JUNE 22
1966 - In the Dome, a home record crowd of 50,908 fans attend to see future HOFer Sandy Koufax and the Dodgers take on the Astros. The Dodgers win the game, 5-2, but the Toy Cannon, Jimmy Wynn, has a banner day, going 4-for-4 off Koufax with a HR and 2 doubles in the losing effort.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros begin a 3-game series vs. the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre in Toronto tonight...**RHP Hunter Brown** (1-0) starts for the Astros vs. Jays **RHP Dylan Cease** (4-3)...tonight will be Brown's 4th career start/app. vs. TOR, and Cease's 9th career start/app. vs. HOU.

ROAD TRIPPIN: Tonight is the 1st game of a 7-game road trip for the Astros, during which they will visit TOR (3G) and DET (4G), respectively...**Road Success:** The Astros are 10-6 in their last 2 road trips combined...they have posted a 16-12 record on the road since going 1-9 on their 1st road trip of the 2026 season...**Road Raking:** The Astros lead the AL in road batting avg. at .252...they also rank 2nd in road SLG (.420) and OPS (.745) and 3rd in road HR (52) and OBP (.326).

ASTROS-BLUE JAYS: The Astros were 4-2 vs. TOR in 2025 (3-0 at home, 1-2 at TOR)...HOU pitched very well vs. TOR last season, posting a 1.86 ERA (11ER/53.1IP) vs. them in 6 games while allowing just 31 hits in 53.1 IP for a .169 opponent batting avg...Jays hitters were just 32x189 vs. HOU pitching overall last season...**Recent Success:** The Astros have won 6 of 8 and 8 of their last 11 vs. TOR.

BROTHER BROWN: Tonight will be **RHP Hunter Brown's** 4th start of the season and his 2nd since a lengthy stint on the Injured List due to a right shoulder strain (4/1-6/15)...in his 1st start off the IL on June 16 vs. DET, he allowed just 1 run in 5.2 IP on 3 hits and 3 walks with 7 K's in a 4-2 Astros win...for the season, Brown has been strong in his 3 starts with a 1.10 ERA (2ER/16.1IP) while allowing just 8 hits in 16.1 IP (.145 opp. avg.) with 24 strikeouts...**2025 Review:** Brown had an outstanding season in 2025, going 12-9 with a 2.43 ERA, earning All-Star honors and a 3rd-place finish in the AL Cy Young voting.

MAKING THE JAYS BLUE: **RHP Hunter Brown** has had success vs. TOR in his young career...he enters tonight with a 15.0-inning scoreless streak vs. the Jays, which is the longest active streak vs. them...in his last 2 starts vs. TOR, he hurled 7.0 scoreless innings on April 21, 2025 in HOU and 6.0 scoreless innings on July 1, 2024 at TOR (both wins)...in 3 career starts vs. TOR, Brown is 2-1 with a 1.42 ERA (3ER/19IP) and an 0.73 WHIP...he has allowed just 7 hits in 19.0 IP vs. TOR.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: In a pitcher's duel, the Astros edged the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Daikin Park, 2-1, winning the rubber match of that series...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (4-6) earned the win, allowing just 1 run in 6.0 strong innings...**Yordan Alvarez** (solo HR) and **Isaac Paredes** (3x4, RBI) provided the offense.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: Over the last month, from May 21-June 21, the Astros are 17-11 (.607), which is the 2nd-best record in the AL in that span.

RECENT STROS: The Astros have won 4 of 5 and 6 of their last 9 games.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid 1st half to his season, currently leading all of baseball with a 1.067 OPS...additionally, he leads the AL in HR (25), SLG (.640) and TB (181), and ranks 2nd in batting avg. (.322), OBP (.428) and RBI (56)...Alvarez was the AL Player of the Month for May, is hitting .388 (26x67) in June with 5 HR and 17 RBI a 1.124 OPS (.468 OBP/.657 SLG).

ALL-STAR VOTING: **Yordan Alvarez** currently leads all AL DH's in All-Star voting... his 1,974,459 votes rank 2nd in the AL and 3rd overall in the Majors.

YORDAN/ROGERS CENTRE: In his last 14 games at Rogers Centre, Yordan Alvarez has 7 HR and 16 RBI, hitting .375 (18x48) in that span with an .875 SLG and a 1.349 OPS.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has the best ERA in the AL with a 2.71 clip (36R/119.2IP) ...the Astros are also 20-14 since May 15.

