YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the White Sox, 5-3, in the third game of the four-game set to earn their 11th series win and 15th comeback win of the season... Improved to 27-10 when homering, 21-3 when hitting multiple home runs, and 11-2 when hitting at least three home runs...Are a perfect 26-0 when outhitting their opponent...**Ryan O'Hearn** (7), **Anthony Santander** (9), and **Jordan Westburg** (8) all homered in the eighth inning to turn a 3-0 deficit into a 5-3 lead; marked the first time the Orioles hit three home runs in an inning since the bottom of the sixth on June 1, 2022 vs. Seattle (Mancini/Mountcastle/Urias).

SWEEP DREAMS: The Orioles are looking for their fourth sweep of the season, first four-game sweep since July 7-10, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-AL, and first four-game sweep on the road since August 22-25, 2011 at Minnesota...It would be Baltimore's first sweep of the White Sox since a three-game set from May 5-7, 2017, first sweep of the White Sox in Chicago since a three-game set from August 18-20, 2014, and first four-game sweep of the Sox since July 6-9, 1995 at Guaranteed Rate Field (then New Comiskey Park).

NIFTY FIFTY: The Orioles have gone 32-18 (.640) through their first 50 games of the year...Marks the fifth time in team history that the Birds have won 32+ of their first 50 games of a season, along with 2023 (33-17), 1997 (35-15), 1970 (34-16), and 1969 (35-15).

THE ERAS TOUR: The O's have a 2.76 ERA (64 ER/209.0 IP) in their last 23 games since April 29, the second-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.41)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 149 hits while holding opponents to a .198 batting average (149-for-752).

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** is tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Houston's Kyle Tucker for the MLB home run lead with 17 and ranks among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)...Homered in four straight games from May 17-20, the first Oriole to do since **DJ Stewart** from September 5-9, 2020; is one of six MLB players to homer in at least four straight games this year, along with Boston's Rafael Devers (6 G), Chicago-NL's Michael Busch (5 G), Los Angeles-NL's Mookie Betts (4 G), New York-AL's Aaron Judge (4 G), and Texas' Corey Seager (4 G).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 75 home runs, tied with 2012 for the third-most homers through the first 50 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 (81) and 1996 (78); the most homers through Baltimore's first 51 games of a season is 83 by the 1987 team.

⚾ The Orioles have four players with at least eight homers, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (17), **Adley Rutschman** and **Anthony Santander** (9), and **Jordan Westburg** (8).

LEADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, the most in MLB...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

⚾ Henderson's five leadoff home runs are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history with **Cedric Mullins** (2022), **Seth Smith** (2017), **Adam Jones** (2016), and **Don Buford** (1971); he trails **Brady Anderson** (7 in 1999 & 2000), Mullins (8 in 2021), and Anderson (12 in 1996).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Orioles wrap up a seven-game road trip today...Were swept in three games by the Cardinals...Have won the first three games of a four-game set against the White Sox...The O's are 15-8 (.652) on the road this year, the second-best road record in the AL and third-best in MLB, behind the Yankees (.679, 19-9) and Phillies (.696, 16-7).

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: The Orioles and White Sox conclude a four-game set in Chicago today, the first of two series between the teams this season...With yesterday's win, the Orioles have clinched their fifth consecutive series win over the White Sox, their longest streak since winning eight sets in a row against them from September 1977 to August 1979, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The O's will host the ChiSox in Baltimore for three games from September 2-4...Last year, the Orioles went 4-2 against the Sox, taking two of three in Chicago from April 14-16 and two of three in Baltimore from August 28-30...The Orioles also won the season series against the White Sox in 2022 (5-2) and are 12-4 against them since the start of 2022.

HOMECOMING: Following the current road trip, the Orioles will return to Baltimore for a six-game homestand, beginning tomorrow with the first of three games against the Red Sox...The Orioles have a scheduled off day on Thursday, May 30, before hosting the Rays for three games over the weekend.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 347 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

TRADE WINDS: The Orioles last night announced that they have acquired right-handed pitcher **Thyago Vieira** and minor league right-handed pitcher **Aneuris Rodriguez** from the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Garrett Stallings...Vieira has not yet reported, while Rodriguez has been assigned to the Florida Complex League Orioles.

⚾ Vieira, 31, had one save and a 5.64 ERA (14 ER/22.1 IP) with 25 hits (6 HR), 13 walks (1 IBB), two hit batters, and 25 strikeouts in 16 games with Milwaukee this season; the 16 appearances tie his career high set with the Chicago White Sox in 2018.

