LAST GAME: The D-backs won 8-0 vs. Rockies last night for their third shutout victory.

- **Corbin Burnes** won his third straight game after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with a season-high 10 strikeouts.
- **Gabriel Moreno** went 3-for-3 with 2 doubles, 1 RBI and 1 walk...reached base a season-best 4 times and recorded his second 3-hit game.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** went 1-for-2 with 1 double, 3 RBI, 1 walk and 1 sacrifice fly.
- Eugenio Suárez went 1-for-3 with 3 RBI and 1 sacrifice fly.
- Corbin Carroll, Josh Naylor and Randal Grichuk each had multi-hit games.
- Kevin Ginkel, Kendall Graveman and Scott Mc-Gough combined for 3.0 hitless innings.

NLWEST STRETCH: The D-backs are 5-3 in a 13-game stretch vs. NL West's Rockies (3 G; 1-0), Dodgers (7 G, 2-2; May 19-21) and Giants (3 G; 2-1).

AMONG LEGENDS: Corbin Carroll (54 H, 14 HR, 5 3B) is the eighth player in modern day history (since 1900) to collect 50+ hits, 14+ homers and 5+ triples within their first 45 games of a season, joining Eddie Mathews/ATL (1959), Willie Mays/SF (1954), Ival Goodman/CIN (1938), Hank Greenberg/DET (1937), Jimmie Foxx/PHI (1932), Wally Berger/ATL (1930) and Babe Ruth/NYY (1928, '21).

CARROLL AMONG THE BEST: Corbin Carroll, among the Majors, ranks in triples (T-1st, 5), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 28), total bases (3rd, 115), runs (3rd, 37), SLG (4th, .612), homers (T-4th, 14), OPS (6th, .971) and hits (T-8th, 54).

- His career-high-tying 3 multi-homer games are tied for most in the Majors (also: Tyler Soderstrom/ATH and Kyle Stowers/MIA).
- His 18 multi-hit games are most in the NL and tied for third in MLB (also: Bo Bichette/TOR), behind Aaron Judge/NYY (22) and Paul Goldschmidt/NYY (20).

VS. ROX: The D-backs are 14-2 in their last 16 games @ Chase Field since Aug. 7, 2022 and outscored the Rockies, 107-49, in that span.

• Have gone 8-1 @ Chase since Sept. 6, 2023 and won their last 5 games...D-backs' offense is hitting a combined .320 with 24 doubles, 1 triple, 10 homers, 66 RBI and 11 stolen bases in the span.

OFFENSE VS. ROX: Corbin Carroll has a 10-game hit streak
 Since April 8, 2024, batting .325 (13-for-40)/1.126 OPS
 with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 3 homers, 4 RBI and 6 walks.
 Gabriel Moreno, in his last 8 games since March

- **Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 8 games since March 28, 2024, is hitting .419 (13-for-31)/1.051 OPS with 5 doubles, 6 RBI and 3 walks, including 4 straight multi-hit efforts.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in his last 12 games since Sept. 4, 2023, is batting .333 (17-for-51)/1.048 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 16 RBI and 3 walks, including 6 multi-hit efforts.
- Josh Naylor, in his last 11 games since Aug. 30, 2020, is hitting .366 (15-for-41)/1.186 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 1 walk.
- **Eugenio Suárez**, in his last 8 home games since March 28, 2024, is hitting .370 (10-for-27)/1.073 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 12 RBI and 2 walks.

TEAM HIT STREAKS: The D-backs have 10+ hits in 3 straight games...the last time they did so in 4 straight games was from Sept. 7-11, 2024.

The D-backs are 9-4 when recording 10+ a game.

SNAKES ON THE BASES: Last night, the D-backs recorded their second game with 4+ stolen bases (last: 4 on April 17 @ Marlins).

• The D-backs' 6 games with 3+ stolen bases are tied for fifth in the Majors (also: Reds), behind the Brewers (7), Cubs (7), Mariners (7) and Rays (7).

TO SACRIFICE: The D-backs' 19 sacrifice flies are most in the Majors, ahead of the Guardians (18) and Yankees (18).

- Geraldo Perdomo's 6 sac flies are most in MLB and Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 4 are tied for fifth (also: 6 others).
- The D-backs and Yankees are the only clubs to have multiple players with 4+ sac flies.

SOMETHING EXTRA: The D-backs' 34 games with 3+ extra-base hits lead the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (31), Mets (29) and Yankees (26).

- The D-backs have recorded 3+ extra-base hits in 8 of their last 10 games (since May 6).
- With 2 outs, the D-backs' 52 extra-base hits are most in the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (51), Padres (51) and Yankees (51).

HERE COMES THE SLUG: The D-backs' 18 homers and 41 extra-base hits since May 5 (11 G) are third in MLB, behind the Dodgers (11 G; 20/47) and Yankees (11 G; 20/45).

AMONG TOP SHORTSTOPS: Geraldo Perdomo ranks among shortstops in OBP (1st, .397), walks (1st, 29), RBI (1st, 34), sac flies (1st, 6), OPS (3rd, .854), stolen bases (T-4th, 10), extra-base hits (T-7th, 15), SLG (8th, .458) and total bases (8th, 70).

 His 8 games with 1+ hits, 1+ walks and 1+ RBI are most in the Majors, ahead of Bo Bichette/TOR (6) and Dansby Swanson/CHC (6).

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (4-2, 3.71)
In his last 7 starts (5 quality), is 3-1 with a 2.36 ERA (11 ER in 42.0 IP), 0.83 WHIP, opponent .195 AVG, 5 walks and 38 strikeouts...allowed 2 runs or fewer in 6 of his last 7 starts.
In 4 home starts (3 quality), is 2-1 with a 3.04 ERA (8 ER

in 23.2 IP), 0.87 WHIP, 7 walks and 15 strikeouts.
