TODAY'S GAME: After dropping another heartbreaker last night, the Giants aim to even up the series tonight...the Giants are 4-2 over their last six games despite last night's defeat.

- ▶ With last night's loss, the Giants have lost six of their last eight games here at home to the Nationals dating to May 10, 2023...if you take it back to 2022, the Giants are 4-9 against Nationals at Oracle Park while being outscored 75-50 (-25 run diff).
- ▶ SF will need to win each of the last two games of this series to claim a series victory, something they have not done against the Nats here in San Francisco since sweeping a three-game set from them in 2021.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: SF suffered another last at-bat defeat yesterday, it's seventh of the season and first at home.

- ▶ It was the 17th time this season the Giants have held a lead at any point in the game and ended up losing the game...the 17 such games are tied for most in the National League with the Nationals and tied for the sixth-most overall in the Majors... Detroit and Minnesota are tied for the most in MLB with 21 such games.
- ▶ Lastly, SF owns a 5.51 ERA in the 9th inning this season, sixth-highest in the Majors and fourth-highest in the National League...the Rockies lead the NL and the Majors with a 7.69 ERA in the 9th inning.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Adrian Houser gets the ball tonight for his 13th start of the season and second start this year against the Nationals...he faced them back in Washington on April 18 in the Giants 7-6 win, allowing five runs (four earned) in 5.2 innings.

- ▶ In seven career games (five starts) vs. Washington, he's 0-1 with a 2.49 ERA (7er, 25.1ip).
- ▶ Houser last threw in Milwaukee last Thursday but didn't finish 5.0 innings to qualify for a victory after SF had opened up a 6-1 lead through the top of the 5th inning...all told, Houser allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits in 4.1 innings.
- ▶ Tonight's outing will be his fifth here at home...he's gone 0-2 with a 6.97 ERA (16er, 20.2ip) in his previous four home starts...SF is 1-3 in those four starts, winning his last one here against the White Sox on May 23.

LEE JUNG HOO, SO HOT RIGHT NOW: OF Jung Hoo Lee stayed red hot with another four-hit game to extend his hitting streak to 16 games....the streak is the longest active streak in the Majors and the fourth-longest by any player in the Majors this year.

- ▶ The 16-game hitting streak is the longest by a Giants batter since a 17-game streak by **Donovan Solano** July 25-August 15, 2020...Lee's streak is the longest by a Giants outfielder since **Ángel Pagán** had a 19-game streak in 2016.
- ▶ Lee is slashing .508/.523/.651 with 15 runs, four doubles, a triple, a homer, eight RBI and two stolen bases over the 16-game streak.
- ▶ Over Lee's last 11 games he now has 27 hits...according to MLB's *Sarah Langs*, Lee is the first Giant since **Whitey Lockman** in 1953 to register 27+ hits in an 11-game span and the sixth Giant overall to do so...*full list to to the right*.
- ▶ Lee's streak has raised his batting average from .265 at the start of the streak to .333, second-best in MLB behind Miami's Otto Lopez (.336).

SPIDERMAN POINTING MEME: IF Luis Arraez (82 hits) and OF Jung Hoo Lee (75 hits) rank among MLB's best in terms of hits with Arraez checking second and Lee tied for fourth.

- ▶ The last time a pair of Giants teammates each had 75+ hits through the team's first 67 games was 11 years ago when **Nori Aoki** (80 hits) and **Joe Panik** (75 hits) did so in 2015.
- ▶ The duo have combined for 157 hits on the season, second-most by any duo in the Majors this year behind Miami's Otto Lopez and Xavier Edwards with 160 hits.

DON'T GRAB THE WINDEX: Several other Giants are also streaking offensively entering play today.

- ▶ **IF Bryce Eldridge** is riding a 15-game on-base streak, tied for the eighth-longest active streak in the Majors...he's slashing .392/.467/.588 (1.055 OPS) during the run.
- ▶ **IF Luis Arraez** is riding a nine-game hitting streak into play today (13x39, .333).
- ▶ **IF Matt Chapman** has at least one RBI in each of his last five games (13 total RBI), tied for the longest such streak of his career (also April 12-17, 2021 with the A's).

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY
JUNE 9, 2015
Chris Heston of the San Francisco Giants threw the first no-hitter of the season in his 14th career start in the 5-0 victory over the Mets. He struck out 11 and walked none, but hit three batters with pitches. It was the fifth no-hitter by a Giants pitcher in seven years.

YO, ADRIAN: Is in his first season in a Giants uniform and 10th overall in the Majors...the 33-year-old signed a two-year contract (with a club option for 2028) with the Giants this past offseason and is making his 13th start of the season tonight.

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched against the team he broke into the Majors with, the Brewers, and received a no-decision in a 12-9 Giants' victory last Thursday...pitched 4.1 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits with five strikeouts and three walks...left after allowing a two-run homer in the 5th inning that cut the Giants' lead (at the time) from 6-1 down to 6-3.

VS. THE NATIONALS: Will be Houser's eighth game (sixth start) against the Nationals...in matchups with Washington, he's 0-1 with a 2.49 ERA (7er, 25.1ip)...this marks his second start against the Nats this year, as he got a no-decision after 5.2 innings (5r, 4er, 7h) in a 7-6 Giants' win in Washington on April 18.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Recently, Houser's approach has shifted to a heavy reliance on the hard stuff over his breaking pitches... he used his sinker and four-seam fastball as his top two pitches in May in terms of usage, which he hadn't done since May of 2025...the sinker and four-seamer were thrown a combined 65.5% of the time in May and opponents were just 16x69 (.232) against them, compared to a 54% combined usage rate in April and a .316 BAA (24x76)...he's throwing all of his offspeed pitches less, especially his changeup, which went from a 22.6% usage rate in April to a 13.8% rate in May... this change in pitch mix led to a much improved 3.81 ERA (11er, 26.0ip) in May compared to a 7.12 ERA (24er, 30.1ip) in April.

