## Barreled

Adam Duvall barreled a ball 382 feet to left in last night's seventh inning, but it was caught at the wall for the first out in the inning.
The ball had an exit velocity of 104.0 miles per hour and an expected batting average of .850 , and would have been a home run in

22 of the 30 major league parks.
The flyout was Atlanta's 61 st out this season made on a barreled ball, the most such outs in baseball. The Yankees, with 57, rank second.
The Braves are batting . 624 this season on barrels, the lowest average in the National League and better than just the Rays (.605) in baseball.

For context, the major league average on barreled balls is $.688,64$ points higher than Atlanta's mark.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Tigers tonight continue a three-game series in what is the only scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The two teams met last year in Detroit, and are playing in back-to-back seasons for the first time.

A The Braves broke a tie with a run in the bottom of the eighth inning last night and held on to win, 2-1, to take the opener.

A Atlanta has won the series, two-games-to-one, in each of the last three seasons these two clubs have met...The Braves won the series by that margin last year, in 2019 and in 2016, and have not lost a series to the Tigers since getting swept in 2013.
A The Braves and Tigers have met 28 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with Atlanta going just 13-15 (.464) against Detroit all-time... Despite the losing record, Atlanta has won five of the nine total series between the clubs, although Detroit has the only two sweeps between the teams.

A The Braves have hosted just one series all-time against the Tigers here at Truist Park, taking two-of-three in 2019...In 19 total games in the city of Atlanta, the Braves hold a slight edge, 10-9.
A RH Spencer Schwellenbach is set to make the fourth start of his major league career, and his first against Detroit...The 6-foot-1, 200-pound righthander turned in the longest outing of his career in his last turn, allowing just four hits and two runs over 6.0 innings on June 12 at Baltimore...A native of Saginaw, MI, he attended Heritage High School, located just under two hours from Comerica Park...Schwellenbach is making his third consecutive interleague start, and is the first pitcher in franchise history to face three AL teams in his first four turns.
A RH Casey Mize has never faced Atlanta... The former No. 1 overall pick out of Auburn is 1-4 with a 4.43 ERA ( $32 \mathrm{ER} / 65.0 \mathrm{IP}$ ) over 13 starts this season, and is $8-17$ with a 4.33 ERA in 52 career starts since 2020...The 6-foot-3, 212-pound native of Springville, AL, has allowed no more than three earned runs in 12 of his 14 starts this season, and pitched 6.0 one-run inning in his last turn, June 13 vs. Washington.
WIN: Ozzie Albies drove a $1-1$ pitch with two outs in the eighth inning out to right field for his fifth home run of the season...The drive gave Atlanta a one-run lead it would not relinquish in the win, 2-1.

A The victory was the Braves' eighth this season from its final at-bat, and moved the club to $4-4$ when it is tied after seven innigs.
A Atlanta improved to 18-10 (.643) against American League opponents this season...New York-AL (12-6, .667),Tampa Bay (13-7, .650) and Philadelphia (11-6, .647) are the only clubs with a higher winning percentage in interleague games... Each of the Braves next five games are versus AL opponents.

CLOSE WIN: Last night's win marked Atlanta's first by a one-run margin since April 28 vs. Cleveland, when it beat the Guardians, 4-3...The club won six of its first nine one-run affairs, but suffered seven consecutive such defeats before yesterday.

A Overall, the Braves are 7-10 (.412) in one-run games this season.
A Atlanta dropped one-run games to Seattle (2-1, 3-2), Los Angeles-NL (4-3), New York-NL (4-3), San Diego (6-5), Chicago-NL (4-3) and Washington (2-1) since its last such win.

A In going 6-3 over their first nine one-run games, the Braves batted $.300 / .376 / .455$ from the seventh inning on and scored 20 total runs in these innings.. During their seven-game losing streak in such games, the Braves hit $.145 / .191 / .217$ after the seventh inning and scored just seven total runs.