OKERT'S O'S: **LHP Steven Okert** has not allowed a run in his last 15.0 innings, which is the longest scoreless streak by an Astros hurler this season... his streak, which spans 12 appearances, is the longest cons. inning scoreless streak in a season since AJ Blubaugh ended the 2025 season with a 19.0-inning scoreless streak...in Okert's current streak, which began on May 23 at CHC, he has allowed just 4 hits in those 15.0 innings pitched.

HADERADE: In his 8 appearances since coming of the IL on June 3, opponents are just 2x26 off **LHP Josh Hader**...Hader has posted a 1.13 ERA (1ER/8IP) and is 5-for-5 in save opportunities (.077 opp. avg., .038 WHIP).

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros have committed the fewest errors (29) and own the best fielding percentage (.989) in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in 78 games.

POSITIVE IMPACT: Since **SS Jeremy Peña** returned to the lineup on May 18, the Astros have gone 18-13, while Peña has hit .293 (34x116) with 5 doubles, 6 homers and 18 RBI in 31 games...prior to that date, Peña played in only 10 of the Astros first 48 games of the season, with the Astros going 19-29 in those contests.

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters have won a Major League-leading 51 ABS challenges on the season and also lead the Majors in ABS challenge success rate (58%)...**3B Isaac Paredes** (8-for-8) is tied for the most successful challenges in the Majors without losing one...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 12-of-17 challenges (71%), ranking T-2nd in the Majors in successful challenges.

ROSTER MOVE: **RHP Bryan Abreu** has been placed on the restricted list, effective today...**RHP Logan VanWey** has been recalled from Triple A Sugar Land and will join the Major League club today.

LAST START, JUNE 16 vs. DET: Made his Major League return from the IL on Tuesday in Houston against his hometown Tigers...had a strong start, working 5.2 innings of 1-run ball, working around 3 hits and 3 walks with 7 strikeouts...tossed 92 pitches (53 strikes)...left the game in a 1-1 ties in the Astros eventual 4-2 win.

THE DIESEL: The Astros 2026 Opening Day starter, Brown has been limited to just 3 Major League starts on the season due to a 2-plus monthlong IL stint due to a right shoulder strain...when on the field, he has performed at an All-Star level in his limited duty, going 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2ER/16.1IP) with 24 strikeouts in his 16.1 innings and a .145 (8x55) opponent average...has been on the Astros active roster for 12 games this season, in which Houston has gone 9-3.

ON THE MEND: After his 2nd start of the season, was placed on the 15-day IL on April 2 with a right shoulder strain...on the way back, he made 4 rehab appearances between Double A and Triple A...combined for a 1.88 ERA (3ER/14.1IP) with 21 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.77 WHIP and a .157 opponent average.

VS. THE JAYS: Has faced the Jays once in each of the last 3 seasons (2023-25), going 2-1 with a 1.42 ERA (3ER/19IP) in those games...has allowed just 7 hits in those games for a .111 (7x63) opponent average...last faced them on April 21, 2025 in Houston and earned the win after tossing 7.0 shutout inning in the Astros 7-0 win

ALL-STAR SEASON: A 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...in 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)...among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration.

MIXING IT UP: Has changed his repertoire over the course of his career, which resulted in a huge turnaround over the last 2 seasons...many coaches and teammates have worked with Brown, none more so than former teammate **Alex Bregman**, who suggested Brown incorporate a running sinker into his arsenal to keep right-handed hitters from leaning out over the plate... while the sinker does not grade out analytically as well as his other offerings, it compliments his offerings perfectly...prior to the change, Brown owned a 5.10 ERA in 41 games.

MULTI-INNING MAN: Leads AL relievers and ranks 2nd among MLB relievers with 47.2 innings pitched this season...a starter throughout his MiLB career, he has 17 multi-inning outings among his 30 apps. this season...also ranks 7th among AL relievers in strikeouts (44).

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Along with leading AL relievers in innings, ranks 7th in K's (44), 11th in opponent average (.196) and 11th in H/9 (6.23) (min. 30 IP).

CHANGING THINGS UP: Has tossed his changeup at a 20.5-percent rate...used his changeup at a 19.3-percent rate as a rookie in 2025...has held opponents to a .154 average (6x39) with his changeup this season.

INHERITANCE: Has stranded 12 of 13 inherited runners this season for a 7.7% inherited runners scored rate.

REVERSE SPLIT: Has held left-handed hitters to a .151 average (13x86) with 26 strikeouts this season.