MIDDLE MAN: Has been at his best this season in the middle innings of his outings...in innings 2-4 this season, he has a 3.03 ERA with a 1.15 WHIP...in May specifically those numbers were even better with to a 2.45 ERA and a 1.09 WHIP...however, in innings 1 and 5 he has an ERA of 8.25 and 11.88, respectively.

LEFT ON READ: Lefties are slashing .349/.434/.617 with 17 doubles, a triple, seven homers and a 1.051 OPS in 149 at-bats compared to righties slashing .206/.233/.320 with two doubles, three homers and a .553 OPS in 97 at-bats...amongst pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched this season, Houser's 1.051 OPS vs. left-handed batters is second-highest in the Majors, behind only COL's Michael Lorenzen (1.238)...on the other hand, his .553 OPS against right-handed batters is 13th-best in the NL.

RAMBLIN' MAN: Houser has been more comfortable on the road than at home this season, posting a 4.73 ERA (21er, 40.0ip) over eight road starts versus a 6.97 ERA (16er, 20.2ip) in four starts at Oracle Park.

HAPPY DAYS: Has found success pitching in day games this season, posting a 3.93 ERA (16er, 36.2p) with a .255 BAA seven starts...in five night starts, he has 7.88 ERA (21er, 24.0ip) with a .347 BAA.

CONTACT: Houser has a 14.4% strikeout rate this season, which is third-lowest in the Majors, ahead only of WSH's Zack Littell (14.0%) and COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (13.6%) (min. 60.0 IP).

TOMORROW'S STARTER

ROBBIE RAY LHP #38

2026 RECORD: 4-6, 4.12 ERA

- ▶ Earned the win in his last start on June 5 at Wrigley Field...tossed 5.0-scoreless innings and allowed two hits and five walks with four strikeouts in the Giants 18-3 win over the Cubs.
- ▶ Will make his 11th career start against the Nationals... has posted a 3-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (30er, 52.2ip) and 59 strikeouts over his 10 career outings...he faced Washington earlier this year on April 19th and suffered the loss as he threw 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits and one walk with seven strikeouts in the Giants 3-0 loss to the Nationals...he's never faced Washington at Oracle Park.

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper

Last Game: 6/4 at MIL; 1.0ip, h, r, er, hr (12 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on May 31 (second stint with SF)...has surrendered seven runs in 3.0ip in three games since his recall and has a 10.50 ERA in five appearances (6.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25...left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, h (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 1.76 ERA (3er, 15.1ip) in his last nine games.
- ▶ Has a 1.53 ERA (3er, 17.2ip) in 13 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 12 of 22 contests (4.6 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .212 (7-for-33) off his slider, .231 (12-for-52) off his sinker and .250 (4-for-16) off his changeup.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 6/6 at CHC; 0.0ip, h, r (5 pitches)

- ▶ Has made 11 appearances with SF, logging 8.2 innings and allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits with 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has walked 11 batters in 8.2 innings (11.4 BB/9ip).
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-16 off him while lefties are 5-for-15.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May but has thrown 4.2 scoreless innings with three hits and 5K's in his last five games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 11-for-60 (.183) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 9-for-46 (.196) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 15 walks in his 19.1ip (7.0 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 64.1 innings pitched dating back to August 14, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-36 (.167) off him while left-handers are 9-for-35 (.257).
- ▶ Holding opponents 4-for-27 (.148) off his slider and 6-for-35 (.171) off his sinker.

#77 CARSON SEYMOUR ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 6/5 at CHC; 3.0ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, hr, bb, k (45 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Friday.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 4.04 ERA (22er, 49.0ip) and 23 strikeouts in 11 games (nine starts) with the River Cats this season.
- ▶ In his last three starts with Sacramento leading up to his recall, Seymour was 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3er, 16.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.38 ERA (10er, 26.2ip) in 13 games out of the bullpen for SF in 2025...also made three starts, posting a 8.68 ERA (9er, 9.1ip) and .325 BAA as a starter.
- ▶ His most effective pitch last season was his four-seamer...batters were 5-for-31 against it (.161) with eight strikeouts.

#66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker

Last Game: 6/8 vs. WSH; 0.1ip (3 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded the first save of his MLB career Sunday, pitching a scoreless 10th inning at Chicago-NL.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on June 2, his second recall of the season...has made four appearances so far for SF, throwing 3.0 scoreless innings with a walk and three strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.98 ERA (9er, 20.1ip) .205 BAA and 23 strikeouts in 15 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Acquired from Detroit on March 30 in exchange for cash.
- ▶ Drafted by Detroit on the third round in 2021 out of the University of Alabama...had spent the past five seasons in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with Detroit last season...in 11 career MLB games he's 1-0-1 with a 1.13 ERA (2er, 16.0ip) with six walks and seven strikeouts.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 6/8 vs. WSH; L, 0.2ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, k, hbp (22 pitches)

- ▶ The three hits he allowed last night were the most he'd allowed in any relief appearance this year (29 games)...his HBP last night was his first of the season.
- ▶ Over his last six games dating to May 26 he's allowed seven runs (six earned) on 10 hits (two homers) over 7.1 innings (7.36 ERA).
- ▶ Has allowed just two of is 10 inherited runners to score this season.
- ▶ 20 of his 29 appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Opponents are just 21-for-108 (.194) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 10-for-54 (.185) with 18 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His is 27.7% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 4% of MLB.
