AROUND THE HORN

TV ON FOX TONIGHT: Tonight's game will be exclusively broadcast on FOX with Kevin Kugler and Tom Verducci on the call.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 3 straight games and a NL-best 13 of their last 18 games since July 9 (2nd in MLB, behind the Red Sox/16).

- Since July 9, the D-backs' 9 road wins are tied for the most in MLB with the Yankees.
- The D-backs currently hold the second NL Wild Card spot, 5.0 games behind the Cubs, and 1.0 game ahead of the Phillies (WC3), 2.0 games ahead of the Padres, 2.5 of the Marlins, and 3.5 of the Pirates and Nationals.
- The D-backs look to become the sixth team in 2026 to win 20+ series, to join the Dodgers (24), Brewers (23), Braves (23), Rays (20) and Nationals (20).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 27 straight games, MLB's longest active streak, and a franchise-high 46 straight starts since June 2 (C: 36, DH: 10), MLB's longest active starts streak (second-longest this season, behind 48 straight starts by Nick Kurtz/ATH from April 3-May 25).
- **Kohl Drake** is making his third career start.

LAST GAME: The D-backs earned a 4-1 series opening win @ Guardians after trailing 1-0 thru 7.0 innings.

- Was the D-backs' fifth comeback win after trailing after the seventh, tied for third most in MLB (also: 6 others), behind the Rockies (8) and Tigers (7).
- Was the D-backs' third comeback win after trailing after the seventh before scoring 4+ runs in an inning, tied for most in MLB with the Padres and Blue Jays.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** (2-for-4, RBI), in the eighth, hit a game-tying 1-out, RBI single with the bases loaded.
- **Gabriel Moreno** (1-for-3, RBI) followed Perdomo with a go-ahead, 2-RBI single to right field before **Ketel Marte** (1-for-3, RBI) tacked on a third straight RBI single to make it a 4-1 game.
- **Mitch Bratt** (ND, 1 ER in 5.0 IP, 3 H, 4 BB, 2 K) held it to a 1-0 game, allowing just 2 singles and 1 double with 5 stranded baserunners.
- D-backs' relievers **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP), **Jonathan Loaisiga** (W, 1.0 IP), **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP) and **Brandyn Garcia** (SV, 1.0 IP) combined for 4.0 hitless innings.

THE FINAL LEG: The D-backs are on their final leg of their longest road trip, in games [10 total], this season: 1-0 @ Cardinals, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates and currently 1-0 @ Guardians this weekend.

- This is their second 11-day, 9+-game roadie (also: April 6-15 @ Mets, Phillies, Orioles).

RECORD VS. LEFTY STARTERS: Vs. opposing lefty starters, the D-backs' .654 win pct. (17-9) ranks second in MLB, behind the Rays (.688, 22-10).

- The D-backs are 8-4 vs. lefty starters on the road this season.

OFFENSE VS. LEFTIES: Vs. lefties, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in AVG (1st, .274), triples (1st, 10), fewest strikeouts (1st, 182), SLG (3rd, .442), OPS (4th, .780) and extra-base hits (8th, 94).

MORENO SINCE MID MAY: Since May 15, **Gabriel Moreno's** .340 AVG is second in the Majors, behind Luis Arraez/SF (.344), while Moreno's .430 OBP ranks third, behind Yordan Alvarez/HOU (.441) and Juan Soto/NYM (.433).

MORENO'S ACTIVE ON-BASE STREAKS: **Gabriel Moreno's** 46-start on-base streak is the second longest by a MLB primary catcher since 2000, behind Jonathan Lucroy/MIL (49 from May 9-July 5, 2014).

- Since June 2, is hitting .345 (58-for-168)/.935 OPS with 10 doubles, 5 homers, 27 RBI, 29 walks (21 K) and 3 hit-by-pitches.

MORENO MEETS MONTERO: **Gabriel Moreno**, in his 79th start of the season tonight, is the second D-back primary catcher all-time with 79+ starts (C or DH) within the team's first 111 games, joining Miguel Montero (4x - 89 in 2011, 92 in 2012, 88 in 2013 and 95 in 2014).

- Moreno missed 13 team games while on the injured list from April 14-30 (strained left oblique).

MORENO RAKING ON THE ROAD: **Gabriel Moreno's** .387 (48-for-124) road AVG since May 13 ranks atop the Majors, ahead of Luke Keaschall/MIN (.372).

- In 34 games since May 13, is carrying a 1.013 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 homers, 26 RBI and 18 walks.
- Moreno and Michael Harris II/ATL (.383 AVG with 26 RBI from April 7-June 23) are the only MLB players this season to carry a .380+ AVG with 25+ RBI in a 34-game road span.

TRIP TRENDS: **Gabriel Moreno**, in 8 games on this trip, is hitting .355 (11-for-31)/.943 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 12 RBI, 3 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.

- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, in 6 games on this trip, is hitting .471 (8-for-17)/1.118 OPS with 3 doubles and 1 RBI.
- **Ildemaro Vargas**, in 8 games on this trip, is hitting .421 (8-for-19)/.950 OPS with 1 double, 1 RBI, 2 walks and has not recorded a strikeout.

STARTER TREND: D-backs' starting pitchers have tossed a season-high-tying 4 consecutive 5.0+-inning bids with 1 or no runs allowed (also: May 8-11).

- In franchise history, there have only been 5 times where D-backs' starters had 5+ consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings with 1 or no runs allowed: Sept. 10-14, 1999 (5), Aug. 8-13, 2001 (6), Sept. 12-16, 2008 (5), June 1-7, 2009 (6) and Aug. 25-29, 2011 (5).
- Only 3 teams this season have had streaks of 5+ consecutive of those starts: Royals (5 from March 28-April 2), Dodgers (5 from May 26-31) and Tigers (6 from April 9-15).

VS. GUARDIANS: The D-backs have won 6 of their last 7 games vs. Guardians...swept the Guardians 3-0 in their last trip from Aug. 5-7, 2024.

- Did not factor in the decision on July 27 @ Pirates (1 R-0 ER in 5.2 IP, 4 H, 1 BB, 6 K) after exiting with a 2-1 lead (3-2 loss in 10 inn.).
- Vs. Guardians, will make his second career start (first as a D-back and first on the road)...tossed 7.0 shut-out innings (W, 4 H, 2 BB, 8 K) in his lone start on Aug. 24, 2025 vs. Guardians while with the Rangers.

- Won his 2 July appearances (1 start) with Triple-A Reno, going 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (2 ER in 8.2 IP), opponent .103 AVG (3-for-29)/.394 OPS, 0.69 WHIP, 3 walks and 8 strikeouts.
