CARDIAC CARDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and San Francisco Giants wrap up a three-game series tonight at Oracle Park ... Last night's wild 9-8 Cardinals win was the team's 39th comeback victory (T-6th in MLB) and their 2nd this season of erasing a season-high five-run deficit (also June 28 at Cleveland) ... After tomorrow's off-day, St. Louis finishes the regular season with a three-game weekend series with the division-rival Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field ... Tonight marks the team's first getaway night game in San Fran since July 2021 (also flew to Chicago to face the Cubs).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters tonight in 4th place in the NL Central and 3.5 games back of the third and final Wild Card spot ... St. Louis needs to win all four remaining games to finish with a winning record and remain in postseason contention ... Any combination of a Cardinals loss or Mets win this season will eliminate St. Louis from the postseason.

SO YOU'RE TELLING ME THERE'S A CHANCE: Including MLB seasons consisting of 150+ games, the three-lowest win totals of postseason teams are the 1973 Mets (82-79, .509), 2005 Padres (82-80, .506), and 2006 World Series Champion Cardinals (83-78, .516).

SAN FRANCISCO SWEEPSTAKES: With a win tonight, the Cardinals would earn their 7th series sweep of the season and first of the Giants since June 20-23, 2024 at Alabama's Rickwood Field (1g) and Busch Stadium (2g).

• Their last three-game series sweep IN SAN FRANCISCO was **June 17-19, 1991** at Candlestick Park when **Willie McGee** played his first season for the Giants ... **Lee Smith** closed out all three one-run Redbirds wins.

• The last time St. Louis swept ANY SERIES IN SAN FRANCISCO was a four-game set from **Sept. 9-12, 1993** at Candlestick Park when McGee was teammates with **Barry Bonds**, **Will Clark**, and **Matt Williams** on the 103-win Giants.

• St. Louis has won nine of its last 11 games vs. the Giants, and five of its last six at Oracle Park.

IVAN THE CHEERABLE: **Iván Herrera** has homered in three-straight games and blasted eight of his 19 homers in September ... Ivan's eight September homers share the MLB monthly lead with **Shohei Ohtani** and **Cal Raleigh**, and are the most by a Cardinal since **Tyler O'Neill** (11), **Paul Goldschmidt** (9) and **Nolan Arenado** (8) in Sept. 2021.

• Herrera is the first Cardinal with 8+ homers in any calendar month since Arenado (9), Goldschmidt (9) and **Albert Pujols** (8) each did so in August 2022.

• The last Cardinal to homer in four straight games was Arenado (five in a row) from May 12-16, 2023.

GRAY'S ORACLE ODYSSEY: Thirty-five year-old **Sonny Gray** makes his first career start at Oracle Park tonight in his 330th career start (340th appearance), most starts by a pitcher in the Cardinals organization before a regular season pitching debut at a specific venue since **Adam Wainwright** at Fenway Park (June 17, 2022) at 370 games (excluding Game 1 of the 2013 World Series) and 345 starts before starting at Progressive Field (July 27, 2021). - *Elias Sports Bureau*

• With six strikeouts tonight, Gray would accomplish consecutive 200 strikeout seasons for the first of his career while becoming just the 4th Cardinal in the Live Ball Era (1920-present) with back-to-back 200+ strikeout seasons with **Bob Gibson** (1962-66, 68-70), **José DeLeón** (1988-89) and **Adam Wainwright** (2009-10).

DONNIE DOUBLES: **Brendan Donovan** tied an MLB record with four doubles last night, joining 1B **Matt Carpenter** (2018) and LF **Joe Medwick** (1937) as the 3rd Cardinal to do so ... Donnie also was just the 8th MLB second baseman to do so and only Cardinal.

CORNERSTONES: **Nolan Arenado** plays his 660th game at third base tonight for St. Louis, passing Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** (2002-07) for 8th all-time in franchise history ... **Milt Stock** (1919-23) ranks 7th with 661 games.

TEXAS LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP: The Springfield Cardinals look to capture its 2nd overall Texas League (AA) championship (also 2012) when it plays the deciding Game 3 of the best-of-three series against the Midland Rockhounds (Athletics) tonight at Momentum Bank Ballpark ... Springfield erased a 3-0 deficit last night, scoring four unanswered runs for a 4-3 come-from-behind victory in Game 2 to even up the series...LHP **Brycen Mautz** makes the final start for the S-Cards at 6:30 p.m. tonight.

SAN FRANCISCO CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado's brother, **Jonah Arenado**, was selected by San Francisco in the 16th round of 2013 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons (2013-19) in the Giants organization.

Nolan Arenado, **Nathan Church**, and **Matt Chapman** are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Daniel Descalso was born in Redwood City and resides in Danville, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at UC-Davis (2005-07).

Cardenales broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played parts of four seasons with the Giants (2007-10).

