**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles fell to the Twins yesterday, 4-1...**Jeremiah Jackson** had two hits, including an RBI single that opened the scoring while **Colton Cowser** doubled and scored for the O's...The clubs will play a rubber game today to decide the series...Baltimore went 9-15 in rubber games a season ago.

⚾ **Anthony Nunez** made his major league debut and tossed 2.0 perfect relief innings with three strikeouts...He became the fifth Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to throw 2.0+ perfect innings in their MLB debut, joining **Denyi Reyes** (5/13/22 at DET), **Chad Paronto** (4/18/01 vs. CLE), **Stacy Jones** (7/30/91 at SEA), and **Ed Barnowski** (9/8/65 [G2] at DET).

⚾ **Kyle Bradish** made his season debut and allowed three runs (2 ER) on two hits and three walks with four strikeouts over 4.2 innings...He suffered the loss after surrendering a two-run home run to Royce Lewis in the fifth...Bradish had allowed two runs or fewer in his previous four home starts before Saturday.

⚾ Baltimore struck out 16 times yesterday, one shy of the team's high of 17 from a year ago on May 6 at Minnesota.

⚾ The Birds are one of two teams without a home run so far this year, along with the San Francisco Giants.

**THE WIZARD OF BAZ:** The Orioles and **Shane Baz** agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on Friday that covers the 2026-30 seasons...Baz, who is scheduled to make his Orioles debut in a start today, was acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in December in exchange for four minor leaguers and a draft pick...He made a career-high 31 starts for the Rays a year ago and has been the starting pitcher in all 124 career professional appearances.

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** is set to play his 500<sup>th</sup> career game with his next appearance... Among players to make their major league debut with the Orioles since 1954 within 500 games or fewer:

⚾ His 315 runs scored are the most in team history (since 1954).

⚾ His 209 extra-base hits are second most behind Manny Machado (211).

⚾ His 86 home runs are seventh most.

**HELLS BELLS:** **Ryan Helsley** recorded the fastest pitch of the MLB season on Thursday, a 101.9 mph ball to Matt Wallner in the ninth inning...He's the fifth Oriole in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) to hit at least 101.0 mph, joining **Félix Bautista** (2022 & 2023), **Grayson Rodriguez** (2023), **Shintaro Fujinami** (2023), and **Kevin Gausman** (2015)...In his career, Helsley has hit 102.0 mph 100 times, including a career-high 104.2 mph on September 27, 2022.

**WELCOME TO BIRDLAND:** Eight players on the Opening Day roster will be making their O's debut or have already: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...Nunez made his major league debut on Saturday.

⚾ Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

**FOR THE BOYS:** **Craig Albarnaz** became the eighth Orioles manager, full-time or interim, to win his debut with the team on Thursday...He was hired to be the 22<sup>nd</sup> manager in Orioles history and 19<sup>th</sup> full-time manager on October 27, 2025..."Alby" joins Baltimore from the Cleveland Guardians where he served as bench coach (2024) and associate manager (2025) under Stephen Vogt, who won American League Manager of the Year both seasons...Albarnaz also worked under Gabe Kapler with the San Francisco Giants as bullpen coach from 2020-23 after spending his first five seasons as a minor league coach in various roles in the Tampa Bay Rays organization.

⚾ New to the coaching staff is **Jason Bourgeois** (First Base Coach), **Miguel Cairo** (Infield Coach), **Hank Conger** (Bullpen Coach), **Donnie Ecker** (Bench Coach), **Dustin Lind** (Hitting Coach), **Brady North** (Assistant Hitting Coach), and **Joe Singley** (Field Coordinator/Catching Coach).

⚾ **Buck Britton** (Third Base Coach), **Drew French** (Pitching Coach), **Ryan Klimek** (Pitching Strategy Coach), and **Mitch Plassmeyer** (Assistant Pitching Coach) all return to the staff.

**SEEING DOUBLE:** The Orioles and Twins are meeting for the first three of six games against each other this season this weekend at Oriole Park...The clubs match up at Target Field from August 10-12...Last year, Baltimore was swept in the season series (0-6) by Minnesota for the fourth time since the Twins moved to the Twin Cities in 1961, joining 2019 (0-6), 2015 (0-7), and 2007 (0-7)...The O's went 13-6 (.684) against Minnesota from 2022-24.

⚾ **Ryan Mountcastle** has hit in 18 straight games against the Twins, the longest hitting streak against Minnesota in team history...Mountcastle's stretch began May 4, 2022, and he's slashing .409/.414/.682 (27-for-66) with nine doubles and three homers during that period.

⚾ Twins Hall of Fame General Manager **Andy MacPhail**, who led Minnesota to two World Championships, served as Baltimore's President of Baseball Operations from 2007 to 2011.

