**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners open a 6-game homestand with the first of 3 games against the Baltimore Orioles...Seattle will also host the Red Sox for a 3-game set (June 19-21) on the homestand...the Mariners are coming off a 10-game road trip where they saw the Orioles (2-2), Tigers (1-2) and Nationals (1-2)... tonight's game against the Orioles will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners.TV** with **Rich Waltz** and **Angie Mentink** on the call, and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** as sideline analyst...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Shannon Drayer** on the call.

**ODDS & ENDS**...the Mariners dropped Sunday's series finale against the Nationals by a 10-2 final... despite the loss, Seattle is 12-7 (.632) since May 25, tied for the 3rd-best record in the AL during that span.

- **Best In The West** - The Mariners (37-36) are in first place in the American League West Division, 0.5 games ahead of the second place Athletics (36-36).
- **Open Sesame** - The Mariners are 14-9 (.607) in series openers this season.
- **Naylor at the Plate** - **Josh Naylor** is batting .306 (59x193) with 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 25 RBI, 13 SB and an .803 OPS over his last 49 games since April 17.
- **Davila Answering the Call** - Right-handed reliever **Nick Davila** has not allowed an earned run over 10 appearances (10.2 IP) to begin his Major League career, the 5th longest such streak in Mariners history.

★**PUNCH THEIR TICKET TO PHILLY**★...Major League Baseball announced a ballot update to Phase One of voting for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia...the Mariners currently have a player in the Top 8 of voting at every position...OF **Julio Rodríguez** and OF **Randy Arozarena** headline the list, ranking 6th and 7th among AL outfielders, respectively...fans can submit up to 5 ballots per day until the conclusion of Phase One on June 25...Phase Two, which takes the finalists at each position, will run from June 29-July 2 before the All-Star rosters are announced on July 4... for more information and to vote, visit [Mariners.com/Vote](http://Mariners.com/Vote).

**CAL AND J.P. REINSTATED**...the Mariners announced today that **Cal Raleigh** (right oblique strain) and **J.P. Crawford** (right hand contusion) were both reinstated from the 10-day Injured List...as corresponding moves, **C Jhonny Pereda** and INF **Patrick Wisdom** (post-game June 14) were optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...Cal made 5 rehab appearances between High-A Everett and Triple-A Tacoma, batting .412 (7x17) with 5 home runs and 12 RBI...he caught all 9.0 innings in his appearances with Tacoma on Saturday and Sunday...Crawford was able to avoid a rehab assignment...he was batting .333 (14x42) in 11 games (5/24-c) before he was placed on the IL.

**DOM DIALED IN**...**Dominic Canzone** has been impressive over his last 18 games since May 24, batting .382 (21x55) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 10 RBI, reaching base at a .424 clip and slugging .818 for a 1.242 OPS...during that span he leads Major League batters in slugging percentage and ranks 2nd in OPS behind only Yordan Alvarez-HOU (1.283 OPS) among players with at least 50 plate appearances...he has hit safely in his last 5-consecutive games (6/10-c).

**COLE YOUNG'S HOT STRETCH**...**Cole Young** has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games since May 27, batting .324 (23x71) with 9 runs, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 2 walks and just 8 strikeouts, reaching base at a .347 clip and slugging .408 (.755 OPS) in 76 plate appearances...his 10.5% strikeout rate during that span ranks 3rd-lowest in the American League, closely behind teammate **Josh Naylor** (8.5%) and trailing only Trent Grisham-NYY (7.0%)...Young recorded a career-high 11-game hitting streak from May 27 to June 8 and has hit safely in his last 5-games since June 10, recording multiple hits in 3 of those games.

**JULIO: MADE FOR THE SPOTLIGHT**...**Julio Rodríguez** is currently poised to move on to Phase Two of All-Star voting, sitting 6th in voting for AL outfielders...Julio has made the All-Star Game in 3 of his first 4 seasons and has the chance to be the third Mariners player to make it 4 of their first 5, joining Ken Griffey Jr. and Ichiro Suzuki...in 73 games this season, Rodríguez is batting .248 (73x294) with 14 doubles, 13 home runs, 34 RBI and 9 stolen bases with a .740 OPS...among AL center fielders (min. 50% G as CF), he ranks T-2nd in doubles, 3rd in home runs, T-2nd in extra-base hits (27), 3rd in RBI and 4th in stolen bases.

