WE PLAYED A BASEBALL GAME LAST NIGHT: The Twins fell to the Nationals, 9-3, last night at Target Field...Joe Ryan was the starter and took the loss, allowing five runs (4 earned) on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...after Washington took an early lead, the Twins got on the board in the sixth after Willi Castro (1-for-3) doubled to lead off the frame and was driven in by Royce Lewis's (2-for-4) single; Ty France (3-for-4) later doubled in Lewis...Matt Wallner (0-for-3) drove in Minnesota's other run on an eighth-inning sac fly...Twins went 1-for-12 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base... Byron Buxton was removed from the game in the top of the seventh with left side soreness.

MONUMENT MEETS MINNEAPOLIS: The Twins and Nationals are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 13-13 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise...Twins are 3-5 at Target Field (2019 & '23), 3-6 at Nationals Park (2013, '16 & '24), 4-2 at the Metrodome (2007 & '08) and 3-0 in Montreal (2004).

HISTORY LESSONS: For 60 years, the Washington Senators played baseball in our nation's capital, winning one World Championship (1924) and three AL pennants (1925, '33)...in 1961, owner Calvin Griffith moved the Senators from Washington, D.C. to Bloomington, Minnesota... the Senators played from 1901-1960, compiling a record of 4223-4864...the Senators beat the New York Giants in the 1924 World Series in seven games, marking the only World Series victory for the franchise during its first 60-year tenure in Washington.

4 The Twins enter tonight's game with an all-time club record (since 1961) of 5086-5145-8 and an all-time franchise record (Senators and Twins) of 9310-10008.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 16-22 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and 1-1 vs. Washington (July 25-27).

◆ Twins have three NL teams still to play (after the Nationals): Padres (August 29-31), D-Backs (September 12-14) and Phillies (September 26-28).

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis has an extra-base hit in each of his last three games (2B/HR, 2B, 2B), matching the second-best such streak of his career for the sixth time (career-best streak is 4 games, from June 19-22, 2024)...he's also hitting .455 (10-for-22) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, two walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a 1.045 slugging percentage and a 1.545 OPS in his last six games...below are his season comparisons in a few categories:

C4, INTERLEAGUE MADNESS: Since the start of 2024, Carlos Correa is hitting .344 (64-for-186) with 12 doubles, one triple, five homers, 21 RBI, a .435 on-base percentage and a .935 OPS in 53 Interleague games...in that span, he leads all hitters (minimum of 150 PA) in Interleague OBP, while his IL batting average is second behind Ivan Herrera (.348).

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have gone 29-21 at home this season, compared to 21-33 on the road...a win today would give the Twins their fourth-straight series win at Target Field, after winning series vs. Tampa Bay (July 4-6), Chicago-NL (July 8-10) and Pittsburgh (July 11-13) last homestand.

♣ The Twins are 9-4 in their last 13 in Minnesota, dating back to June 25.

♣ Byron Buxton has a 1.006 OPS in 42 home games this season, fifth best in baseball.

SUNDAY, RUBBER SUNDAY: The Twins enter today 3-7 in rubber games this season and 1-2 in rubber games at home...lone home rubber game win this season came on April 16 vs. New York-NL, a 4-3 walk-off win in 10 innings...Twins have lost each of their last six rubber games, dating back to May 28 at Tampa Bay; Minnesota's last win in a rubber match was on May 4 at Boston, a 5-4 victory.

TWINS Milb WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita outfielder Kyler Fedko and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Adrian Bohorquez have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

◆ Fedko, 25, hit .313 (5-for-16), with one double, three home runs, four RBI, five walks, three stolen bases, a .476 on-base percentage and a 1.414 OPS in five games for the Wind Surge... during the week, Fedko reached 20 home runs, giving him a 20 HR/20 SB season for the first time in his career...the Gibsonia, PA native was selected by Minnesota in the 12th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Connecticut.

◆ Bohorquez, 20, started and earned the win for the Mighty Mussels on July 24 at Lakeland, allowing one unearned run on two hits, with one hit batter, no walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings...the La Victoria, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as a free agent in January 2023.

ACROSS THE RIVER, THERE'S REHAB: Infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) is on rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints and went 1-for-4 with a walk, two stolen bases and a run scored last night against Worcester...Keaschall has played in seven rehab games with St. Paul so far, hitting .231 (6-for-26) with one RBI, five walks and four steals.

◆ Right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober (left hip impingement) is also rehabbing with the Saints and has a 1.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in two starts.