Andrew Knizner played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2019-23)...selected in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Willie McGee** played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...resides in Hercules...worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

Cardinals Major League Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** is a native of Santa Rosa, Calif., who also worked for the Oakland Athletics.

Joey Lucchesi pitched two seasons at Southeast Missouri State (2015-16).

Duane Kuiper is a graduate of Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Ill.

Athletic writer **Katie Woo** is a native of Vacaville, Calif...previously covered the Giants, 49ers, & Warriors for NBC Sports Bay Area & California.

Cardinals Bullpen Coach **Julio Rangel** was the Giants Minor League Pitching Coordinator in 2018.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** made his MLB debut at San Francisco (April 7, 1984).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his 32nd start of the season and 60th career start for St. Louis.
- Making his first career start at Oracle Park in his 330th career start and 340th appearance. Most starts by a pitcher in the Cardinals organization before pitching a regular season game since Adam Wainwright at Fenway Park on June 17, 2022 at 370 games (started Game 1 of the 2013 World Series) and 345 games before starting at Progressive Field (7/27/2021). Clayton Kershaw holds the active pitcher record at 447 games before starting at Oriole Park on Sept. 7 of this season. - *Elias Sports Bureau*
- A win today would give him 15, a new single-season high, surpassing the 14 he had in 2014 & 2015 with Oakland.
- With six strikeouts, would accomplish consecutive 200 strikeout seasons for the first of his career. Also would become just the 4th Cardinal in the Live Ball Era (1920-present) with back-to-back 200+ strikeout seasons, joining **Bob Gibson** (1962-66, 68-70), **José DeLeón** (1988-89) and **Adam Wainwright** (2009-10).
- **Boasts the highest strikeout percentage on the Sweeper (51.0) in the National League, trailing only Garrett Crochet (51.5) of Boston. --Min. 100 batters faced**
- Marks his 5th season with 30 or more starts and first since 2023 with Minnesota.
- Ranks T-107th in career strikeouts at 1,918 with Hideo Nomo (1995-2008); Tom Gordon (1988-2009) ranks 106th with 1,928.
- Is the first Cardinal with back-to-back 10-win seasons since **Adam Wainwright** (2021-22).
- **The Cardinals are 21-10 in Gray's 31 starts this season. Tied for 4th for most team wins for any starting pitcher.**
- **St. Louis was 15-5 in his 20 home starts this season, most wins by a home team record for any starting pitcher in MLB this season** (Chris Bassitt (TOR) is 2nd with 13). Cardinals record is 16 in Matt Morris starts from 2001.
- Sonny's 19 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-25) is tied the most in MLB with Tarik Skubal (19).
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks T-28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in MLB-leading 23-of-30 starts this season; St. Louis is 16-7 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 6th-most in MLB. Tigers LHP Tarik Skubal (12) leads the list.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (268 K). **Kyle Lohse** ranks 9th with 297 strikeouts.
- 24 of his 178 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **39 of his 90 runs (43.3%) allowed this season have come via home run.**
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (397, 5th) and wins (27, T-5th).
- St. Louis is 38-21 (.644) in his 59 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 27-17 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, Sept. 19 vs. Milwaukee): Made consecutive starts vs. MIL and scattered nine hits over 6.0 innings allowing just a solo home run to Sal Frelick in a Cardinals 7-1 win at Busch Stadium. Tied his single-season high with 14 wins.

2025:

- Became the 9th-active pitcher with 1,900 career innings. Ranks 7th among active pitchers with 329 starts.
- Became 1-of-30 pitchers with 5 seasons with 30 or more starts since 2014 joining teammate Miles Mikolas and retired Cardinal Adam Wainwright.
- Has two starts holding the opposition to one hit this season (8/4 at LAD 7.0 IP & 6/27 at CLE 9.0 IP).
- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.

- *Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug. 22, 2022.*
- *Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone's** perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.*

GRAY vs. SAN FRANCISCO

- Making his first career start at Oracle Park in his 330th career start. Longest active streak in MLB. Longest since Clayton Kershaw went 447 in his career before starting at Oriole Park at Camden Yards on Sept. 7.
- Is 4-1 with a 3.18 ERA in eight career starts against the Giants. Won both starts vs. SF with St. Louis (2-0, 2.92 ERA, 12.1 IP, 14 K).
- Holds a .184 opponent BA vs. the Giants, 2nd-best among actives (Snell .170) and 5th all-time. *min.* 7 GS
- Has never allowed more than three earned runs in any of his eight career starts vs. SF.
- Tossed 5.1 innings allowing three runs on two hits with a season-high four walks in his last start vs. SF (Sept. 7).
- Pitched 7.0 innings allowing just one hit with eight strikeouts. His second career one-hit start vs. SF (8/27/22 - 5.0 IP w/MIN).
