**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**MAY 9**  
**2000 - 3B Ken Caminiti** hits the first grand slam by an Astro at Daikin Park in a 13-8 comeback victory over the visiting Rockies...he hits the homer off Rockies starter **LHP Scott Karl**...the slam marked Caminiti's only career grand slam at the venue...**OF Carlos Lee** owns the stadium record with four career grand slams at Daikin Park.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Astros and Reds play their second game of a three-game series this afternoon at Great American Ball Park with first pitch scheduled for 3:10 p.m. CT...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** is on the mound for the Astros looking for his fifth consecutive winning decision...the Reds will have **RHP Chase Burns** on the mound today.

**MOM'S SPAGHETTI:** After starting the season at Triple A Sugar Land, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has been strong in his four starts for the Astros this season...he is 4-0 with a 1.96 ERA (5ER/23IP) with 25 strikeouts, 14 walks and a .195 opponent batting average...in his last start on Saturday May 2 at BOS, he allowed one run on five hits and five walks with four strikeouts in five innings.

**RECENT SUCCESS:** **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land on April 15...since making his season debut, he ranks first in the AL in wins (4), eighth in ERA (1.96), 10th in opponent batting average (.195) and T-12th in strikeouts (25).

**VS. THE REDS:** The Astros have faced the Reds 858 times in their history, their most games played against any other Major League franchise, going 404-453-1 in the all-time series...the Astros went 2-1 against the Reds in 2025 at Daikin Park...last night, the Astros secured the first win at Great American Ball Park since Sept. 9, 2012.

**TODAY'S BROADCASTS:** Tonight's game and every game this road trip will be televised by Space City Home Network with **Todd Kalas, Steve Sparks** and **Julia Morales** on the call...the game will also air on SportsTalk 790 with **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder** behind the mic...lastly, the game will air in Spanish on TUDN 102.9 FM with **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on the call.

**LAST NIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros shut out the Reds, 10-0, last night at Great American Ball Park...**RHP Mike Burrows** allowed three hits and one walk with six strikeouts in seven scoreless innings...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x4, HR, 2 RBI), **LF Zach Dezenzo** (1x3, HR, 2 RBI), **LF Zach Cole** (1x1, HR, 3 RBI) and **C Christian Vázquez** (1x4, HR, RBI) each homered for the Astros...**RHP AJ Blubaugh** (1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 K) and **RHP Logan VanWey** (1.0 IP, 1 H, 2 K) each tossed a scoreless inning out of the bullpen.

**NO. 600:** **IF Isaac Paredes** played in his 600th career game last night at CIN...he became the 14th Mexican-born player to reach this milestone, joining players like **IF Vinny Castilla**, **IF Hector Torres** and **C Alex Treviño**.

**THE ORDER:** The Astros have used 39 different batting orders in their 39 games so far this season...only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the lineup (second).

**OHIONATIVES:** **RHP AJ Blubaugh** and **IF/OF Zach Dezenzo** are both from the state of Ohio...Blubaugh attended Clear Fork High School in Bellville, OH...Dezenzo attended Marlington High School in Alliance, OH and also played college baseball at Ohio State University.

**ON THE MEND:** **LHP Josh Hader** is scheduled to make a rehab appearance with Triple A Sugar Land today.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** The Astros placed **LHP Bennett Sousa** (retro 5/6) on the 15-day IL due to left elbow inflammation...to take his place on the active roster, the Astros have recalled **RHP Jayden Murray** from Triple A Sugar Land.

**AIR YORDAN:** **LF Yordan Alvarez** is off to a hot start this season, batting .324 (47x145) with nine doubles, 13 HR, 29 RBI, 22 walks and a 1.080 OPS (.424 OBP/.655 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in extra-base hits (22), second in OPS, second in SLG, third in OBP, third in batting average and third in home runs.

**CLIMBING THE CHARTS:** With 238 career homers as a second baseman, **Jose Altuve** needs one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen...Altuve also needs two RBI to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach 900.

**HIT PAREDES:** **IF Isaac Paredes** has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games dating back to April 19, a span in which he's hitting .339 (21x62) with three doubles, three homers, 10 RBI and a .947 OPS... additionally, he's reached base safely in 12 straight games, posting a .440 OBP in that span.

**PLAYER OF THE MONTH!:** Announced on Monday, **OF Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Month for March/April for his third career AL Player of the Month Award...for the months of March and April, Alvarez batted .356 (42x118) with nine doubles, 12 home runs, 27 RBI, 21 walks, 25 runs scored and a 1.199 OPS (.462 OBP/.737 SLG).

