THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
AUG. 3
2019 - Four Astros combine to toss the 12th no-hitter in club history in a 9-0 shellacking of the Mariners... RHP Aaron Sanchez tosses the first 6.0 frames before consecutive scoreless innings by RHP Will Harris , RHP Joe Biagini and RHP Chris Devenski ... C Martín Maldonado was behind the plate for the combined no-no...the no-hitter might have been the most improbable in club history, with Sanchez, Biagini and Maldonado all joining the club just four days prior, at the trading deadline on July 31, 2019.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros, winners of six straight, will open a three-game series with the Blue Jays tonight at Daikin Park...**RHP Cristian Javier** (1-1) will get the start for the Astros opposite the **RHP Shane Bieber** (2-2) and the Blue Jays.

ABOUT JAVIER: **RHP Cristian Javier** is making his fifth start of the season and his second since returning from the IL in early July...he's primarily pitched out of the bullpen since his return, making four relief appearances and a spot start...Javier earned tonight's start thanks to his last outing on July 27 at LAA, when he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts in relief.

WINNING WAYS: The Astros have won six straight games, which is their longest winning streak since they won eight straight from Aug. 6-14, 2024...the Astros have also won 11 of their last 12 games...the Astros are now three games over .500, their first time at that mark since being 6-3 following their ninth game of the season on April 4.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 38-24 since May 22, which ties as the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise this series in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2...**Enrique Vasquez** and **Gene Flores** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast this series.

AYA IN ACTION: The Astros Youth Academy had two teams qualify for the Nike RBI World Series, which will be played in Vero Beach, FL, beginning this week...the Astros Junior Baseball Team is seeking its first Nike RBI World Series Championship, while the Astros Softball Team is seeking its sixth Nike RBI World Series Championship.

MINOR LEAGUE HONORS: **RHP Bryce Mayer**, the Astros top pitching prospect, was named the Double A Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of July 27-Aug. 2...Mayer made one start last week, tossing 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts, while allowing three hits and no walks in the Hooks 7-0 win over Frisco on Saturday.

SUNDAY, FUNDAY: The surging Astros completed a three-game sweep of the Rangers yesterday with a 7-3 win...**LF Yordan Alvarez** (4x5, 2RBI) had a huge day, tying career highs in hits and doubles (3), but **RF Cam Smith** (3x5, RBI) was the hero, as he knocked in the go-ahead run in the 7th...**RHP Peter Lambert** (2ER/5.2IP) had a solid start, and **RHP AJ Blubaugh** (0ER/1.1IP) earned his first career save.

SILVER BOOT SECURED: The Astros finished their season series with a 9-4 record against the Rangers, securing them the 2026 Silver Boot...the Astros have now won the Silver Boot in 10 consecutive seasons (every year since 2017), during which the Astros have gone 102-55 vs. the Rangers.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Astros rank second in the AL in home runs (155) and third in runs scored (528), just behind the Twins (532) and White Sox (531)...also among AL clubs, the Astros rank first in slugging (.418) and in OPS (.739), and second in batting average (.245), OBP (.321) and hits (936).

JULY HONORS: Earlier today, **DH Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Month for July...this marks the fourth career AL Player of the Month Award for Alvarez and his second this season...in July, Alvarez hit .360 (31x86) with nine HR, 22 RBI, a .467 OBP, a .721 SLG, and a 1.188 OPS in 23 games.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** is a strong AL MVP candidate as he leads the league in all three Triple Crown categories, ranking first in batting average (.330), HR (35), and RBI (84)...additionally, he currently leads MLB in OPS (1.092), OBP (.442), SLG (.650), extra-base hits (59), and TB (262), and in the AL, he ranks first in hits (133), and runs (77), and third in walks (77)...AL leaders below:

HEAVY TRAFFIC: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has reached base safely in 18 straight games (since July 10), batting .438 (28x64) with 15 runs, eight doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI, 18 walks, a .566 OBP and a 1.410 OPS during the streak...Alvarez also has on-base streaks of 25 games (May 22-June 19) and 22 games (April 4-28) this season.

GOOD INTENTIONS: **DH Yordan Alvarez** was walked twice intentionally on Saturday vs. TEX, giving him an MLB-leading 22 intentional walks on the season...Alvarez's 22 intentional walks ties as the third-highest total in a single season by an Astros player in club history, along with **Lance Berkman**, who was walked intentionally 22 times in 2006.

STREAKING: **SS Jeremy Peña** is on a 14-game hitting streak, in which he's hit .433 (26x60) with three doubles, one triple, seven homers, 14 RBI and a 1.336 OPS during the streak...Peña's streak matches his career high (also, April 8-23, 2025), and is the longest active streak in the Majors.

