SWEEP DREAMS: The Birds completed their third, three-game sweep of the season on Sunday, joining April 9-11 at Boston and April 15-17 vs. Minnesota...Marked their first sweep of any length at Cincinnati, and their first sweep of the Reds since a three-gamer in Baltimore from September 2-4, 2014.

THIS AND THAT: The Orioles are winners of four in a row, six of their last seven, seven of nine, 11 of 15, and 15 of 20... At 23-11 (.676), the O's have the best record in the AL and second-best in MLB behind the Phillies (.694, 25-11)...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 207-151 (.578), the second-best record in the AL behind the Astros (.581, 208-150) and fourth-best in MLB, trailing the Braves (.632, 225-131) and Dodgers (.651, 235-126).

OPENING STATEMENTS: The starting pitcher trio of **Cole Irvin** (6.1 IP), **John Means** (7.0), and **Dean Kremer** (6.0) did not surrender a run during the weekend series in Cincinnati...Dating back to May 2, starting pitchers have posted 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings, the longest such stretch by the 0's since 29.2 straight shutout frames from April 18-22, 2023. Øx For the season, Baltimore starters have a 3.18 ERA (68 ER/192.2 IP), ranked fourth in the

AL and sixth in MLB.

PITCH PERFECT: The Orioles have allowed two runs or less in seven straight games since April 29, the longest such stretch since an eight-gamer from August 1-9, 1980...During that time, the team has a 1.14 ERA (8 ER/63.0 IP), almost a full run better than the Dodgers (2.08), who are second...O's hurlers have held opponents to a .154/.216/.238 (33-for-214) slash line with nine extra-base hits (4-2B, 3B, 4 HR) over that period.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 54 home runs, tied with the 2012 club for the most homers through the first 34 games in 0's history...The most long balls through Baltimore's first 34 games of a season is 56 by the 2012 team; the Birds also hit at least 54 homers through the first 35 games in 1987(55) and 2016(54).
 The Orioles have an MLB-best eight players with at least five homers: Gunnar Henderson (10), Colton Cowser, Cedric Mullins, and Jordan Westburg (6), and Ryan Mountcastle, Ryan O'Hearn, Adley Rutschman, and Anthony Santander (5); the eight such players are tied for the second-most through a team's first 34 games of a season in MLB history with the 2019 Mariners and trailing only the 2023 Rays (9), per Sarah Langs (@SlangsOnSports).

- BIG TIME RUTSCH: Adley Rutschman enters today ranked third in the AL in hits (45) and fourth in batting average (.324)...He leads the AL and ranks second in MLB in multi-hit games (15).
 Rutschman has hit safely in five straight games since May 2, 15 of 16 since April 19, and 20 of his last 22 since April 11; for the season, he has a hit in 27 of his 33 games and has reached safely in 28 of those.
 Since April 19, he's slashing .371/.389/.600 (26-for-70) with four doubles, four homers, eight runs, 15 RBI, and two walks; during that time, he leads the AL in hits and total bases (42), and tied for the AL lead in RBI.
 He had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an 0's batter this season.

O THE PLACES YOU'LL GO: (3-0) and two in Washington...The club has scheduled off days on May 6 and May 9...At 11-4(.733) on the road, the Orioles have the best road record in MLB to start the season. Ø_⋆ Since the start of 2023, Baltimore has the best road mark in MLB at 63-33 (.656).

- BATTLE OF THE BELTWAYS: The 0's and Nats begin a two-game set at Nationals Park tonight, the first of two series between the teams this season...The Birds will host the Nationals at Oriole Park for two games from August 13-14.
 The 0's went 4-0 against the Nats last year, sweeping the season series for the first time since the teams first met in 2006.
 Orioles pitchers allowed just one run in 36.0 innings (0.25 ERA) against the Nationals in 2023, including shutouts in each of their first three contests of the season; marked the first time the 0's shut out the same opponent in three straight games since blanking the Yankees in three consecutive meetings from August 28 to September 3, 2016.
 Baltimore has won seven in a row against Washington dating back to 2022, their longest winning streak against the Nats in club history and their longest winning streak against the Nats in club history and their Rangers from July 4, 2022 to April 4, 2023.

<u>CITIES CONNECTED:</u> The Orioles and Nationals will honor their respective fans and cities in a special way by taking part in the 2024 Beltway Series: Cities Connected...Both teams will don their popular City Connect uniforms during tonight's game at Nationals Park...To learn more about Baltimore's City Connects, visit <u>Orioles.com/CityConnect</u>.
 Øx The O's own a 5-8 record when wearing their City Connect uniforms (5-7 in all black, 0-1 in black tops/white pants); tonight's game will be the first time the Birds have worn their City Connects on the road.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Gunnar Henderson and Colton Cowser were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's have claimed both awards in the same month...The last MLB team to do so was the Dodgers in August 2023: Mookie Betts (Player) and James Outman (Rookie)...The last occurrence among AL teammates was the Guardians in April 2022: José Ramírez (Player) and Steven Kwan (Rookie).

MINOR LEAGUE AWARDS: The Orioles yesterday announced that infielder Coby Mayo (Norfolk) and left-handed pitcher Cade Povich (Norfolk) were named the Orioles Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for April, respectively...Mayo is ranked by MLB Pipeline as Baltimore's No. 3 prospect and the No. 26 overall prospect, while Povich is ranked as Baltimore's No. 9 prospect and the club's No. 2 pitching prospect.
 Mayo slashed .330/.400/.652 (38-for-115) with six doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 21 runs, 25 RBI, 12 walks, and a 1.052 OPS in 28 March/April games.
 Povich made five starts in April, pitching to a 2-1 record with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and 40 strikeouts; also named the International League Pitcher of the Month.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 102 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in 0's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 338 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his eighth start of the season tonight against the Nationals...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Dealt his first loss of the season on May 1vs. New York-AL... Allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts across 6.0 innings; Oswaldo Cabrera hit a two-run homer in the fifth inning...Half of Burnes' 12 earned runs have scored via home runs...Threw 95 pitches, 61 strikes.

AGAINST THE NATIONALS: Making his third career start and sixth appearance against the Nationals...Owns a lifetime 3.68 ERA (6 ER/14.2 IP), allowing six runs on 11 hits (2 HR) and six walks with 17 strikeouts in his five prior games against Washington.

<u>AGAINST THE NL EAST:</u> Owns a lifetime 6-4 record with a 3.90 ERA (47 ER/108.1 IP), his highest ERA against any division, across 27 appearances (16 GS) against the NL East...Opponents are slashing .238/.287/.402 (100-for-420) off him.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Scheduled to make his third road start of the season... In 2023, he went 6-5 with a 2.77 ERA (35 ER/113.2 IP) in 18 road starts.

<u>NIGHT</u> OWL: Through four night starts this season, Burnes owns a 1-1 record with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER/17.2 IP)...Has allowed five walks compared to 16 strikeouts in night games.

EARLY STRUGGLES: Burnes has surrendered five of his 13 runs in the first inning this season with four of those coming via solo home runs...The four first inning home runs allowed are tied for the MLB lead with Atlanta's Chris Sale and San Diego's Matt Waldron.

<u>RING 'EM UP:</u> Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 89 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 604.0 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank third in MLB (Aaron NoIa – 622.2 and Sandy Alcántara – 619.0)... Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