**RANDY DESERVES YOUR VOTE**...**Randy Arozarena** been solid offensively all season long, batting .291 (76x261) with 47 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs, 33 RBI, 27 walks and 19 stolen bases, getting on base at a .377 clip and slugging .458 for an .826 OPS in 71 games...among qualified AL outfielders (min. 50% G as OF), Randy ranks 2nd in hits, 1st in stolen bases, 2nd in doubles, 2nd in batting average, 2nd in fWAR (2.3), 4th in OBP and 5th in OPS...Arozarena is 1 of 4 players with 25+ extra-base hits and 15+ stolen bases this season (26 XBH, 18 SB), joining José Ramírez-CLE (28 XBH, 24 SB), Bobby Witt Jr.-KC (29 XBH, 26 SB) and Pete Crow-Armstrong-CHC (29 XBH, 16 SB).

**EMERSON FOR EXTRAS**...in 23 games to begin his career, **Colt Emerson** has hit .237 (18x76) with 12 extra base hits: 5 doubles, 1 triple and 6 home runs...Emerson is one of 9 players in MLB history to record 12+ extra base hits in the first 23 games of their career at age 20...his 6 home runs prior to his 21st birthday also rank 3rd-most in Mariners history, trailing only Ken Griffey Jr. (38 HR from 1989-90) and Alex Rodriguez (26 HR from 1994-96).

**ROLLING TIDES**...during the Mariners 12-7 run since May 25, the Mariners pitching staff ranks 4th in MLB in ERA (3.77), 2nd in WHIP (1.11) and 5th in strikeout-to-walk rate (3.26)...also during the span, the Seattle offense ranks 8th in MLB in batting average (.268), 7th in slugging (.457) and 3rd in home runs (34).

**HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS**...highlights and promotions on the Mariners current homestand against include **Mariners Value Games** during each game of the Orioles series, **Stars and Stripes Soccer Jersey Day** on Thursday, **Juneteenth Celebration** and **Fireworks Night** on Friday, where Seattle will wear their Steelheads Jerseys, and **Father's Day** on Sunday.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Logan Gilbert** has been one of the best strikeout starters in the Majors since making his MLB debut in 2021, recording 966 career strikeouts since that rank 8th most in the Majors during that span, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...with his next strikeout at T-Mobile Park, Gilbert will become the 5th pitcher in Mariners history to record 500+ strikeouts at home?...he will join Félix Hernández (1348 K), Randy Johnson (1192 K), Jamie Moyer (689) and Mark Langston (578) as the only pitchers to accomplish the feat...Gilbert would also become the 10th pitcher in MLB since 2021 to hit the 500+ home strikeout mark.

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - JUNE 16

- **1985** - The Mariners completed a 3-game sweep of the eventual World Champion Kansas City Royals with a 2-1 win at the Kingdome; the Mariners 5th straight victory over Kansas City. Jim Presley singled home Barry Bonnell in the 9th inning for the game-winner.
- **1992** - Henry Cotto records the 34th pinch-hit of his Mariners career, making him the franchise leader in that category, passing Scott Bradley (33). Cotto finished his career with 38 pinch-hits.
- **2001** - John Olerud hits for the cycle for the second time in his career (also: Sept. 11, 1997 with NYM). Was third cycle in Mariners history.
- **2003** - John Olerud collects his 2,000th career hit – a game-tying two run homer off John Lackey – in the 4th inning of a 6-3 win vs. Anaheim.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 15th start of the season and the 161st start of his career...also marks his 2nd start against the Orioles this season and the 5th of his career.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

**LAST TIME OUT...**ND on June 9 at Baltimore, throwing 6.0 innings of 1-run baseball (1 ER) with 4 hits and 2 walks allowed to 5 strikeouts...he threw a season-high 105 pitches (61 strikes)...has tossed a quality start in 2 of his last 3 starts and in 5 starts this season...the Mariners have won in each of his last 4 starts (5/22-c) and in 7 of his last 9 starts (4/22-c).

**LATEST STRETCH...**across his last 4 starts since May 22, he is 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA (4 ER, 23.0 IP), 14 hits allowed (2 HR), 7 walks and 25 strikeouts...his 1.57 ERA is his best mark across a 4-game span since posting a 1.21 ERA (4 ER, 29.2 IP) from June 5-22, 2024.

**100 AND COUNTING...**threw a season-high 105 pitches in his last start (6/9 at BAL), tied for the 4th-most pitches he has thrown in any start across his career and the most he has thrown since July 4, 2023 at SF (also 105 pitches)...has thrown 100+ pitches 29 times in his career, including a career-high 13 times in 2022.

