 2023, at Tampa Bay, he had his career-best 28.0 scoreless inning streak come to an end, which was the second-longest single-season run in Blue Jays history (Clemens, 33.0 IP, 8/15-9/5/98) and the third longest overall (Dave Stieb, 34.0 IP, 9/13/88-4/5/89).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft...Acquired by Oakland on December 9, 2014, and spent six seasons with the club (2015-21)...Earned his first All-Star Game selection in 2021 with Oakland and received two fifth-place votes in AL Cy Young balloting...Led the AL with 16 wins during the 2023 season with Toronto, going 16-8 with a 3.60 ERA (80 ER/200.0 IP).
