**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his eighth start of the season tonight against the Nationals...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Dealt his first loss of the season on May 1 vs. New York-AL... Allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts across 6.0 innings; Oswaldo Cabrera hit a two-run homer in the fifth inning...Half of Burnes' 12 earned runs have scored via home runs...Threw 95 pitches, 61 strikes.

**AGAINST THE NATIONALS:** Making his third career start and sixth appearance against the Nationals...Owns a lifetime 3.68 ERA (6 ER/14.2 IP), allowing six runs on 11 hits (2 HR) and six walks with 17 strikeouts in his five prior games against Washington.

**AGAINST THE NL EAST:** Owns a lifetime 6-4 record with a 3.90 ERA (47 ER/108.1 IP), his highest ERA against any division, across 27 appearances (16 GS) against the NL East...Opponents are slashing .238/.287/.402 (100-for-420) off him.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Scheduled to make his third road start of the season... In 2023, he went 6-5 with a 2.77 ERA (35 ER/113.2 IP) in 18 road starts.

**NIGHT OWL:** Through four night starts this season, Burnes owns a 1-1 record with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER/17.2 IP)...Has allowed five walks compared to 16 strikeouts in night games.

**EARLY STRUGGLES:** Burnes has surrendered five of his 13 runs in the first inning this season with four of those coming via solo home runs...The four first inning home runs allowed are tied for the MLB lead with Atlanta's Chris Sale and San Diego's Matt Waldron.

**RING 'EM UP:** Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 89 strikeouts away from 1,000.

**INNINGS EATER:** The 604.0 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank third in MLB (Aaron Nola - 622.2 and Sandy Alcántara - 619.0)... Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.

Slated to make his second start of the season and third of his career against the Nationals tomorrow...Did not factor into the decision in his season debut on May 2 vs. New York-AL; allowed one run on four hits, two walks, and one hit batter with five strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...Owns a lifetime 2-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/14.0 IP) across two starts against Washington...Took the win in his last appearance against the Nats on September 26, 2023 at Oriole Park after completing 8.0 shutout innings, his third career 8.0-inning shutout start.