**UPCOMING MILESTONE...**is 1 strikeout away from 500 career strikeouts at home...with his next strikeout, he will become the 5th pitcher in Mariners history to record 500+ strikeouts at home, joining Félix Hernández, Randy Johnson, Jamie Moyer and Mark Langston.

**HOME SWEET HOME...**is making his 9th start at home this season and the 80th of his career...his 499 strikeouts at home lead the American League since 2021, ahead of Framber Valdez (494 SO)...among AL leaders since 2021, he also ranks 1st in starts (79 GS) and 3rd in innings pitched (452.0 IP).

**AGAINST THE O'S...**will make his 2nd consecutive start against the Orioles, last tossing 6.0 innings of 1-run baseball at Camden Yards on June 9...is facing the Orioles at home for just the 2nd time in his career, last throwing 5.1 innings and allowing 4 runs (4 ER) on 6 hits (1 HR) with 3 walks and 6 strikeouts on July 3, 2024.

**#50...**earned his 50th career win in his last road start on May 27 at the Athletics, becoming the 13th pitcher in Mariners history with 50+ career wins with the club...joins teammate **George Kirby** who also surpassed 50 career wins on May 11 at Houston.

**IN JUNE...**is 12-5 and owns a 3.27 ERA (53 ER, 145.2 IP) with 142 strikeouts to 27 walks allowed across 25 career starts in June...among pitchers with 20+ starts in June since 2021, his 1.016 career WHIP leads MLB, ranking ahead of Max Fried (1.022), while his 5.48 strikeout-to-walk ratio in June is 4th-best...rotation-mate **George Kirby** leads MLB with a 6.72 SO/BB in June.

**WALTER SHOVES...**has thrown 6.0+ innings with 1-or-fewer runs allowed in 4 starts this season (last: 6/9 at BAL) and in 43 starts across his career...his 43 such starts are 6th-most among American League pitchers since 2021...among that list, **George Kirby** ranks 8th (41 G) and **Luis Castillo** is 10th (37 G).

**AMONG THE LEAGUE...**among American League leaders since 2021, he ranks 1st in strikeouts (966 SO) and in total starts (160 GS), ranks 2nd in innings pitched (915.0 IP), 4th in quality starts (75 QS), 7th in K/BB (4.83), 9th in wins (51), T-9th in WHIP (1.06), and 9th in BB/9 (1.97)...his 85 career starts with 6.0+ innings thrown are tied for tied for 3rd-most in AL since 2021 while his 26 games with 7.0+ innings are 8th-most among AL pitchers.

**IN COMMAND...**has thrown 8+ strikeouts with 1-or-fewer walks in 29 career starts, including twice this season (last: 6/2 vs. NYM)...his 29 such starts are 10th-most in MLB since 2021...his 49 starts of 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks are 3rd-most in MLB since 2021, trailing only Aaron Nola (55) and Zack Wheeler (52).

**STAYING OFF THE BASE PATHS...**in his May 10 start vs. the White Sox, he allowed only 1 base runner for his 7th career start with 2-or-fewer base runners allowed over 6.0+ innings...his 7 such games are most in MLB since 2021.

**QUALITY CONTROL...**has thrown a quality start with 1-or-fewer walks issued in 58 career games (last: 5/10 at CWS), the 5th-most such games in MLB since 2021, just trailing behind rotation-mate **George Kirby** (59)...his 27 quality starts without a walk are 6th-most in MLB since 2021...Kirby leads MLB with 37 quality starts without a walk since 2021.

**AMONG THE GREATS...**his 3.58 career ERA (364 ER, 915.0 IP) is 5th-best among pitchers in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and ranks ahead of **Luis Castillo** (3.61)...his 966 career strikeouts are 5th-most in Mariners history (next: Mark Langston, 1078 SO)...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.060), T-2nd in K/9 (9.5, also James Paxton), and 2nd in K/BB (4.83) only behind **George Kirby's** 6.10 K/BB (min. 500 IP).

**HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...**recorded a season-high 21 swings and misses in his last home start (6/9 vws. NYM), tied for the 4th-most in a single game across his career...among American League leaders this season, his 29.1% whiff rate is tied for 8th-best (min. 750 pitches) while his 186 swings and misses are 9th-most...his 2,095 career swing and misses rank 5th-most in MLB and lead the American League since 2021...also owns a 43.5 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.
