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THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 at Seattle last weekend, followed by another 1-2 series loss in Kansas City this week...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three against the Brewers at American Family Field through the weekend.
⚡ Despite the 2-4 trip record, the Twins have gone 14-11 on the road since June 15.

CAN'T TURN AWAY FROM THIS TEAM: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 4-3, scoring three runs in the eighth inning for their 27th comeback win in 2026...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and no strikeouts...Royce Lewis recorded the first Twins run with a fifth-inning solo homer...Brooks Lee capped off the comeback with a two-run single in the eighth inning, scoring runs three and four on the night.

FASHIONABLY LATE: Last night marked the Twins 27th come-from-behind victory this season, accounting for 47% of their victories in 2026...seven of their nine wins since the All-Star break have been comeback wins.
⚡ Twins are 3-48 this season when trailing after seven innings and 2-51 when trailing after eight...in each of their last four wins, they have been trailing after six innings.
⚡ Twins had 36 comeback wins in 2025.

KEEP FINDING WAYS: Since June 14, the Twins have gone 25-19, for a .568 winning percentage, seventh-highest in baseball since that date:

TWINS GET THEIR ROLL ON: The Twins have selected the contract of infielder Kaelen Culppepper from Triple-A St. Paul...Culppepper, 23, has hit .271 (80-for-295) with 15 doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 46 RBI, 39 walks, 63 runs scored, 17 stolen bases (20 attempts) and an .845 OPS in 74 games for the Saints this season...he is tied for third among all Twins minor leaguers in runs scored and ranks eighth in slugging percentage (.478)...defensively at St. Paul, Culppepper has played in 51 games (all starts) at shortstop, nine games (all starts) at third base, and four games (all starts) at second base...the Memphis, Tennessee native was selected by Minnesota in the first round (21st overall) of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University and is currently ranked as the number two prospect in the Twins' system, per MLB.com...he entered the 2026 season ranked as baseball's number 52 prospect by MLB.com, number 71 by *Baseball Prospectus* and number 74 by *Baseball America*.
⚡ The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan on the 15-day Injured List with a left glute strain...Ryan has made 23 starts for the Twins this season, going 6-8, 3.65 ERA (125.2 IP, 51 ER), 27 walks, 138 strikeouts and a .239 opponent batting average...the two-time All-Star leads the Twins in games started and is tied for the team lead with 11 quality starts, while ranking second in strikeouts and innings pitched.

⚡ To make room for Culppepper on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Tristan Gray to the Saints...Gray was most recently recalled on July 29 and went 0-for-5 with one walk in three games during his most recent stint with Minnesota.
⚡ To replace Ryan on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews from Triple-A St. Paul...Matthews, who was optioned on August 1, has made 14 starts for Minnesota this season, going 4-8, 5.22 ERA (81.0 IP, 47 ER), 26 walks, 69 strikeouts and a .259 opponent batting average.
⚡ To make room for Culppepper on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Taylor Rashi for release or assignment.

RED HOT CULPEPPER: Over his last 25 games for the Saints, since May 30, Kaelen Culppepper hit .326 (31-for-95) with six doubles, two triples, two home runs, nine RBI, 11 walks, 21 runs scored, a .413 on-base percentage and a .908 OPS.

BORDER BATTLE: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the fourth of six games this season...Minnesota hosted Milwaukee for three games from May 15-17 as the Twins won just the third of the three games.

⚡ Twins last trip to Milwaukee was May 16-18, 2025...the Twins won the first two games which extended their winning streak to 13 games, but lost game three.
⚡ Twins have won three of their last four games at American Family Field.
⚡ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 43 home runs in 33 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent...they have homered 26 times over their last 19 games vs. the Brewers.
⚡ In 10 career games against the Brewers, Trevor Larnach has posted a .613 slugging percentage (2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs) and a .984 OPS.
⚡ Over his last 19 games vs. Milwaukee, Josh Bell is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with 12 RBI, a .578 slugging percentage and a 1.005 OPS.
⚡ In 44 career games against Milwaukee, Victor Caratini is hitting .301 (34-for-113) with an .805 OPS...Caratini played here for two seasons, from 2022-23.
⚡ In seven career games at American Family Field, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .407 (11-for-27) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and a 1.132 OPS...one of his two career four-hit games was here on May 17, 2025.
⚡ In 10 career games vs. the Brewers, Kody Clemens is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI and an .888 OPS.

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis has hit safely in a career-long 11-straight games...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Ryan Jeffers' 12-gamer from July 25-August 10, 2025...Lewis' streak is the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Freddie Freeman (15)...during the streak, Lewis is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, a .707 slugging percentage and a 1.103 OPS...in those 11 games (since July 25), among players with a minimum of 30 plate appearances, he leads baseball in average exit velocity (97.2 mph) and seventh in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage (14.3%).
⚡ Additionally, he has reached safely via hit or walk in a career-high 17-straight games.

THIS AND THAT:

⚡ Ryan Jeffers has reached base safely in 25 of his last 26 games...over those 26 games, he is slashing .280/.374/.538 (.911 OPS) with six doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI and 13 walks.
⚡ In their last 13 games, Twins starters have received a run support average of 1.96...Twins have scored just one run for starters five times and zero runs five times.
⚡ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .323 (21-for-65) with a .935 OPS vs. lefties this season...Royce Lewis is 4-for-his-last-6 vs. lefties with two home runs.
⚡ Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Marco Raya is celebrating his 24th birthday today.
⚡ Last night, in a ceremony at CHS Field in St. Paul, Joe Mauer was inducted into the Irish Baseball Hall of Fame.
