THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 10
1962 - **SS Dan Buddin** hits the first grand slam in Astros franchise history in a 9-7 Colts loss to the Dodgers in Game 2 of a doubleheader at Colt Stadium...Buddin hit only two homers in his Astros tenure, which lasted just the 1962 season.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros continue a six-game road trip with the final game of a three-game series against the Los Angeles Angels tonight at Angel Stadium...**RHP Peter Lambert** will be on the mound for the Astros, opposite **LHP Reid Detmers** and the Halos...the Astros have won 11 of their last 18 games.

DRIVING THE LAMBO: Tonight's Astros starter **RHP Peter Lambert** has been solid in his nine starts for the Astros, going 5-4 with a 3.55 ERA (19ER/45.1IP) with 47 strikeouts and a .212 opponent average...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in three appearances) before being called up to join the rotation on April 17.

ROAD TRIP: Tonight is the third game of six game road trip for the Astros...the Astros are facing the Angels for a three-game series before traveling to Kansas City to face the Royals for another three-game series...the Astros are 15-19 on the road this season and went 7-3 on their last road trip.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has recorded a 2.61 ERA (24ER/82.2IP) with 81 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .167 opponent batting average... among AL teams since May 15, the Astros bullpen ranks first in opponent batting average, first in WHIP and first in ERA...the Astros are also 14-10 during since May 15.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME The Astros were defeated by the Angels, 10-1 last night at Angel Stadium... **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (4.0 IP, 7 H, 7 R, 5 ER, 3 BB, 5 K) made the start for the Astros...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x2, BB), **PH-2B Brice Matthews** (1x1, RBI), **1B Collin Price** (1x2, R) and **CF Jake Meyers** (1x4) contributed offensively.

ASTROS TV: Tonight's game will be televised locally by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas** and **Geoff Blum** on the call...also, **Lauren Callendar** will fill-in for **Julia Morales** for the entire road trip.

VOTING COMMENCES: MLB launched the 2026 Konami eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot last week... the Astros on the ballot: **1B Christian Walker**, **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Isaac Paredes**, **SS Jeremy Peña**, **C Yainer Diaz**, **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **OF Brice Matthews**, **OF Jake Meyers** and **OF Cam Smith**.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros are tied for the fewest errors in the AL (28) with the Athletics... Houston has posted the best fielding percentage (.988) in the AL, topping the Athletics (.988) by a few percentage points.

VS. THE HALOS: The Astros and Angels are facing each other for the second time this season...the last time was on Opening Weekend at Daikin Park, where the two teams split the four-game series... the Astros went 8-5 against the Angels last season, including a 4-2 record at Angel Stadium...the Astros own a 141-91 all-time record against the Angels, including a 67-47 record at Angel Stadium.

TRADE WINDS: Earlier today, the Astros acquired minor league **IF Raynel Delgado** from Tampa Bay in exchange for cash considerations...Delgado batted .250 (56x224) with three home runs, 33 RBI and a .682 OPS in 61 games at Triple A Durham this season...he will report to Triple A Sugar Land.

ON THE LEADERBOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in OPS (1.074), SLG (.642) and total bases (156) and leads the AL in home runs (22)...also in the AL, he ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (25), second in RBI (48), second in OBP (.432), second in hits (77), second in batting average (.317), fourth in walks (46) and fifth in runs (46).

ON THE MEND: **C Yainer Diaz** and **RHP Cristian Javier** each made a rehab appearance with Triple A Sugar Land last night...Diaz went 1x3 with a run scored and caught six innings...Javier struck out three in three scoreless innings (44 total pitches, 29 strikes)...**RHP Hunter Brown** will also continue his rehab assignment with Triple A Sugar Land tonight.

ON BASE MACHINE: **OF Yordan Alvarez** is on a 17-game on-base streak...during the streak, he's batting .362 (21x58) with 16 runs, two doubles, seven home runs, 17 RBI, 15 walks and a 1.252OPS...it is his second-longest on-base streak this season, behind a 22-game on-base streak from April 4-28.

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: On Monday, **OF Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Week for the week of June 1-7...for the week, he batted .476 (10x21) with six runs, one double, two HR, nine RBI, five walks and a 1.386 OPS...marked his second AL Player of the Week award this season, also won for the week March 30-April 5.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** ranks tied for second in the AL in RBI with teammate **DH Yordan Alvarez** (48)...Walker also ranks tied for sixth in the AL in total bases (125), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (29), tied for sixth in total bases (125), tied for seventh in home runs (16) and 13th in SLG (.494)...in the field, Walker has not committed an error in 67 games.

MOVIN' ON UP: **RHP Bryan Abreu** (342g) is one appearance shy of surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342g) for the sixth-most relief appearances in Astros history...Abreu is also six appearances shy of tying **LHP Joe Sambito** (348) for the fifth-most relief appearances in franchise history.

HIT PAREDES: **IF Isaac Paredes** is one double away from recording his 100th career double...is looking to become just the 4th Mexican-born player in MLB history with 500 career hits, 100 doubles and 100 home runs, joining **IF Vinny Castilla**, **IF Jorge Orta** and **IF Aurelio Rodriguez**.

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** hit his 192nd career regular season home run on Saturday, which moved him into sixth in Astros history in home runs, surpassing **3B Alex Bregman**.

LAST START - JUNE 5 vs. ATH: Spun 5.1 innings of 1-run ball, allowing 5 hits and 4 walks with 4 strikeouts last Friday vs. the Athletics...shutout the Athletics across 5.0 innings before allowing the only A's run of the game on a solo home run with one out...after a walk and a double, his night ended...tossed 94 pitches (57 strikes)...has worked 5.0+ innings in 6 consecutive starts, which matches his career-long streak from Aug. 12-Sept. 10, 2023.

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has been a stabilizer in the Astros rotation amid a flurry of injuries...has recorded a quality start in 3 of his 9 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 4 of his 9 starts...among AL pitchers with 50.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks 12th in opponent batting average (.200)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .154 average on the pitch (4x26), including just 2 XBH (2 doubles)...his .154 opponent average vs. his slider is the T-10th-lowest in the AL (min. 25 PA)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Notched the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory...matched his career high with 7.0 innings, which he's now accomplished 4 times (last on May 11 vs. SEA).

SWING & A MISS: Made his Astros debut on April 17 vs. STL...opened eyes by inducing 23 whiffs by Cardinals hitters...that total ties as the 4th-highest by an AL pitcher in 2026.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/8 vs. LAA): Worked the 10th inning last night and picked up the save after allowing 1 hit with 1 strikeout...marked his 4th save of the season and is 4-for-4 in save opportunities...tossed only 8 pitches in the outing...also pitched on Sunday vs. ATH (0ER/1IP, 9 pitches).

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-0 with 3 saves and a 2.77 ERA (4ER/13IP) in his last 14 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

VS. LAA: In 36 career regular season games against the Angels, owns 1-1 record with a 4.46 ERA (18ER/36.1IP), 19 walks and 46 strikeouts...has averaged an 11.39 K/9...are his most career appearances against any single opponent...since 2019, leads all active MLB pitchers in appearances vs. the Angels.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Made his 342nd career appearance last night, which tied him with **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...the two now directly trail **LHP Joe Sambito** (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (479) and 10th in innings pitched (352.0).

CAREER: In 342 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.91 ERA (114ER/352IP) with 479 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.25 K/9 and a 0.77 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 3rd in appearances among AL relievers.