A Ozzie Albies' eighth-inning home run was Atlanta's fourth the season in the seventh inning or later of a one-run game, and the first that spurred the club to a win...Ronald Acuña Jr. homered in the eighth inning on May 3 at the Dodgers in a game Atlanta lost in extra innings, and Marcell Ozuna hit homers in the seventh and ninth on April 2 at the White Sox in a game Atlanta dropped, 3-2.
LATE RUNS: The Braves scored once in the seventh and once in the eighth last night to plate their only two runs of the game...Atlanta's 93 total runs in the seventh and eighth this season are the most in baseball.
A Thirty percent (93-of-311) of the Braves' runs this season have scored in these two innings...Atlanta is hitting .258/.331/.456 in these two innings, and has hit 23 of its 76 home runs ( $30 \%$ ) on the season... The club's .787 OPS in the seventh and eighth is behind just Baltimore (.828) in baseball.
A Atlanta has scored just 186 runs in the first through the sixth innings, more than only seven other teams...The Braves are batting .243/.303/.393 in these innings, and its . 696 OPS ranks 16th in the majors.

AUSTIN RILEY: Collected two more hits last night, going 2-for-3 with two doubles...He has hits in each of the four games of this homestand, going 8-for-13 with eight RBI and six runs scored.

A Six of Riley's eight hits have gone for extra bases, including his two doubles last night, and he has three doubles and three homers in his last four games... He is batting .615/.667/1.538 on the homestand.

A Riley had just eight total hits in the month of June prior to his current streak, going 8 -for-42 (.190) with two doubles over 11 total games.

A His six extra-base hits in four games this homestand match his total from his previous 38 games dating to April 16, when he batted just .188/.264/.250 with four doubles, one triple and a home run.
A Eight of the 12 balls Riley has put in play this homestand have exit velocities over 100 mph .

A Scheduled to make his fourth career start.
A Will become the first Braves pitcher in franchise history to make three starts through his first four career appearances against American League opponents.
Scattered four hits and two runs over 6.0 frames tossed against Baltimore in his last start

A Schwellenbach joined Charlie Morton and Ian Anderson as the only Braves pitchers in franchise history to make two of their first three career appearances as starters against American League opponents...He will become just the second hurler to face two AL East opponents in that span.
A Ian Anderson made his first two career starts against Boston and New York (AL) in 2020, while Charlie Morton pitched against Texas and Los Angeles (AL) in his first two outings in 2008.

A Allowed seven hits, six runs, two walks and a home run with four strikeouts in his last start while facing the Red Sox.

A Joined Ian Anderson (2020) and Kyle Davies (2005) as the only Braves pitchers in franchise history to make one of their first two career starts in Fenway Park

A Made his major league debut on May 29 against the Nationals...went 5.0 inning allowing five hits, three runs, one walk and striking out five Washington hitters.

A Became just the ninth pitcher in Braves franchise history to debut against the Nationals

A Made his debut at age 23 years and 364 days, becoming the youngest starter to debut for Atlanta since AJ Smith-Shawver last season on June 4...Teammate Hurston Waldrep became the youngest pitcher to make their first start shortly after debuting at 22 years and 100 days.
A He was the sixth youngest starter to debut this season at the time of his start.
A Pitched 13.0 scoreless innings in two starts with Double-A Mississippi while recording 17 strikeouts and issuing just one walk, earning the win in both games.

A Held hitters to a .122 batting average.
A Made six starts for High-A Rome and went 2-1 with a 2.53 ERA this season.
A It would rank as the third lowest ERA among qualified starters in the South Atlantic League.

A Enters today with 24 starts at the professional level between Single-A Augusta, High-A Rome and Double-A Mississippi.

Iglesias is one of seven active pitchers with at least 400 games pitched and a sub-3.00 ERA
Since joining the Braves in 2022, has pitched to a 2.15 ERA (26 ER/108.2 IP).
Has 208 career saves, fifth most among active pitchers... Craig Kimbrel (433), Kenley Jansen (432), Aroldis Chapman (322) and Edwin Díaz (211) are ahead of him.

From April 6-22, logged saves in seven consecutive outings, the longest streak of his career without a decision/nodecision in between.
Since 2017, his 437 appearances rank fourth in the majors.
Was named National League Reliever of the month for August 2023 after he pitched 13 scoreless appearances within the month...In 13.0 innings, struck out 17, walked four and allowed only seven hits.