LOAD 'EM FOR LAMONTE: **OF LaMonte Wade** has reached safely in all six of his plate appearances with the bases loaded this season, going 4x4 with one double, one homer, 10 RBI and two walks with the bases juiced...with RISP, Wade is hitting .412 (7x17) with a .500 OBP this season.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader**, who is 15-for-15 in save chances with a 1.17 ERA, recorded his 77th career save as an Astro on Saturday, moving him past **RHP Fred Gladding** (76) for fifth place in saves all-time among Astros relievers...he now trails **RHP Ryan Pressly** (111) for fourth on that all-time list.

STALKING 500: **RHP Bryan Abreu** has 499 career strikeouts, needing just one strikeout to reach 500 for his career...he would become just the fourth reliever in franchise history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining **LHP Billy Wagner** (694), **RHP Brad Lidge** (557) and **RHP Dave Smith** (529).

LAST APPEARANCE, JULY 27 at LAA: Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings of relief last Monday night at LAA, striking out 7 batters while allowing 3 hits, to earn his first win of the season...struck out a season-high 7 hitters...tossed at least 5.0 scoreless innings for the 1st time since he tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on Aug. 29, 2025 vs. LAA...the last Astros reliever to toss at least 5.0 innings in a game was **LHP Colton Gordon** (5.0 IP) on Sept. 28, 2025 at LAA.

REPTIL BACK IN THE ROTATION: Has bounced between the rotation and the bullpen since being reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3...tonight will mark his 2nd start since returning from the IL...has spent the majority of his time since being reinstated in the bullpen, posting a 1.00 ERA (1ER/9IP) with 13 strikeouts and a .206 opponent batting average through 4 relief appearances...made a spot start on July 12 at TEX and worked 3.0 innings while allowing 3 runs on 4 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts.

AS A STARTER: Began the season as the Astros' No. 3 starter and made 3 turns in the rotation before being placed on the IL with his right shoulder strain...has worked predominantly as a starter since the 2022 season, making 75 of his 84 total appearances in that span as a starter...has gone 34-22 with a 3.93 ERA (210ER/480.1IP), a .209 opponent batting average, a 1.17 WHIP and 9.5 SO/9 in his 94 career regular-season starts.

INVISBALL: Among AL pitchers since 2022 (min. 400 IP), he ranks 4th in H/9 (7.09) and 4th in opponent batting average (.214).

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3 after missing 76 games (April 9-July 1) due to a right shoulder strain...has battled a multitude of injuries the past few seasons, also missing most of the 2024 and '25 seasons due to Tommy John surgery (underwent the procedure in June 2024)...returned from Tommy John surgery on Aug. 11, 2025, going 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP) in eight starts to close out the season.

VS. TOR: Will be making his 5th career start vs. the Jays and is facing them for the 1st time since a start on Sept. 11, 2025 at Rogers Centre (6.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 SO)...in his 3 career starts vs. TOR at Daikin Park, he's gone 2-1 with a 3.52 ERA (6ER/15.1IP, a .151 opponent average (8x53) and 16 strikeouts...has held **IF Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** to 1x9 with 2 strikeouts in their career matchups...has also held former teammate **OF George Springer** to 1x8 with 2 strikeouts in their career matchups.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican pitcher is in his 7th MLB season with the Astros and has gone 36-23 with a 3.80 ERA (236ER/559.1IP) and 619 strikeouts in 132 appearances, including 94 starts...among Astros pitchers with at least 500 innings pitched with the club, his .206 career opponent batting average ranks 3rd, behind only **LHP Billy Wagner** (.186) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (.199)...was signed by the Astros as a non-drafted free agent from the Dominican Republic on March 19, 2015...signed a 5-year contract extension in Feb. 2023 that will keep him in Houston through the 2027 season.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/2 vs. TEX): Notched his 3rd win of the season, working a scoreless 0.2 of an inning with 1 walk and 2 strikeouts...struck out IF Nicky Lopez looking to end the 7th inning with runners at 1st and 2nd and the game tied at 3-3.

MILESTONE MARKERS: Is currently at 499 career strikeouts and is seeking to become the 4th reliever in Astros history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining LHP Billy Wagner (694), RHP Brad Lidge (557) and RHP Dave Smith (529)...logged his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history.

HEAT OF THE SUMMER: Over his last 15 appearances (since June 20), he's posted a 1.17 ERA (2ER/15.1IP) with 18 strikeouts, a .137 opponent batting average and a 0.78 WHIP...ranks 6th among AL relievers in opponent batting average in that span (min. 15 IP).

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 3-1-6 with a 2.08 ERA (7ER/30.1IP)...has also recorded 35 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .176 opponent batting average during the stretch...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is T-3rd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert's (14-game streak and 10-game streak)...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.