⚾ Rodriguez, 19, made three appearances (one start) for the Arizona Complex League Brewers this season while posting a 3.68 ERA (3 ER/7.1 IP), seven hits, six total runs, four walks, one hit batter, and 15 strikeouts.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his fifth start of the season and the first of his career against the White Sox this afternoon...Has not surrendered a home run since September 14, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay...Made his season debut on May 2 vs. New York-AL...Began the year on the 15-day Injured List (right UCL sprain)...Made three rehab starts, one with Double-A Bowie and two with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) with 14 strikeouts and four walks...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 quality starts) for the O's in 2023 and finished fourth for the AL Cy Young; became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992...Spent time on the Injured List with a right foot contusion from April 5-19 after being struck by a comebacker in the second inning of his season debut on April 3 at Texas...Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Zach Peck, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 21 at St. Louis...Allowed one run on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts and one hit batter in 5.0 innings; has surrendered four hits in every outing this season...Removed from the start after the game was suspended due to inclement weather...Threw 74 pitches, 52 strikes.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX AND THE AL CENTRAL: Slated to make his first career start against the White Sox and his fifth against the AL Central...Owns a lifetime 1-1 record with a 3.32 ERA (8 ER/21.2 IP) in his four prior outings against the division...Suffered the loss in his last start against an AL Central foe on July 1, 2023 vs. Minnesota; allowed one run on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with seven strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Bradish has posted a 7-3 record with a 3.18 ERA (36 ER/102.0 IP) in 19 starts away from Oriole Park since the start of last season...Has not allowed more than three runs in 17 of those starts and has not allowed more than two runs in a road start since August 1, 2023 at Toronto.

NIGHT OWL: Slated to make his third night start of the season...Went 9-6 with a 3.44 ERA (41 ER/107.1 IP) across his 19 night starts in 2023.

STATCAST STUD: His HardHit% is ranked in the 99th percentile (20.8); also ranks among MLB leaders in Exit Velocity (98th, 84.4), xSLG (95th, .285), and xBA (94th, .190), per Statcast.

REVERSE SPLITS: Bradish is holding lefties to a .184/.279/.263 (7-for-38) slash line this season, while righties are slashing .273/.368/.424 (9-for-33) off him...Has allowed 11 extra-base hits to lefty hitters in his last 19 starts and two in his last seven outings.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster...Finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, earning six third-place, eight fourth-place, and five fifth-place votes; marked the highest finish by an Orioles hurler since Zack Britton finished fourth in 2016...Led the O's in nearly every pitching category last season, including ERA (2.83), strikeouts (168), opponent batting average (.215), on-base percentage (.275), OPS (.605), WHIP (1.04), and quality starts (18)...Ended the campaign ranked among qualified MLB leaders in ERA and WHIP (4th), as well as opponent batting average (7th), and among qualified AL leaders in opponent average (2nd), ERA (3rd), WHIP (4th), and winning percentage (T-8th, .632)...The 168 strikeouts were a career high and the most by an O's hurler since Dylan Bundy fanned 184 batters in 2018...Logged five straight quality starts from August 6 to September 8, the longest such streak of his career...The last longer streak by an Oriole was Alex Cobb's six-gamer from July 26 to August 24, 2018...Had a 16.0-inning scoreless streak to end the regular season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Made his Postseason debut as the starter in Game 1 of the ALDS vs. TEX; dealt the loss after allowing two runs on seven hits with one walk and nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings; became the third player in O's history (since 1954) to strike out at least nine batters in his Postseason debut, joining Mike Boddicker (14, September 6, 1983 vs. CWS - ALCS G2) and Moe Drabowsky (11, September 5, 1966 at LAD - WS G1).

Scheduled to make his 10th appearance and eighth start of the season tomorrow against the Red Sox...Suffered the loss in his last outing, allowing five runs (3 ER) on six hits (1 HR) with two strikeouts in 3.1 innings of relief on May 22 in St. Louis...Picked up the win in his last start on May 10 vs. Arizona, surrendering two runs on five hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts across 5.2 innings...Owns a lifetime 0-1 record with a 7.31 ERA (13 ER/16.0 IP) in his three prior starts against Boston...Did not factor into the decision in his start in Boston earlier this season, allowing five runs on seven hits (1 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts in 5.0 innings on April 10.