⚾ On April 15, 2000, **Cal Ripken, Jr.** singled at the Metrodome off Hector Carrasco for his 3,000<sup>th</sup> career hit.

⚾ Former All-Star **Justin Morneau** is the only Twin to hit a home run onto Eutaw Street, which he did on July 25, 2004, off Daniel Cabrera.

March 29, 1984	- While the Orioles are at Spring Training in Miami, their co-tenants at Memorial Stadium, the NFL's Colts, pack up in the middle of the night and move unannounced to Indianapolis. The football team's exit creates an urgency for a new baseball park to keep the Orioles from leaving, and an agreement is reached four years later for the construction of Camden Yards.

**NEW KID IN TOWN:** Baz is scheduled to make his first start as an Oriole today vs. the Twins after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...Over three Grapefruit League starts this spring, Baz went 0-1 with a 2.61 ERA (3 ER/10.1 IP) on five hits, four walks, and 14 strikeouts.

⚾ The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on Friday that covers the 2026-30 seasons...The 26-year-old right hander made a career-high 31 starts for the Rays a year ago and has been the starting pitcher in all 124 of his career professional appearances.

**TWIN CITIES:** Baz has faced Minnesota only once in his career on June 11, 2022, at Target Field, where he suffered the loss for Tampa Bay after allowing five runs over 2.1 innings with three hits (1 HR), three walks, and two strikeouts.

⚾ In eight career starts against the AL Central, Baz is 2-5 with a 7.02 ERA (33 ER/42.1 IP), which is his highest mark against any division by over a run (5.97 vs. NL Central).

**FAST AND FURIOUS:** Last season, Baz's 97.0 mph average fastball velocity was fifth fastest in the AL and ninth fastest in the majors among qualified pitchers...He threw the pitch 43.9% (1,194 P) of the time in 2025, making it his most-used pitch.

⚾ Baz backed up his fastball last season with a knuckle-curve that registered 86 strikeouts, the most on any knuckle-curve in the majors and third most on a pitcher's curveball of any type, trailing curves belonging to HOU's Framber Valdez (121) and BAL/DET/ATL's Charlie Morton (89).

**THE DISTANCE:** Baz was one of three Rays starters to remain active all season, along with Ryan Pepiot and Drew Rasmussen...Five of his 31 starts last year went 7.0+ innings, tying Zack Littell for the club lead...That included a start on June 26 at Kansas City, when he tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in a winning effort...Marked the first start of 8.0 scoreless innings or more by a Rays pitcher since Tyler Glasnow on May 26, 2021 vs. Kansas City.

**CAREER RECAP:** Made 31 starts with the Rays in 2025, going 10-12 with a 4.87 ERA (26 ER/166.1 IP) on 158 hits (26 HR), 64 walks, nine hit batters, three wild pitches, and 176 strikeouts...Set career highs in starts, wins, strikeouts, innings, and quality starts (11).

⚾ Went 4-3 in 2024 with a 3.06 ERA (27 ER/79.1 IP) across 14 starts with Tampa Bay in his return from Tommy John surgery, which he underwent on September 28, 2022.

⚾ On September 20, 2021 vs. Toronto, made his major league debut at 22 years, 95 days old and earned the victory, becoming the third-youngest Ray to start and win his MLB debut behind Scott Kazmir (20y-212d) on August 23, 2004 at Seattle and Joe Kennedy (22y-013d) on June 6, 2001 at Toronto.

⚾ Became the second pitcher in MLB history to start a Postseason game with three or fewer career regular season appearances up to that point on October 8, 2021 vs. Boston, joining TB's Matt Moore in Game 1 of the 2011 ALDS at Texas

⚾ Pitched for Team USA in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics (7/30-8/7/21) and won a silver medal.

⚾ On August 14, 2018, traded from the Pittsburgh Pirates to the Rays as a player to be named of the July 31, 2018 deal that sent RHP Tyler Glasnow and OF Austin Meadows to Tampa Bay in exchange for RHP Chris Archer.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Picked up the win on Monday at Washington with 2.0 scoreless innings and one strikeout in relief of starter Shane Baz...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (3 GS) this spring and went 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) on nine hits (1 HR), eight walks, and 10 strikeouts.

**vs. TEXAS:** Set to make his 14<sup>th</sup> career start (18<sup>th</sup> appearance) against the Rangers, going 5-3 with a 3.77 ERA (32 ER/76.1 IP) vs. Texas with five quality starts...Bassitt holds a 2-2 record and 3.20 ERA (14 ER/39.1 IP) against the Rangers when pitching in his home ballpark.