**ROAD WARRIOR:** In 15 road games (12 starts) this season, **IF/OF Brice Matthews** is batting .333 (15x45) with eight runs, three doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks and a .993 OPS...in his young career on the road, Matthews is hitting .304 (21x69) with six home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.025 OPS.

**HISTORIC HOMERS:** **Yordan Alvarez** is off to one of the most prolific starts in franchise history...his 13 HR through the club's first 39 games of the season are the tied for the second-most in franchise history, behind only **1B Lance Berkman's** 14 home runs in 2002.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** **LF Zach Cole** and **C Christian Vázquez** smacked back-to-back home runs last night in the ninth inning at CIN...marked the first the season the Astros have smacked back-to-back home run last was on Sept. 28, 2025 at LAA by **IF Ramón Urías** and **IF/OF Brice Matthews**.

**LAST START, MAY 2 at BOS:** Picked up his 4th straight win in his last outing last Saturday at Fenway Park in the Astros 6-3 win...worked 5.0 innings, allowing 1 run, while working around 5 hits and 5 walks with 4 strikeouts and 2 GIDPs...tied his career high in walks...also marked his first Major League appearance with 2 GIDPs.

**SPAGHETTI DAY:** The 3rd-year starter has dominated in his Major League action this season, going 4-0 in 4 starts with a 1.96 ERA (5ER/23IP), while fanning 25 in 23.0 innings and allowing a miniscule .195 (16x82) opponent average...leads the Astros with 4 wins on the young season...his 4-game winning streak is the longest of his Major League career...all this came after he began the season at Triple A Sugar Land (recalled on April 15).

**SINCE HIS RECALL:** Since making his season debut on April 15, Arrighetti ranks 1st among AL pitchers in wins (4) and is tied with **LHP Shota Imanaga** for the MLB lead in that span...in the AL over that span, he also ranks 8th in ERA (1.96), 10th in opponent batting average (.195) and T-10th in strikeouts (25).

**SAVANT SAYS:** Ranks in the 99th percentile in extension (7.5), 73rd percentile in whiff percentage (28.9) and 72nd percentile in hard-hit percentage (34.5).

**RACKING UP K'S:** Has 25 strikeouts in his 23.0 innings pitched this season, which included a 10-strikeout game in his season debut on April 15 vs. COL...his 10 strikeouts are the most strikeouts in a game by an Astros pitcher this season and marked his 5th career game with 10+ strikeouts (last: 11 strikeouts on Aug. 11, 2024 at PHI).

**STRIKEOUT PACE:** His 227 career strikeouts are 3rd-most through a player's first 40 career appearances in Astros history, trailing only **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (266) and **RHP Tom Griffin** (233).

**DOWN IN SUGAR LAND:** Broke camp with Triple A Sugar Land and posted a 1.26 ERA (2ER/14.1IP), 0.77 WHIP and .111 opponent batting average, with 20 strikeouts, through 3 starts with the Space Cowboys...on the date of his recall from Triple A (April 15), he ranked 1st in the PCL in strikeouts and 2nd in ERA, WHIP and opponent batting average.

**SEEING RED:** Has one career start against the Reds, which came on Sept. 4, 2024 in Cincinnati...allowed a career high 9 runs in what was the shortest start of his career (0.2IP)...entered that start on a heater, as he had just won the AL Rookie of the Month for August of 2024.

**2025 SEASON:** Battled through a pair of IL stints in his 2nd season in the Majors, missing 105 team games due to a broken right thumb from April 7-Aug. 6, and then the final 26 games of the regular season due to right elbow inflammation...held opponents to a .229 average through his 7 starts, also recording a 5.35 ERA (21ER/35.1IP), 1.415 WHIP and 7.9 SO/9IP...was fantastic at Daikin Park, recording a 2.08 ERA (4ER/17.1IP) and .056 opponent average (3x54) in his 3 home starts.

**ABOUT ARRIGHETTI:** Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School, located approximately 30 miles from Daikin Park...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette and was routinely ranked as one of the club's top pitching prospects in ascent through the minors...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

**FIRST W:** Earned his 1st win of the season last Sunday at BOS, allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 2.0 scoreless innings...was his longest outing of the season and his 2nd multi-inning scoreless effort of the year (also: 1.1 IP on April 15 vs. COL).

**ALL-TIME RANKINGS:** With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 342.0 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (468) and 7th in apps. (330).

**CAREER:** In 330 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (110ER/3412P) with 468 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.32 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
