**REVERSE THE DERBY CURSE: INF Trey Mancini** has hit safely in nine-straight games, six being multi-hit games, and is batting .366/.395/.659 (15-for-41) since the All-Star Break...His 15 hits are tied for the third-most in the AL since the break.

- ⚾ His nine-game hitting streak is tied for the third-longest of his career; longest since an 11-game hitting streak from September 13-24, 2019...His career-long is 17 games (September 11-29, 2017).
- ⚾ Mancini has recorded an extra-base hit in five-straight games, tied for the longest active streak in the majors (**Votto**, CIN and **Winker**, CIN)...It is tied for the longest extra-base-hit-streak of his career, also: August 25-29, 2018.
- ⚾ Mancini's 37 barrels are the eighth-most in the AL and tied for the 13<sup>th</sup>-most in the majors.

**LET ME TELL YOU ABOUT MY BEST FRIEND: OF Cedric Mullins** and **OF Austin Hays** each recorded a home run in last night's game, second time this season they've homered in the same game (April 30 at OAK)...The two have recorded extra-base hits in the same game four times since the All-Star Break and 11 total times this season.

- ⚾ Hays and Mullins have both hit five doubles in 10 games since the break, tied for the most doubles in the American League and the fourth-most in the majors...Hays' eight doubles in July (18 G) are tied for the most in the AL.
- ⚾ Hays has recorded an extra-base hit in four-straight games in which he has recorded an at-bat, setting a career-high.
- ⚾ Mullins' 48 extra-base hits are the seventh-most in the AL, with his 28 doubles tied for the second-most...His 205 total bases are tied for the fourth-most in the AL (**Semien**, TOR), trailing only **Devers**, BOS (211), **Guerrero, Jr.**, TOR (230), **Ohtani**, LAA (232).

**IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: OF Cedric Mullins** is batting .386 (34-for-88) in the first inning this season...His 34 first-inning hits are the most in the majors, five-more than the second-most (**Winker**, CIN - 29); the 34 hits are also the most in any single inning in the majors...The O's single-season record for the most hits in the first inning is 52 by **Nick Markakis** in 2007; Markakis also has the second-highest total of 51 in 2014...Mullins' 13 first-inning extra-base hits (8-2B, 1-3B, 4 HR) are tied for the third-most in the majors.

- ⚾ Mullins is batting .380 (60-for-158) when leading off an inning, with his 60 hits being the most in the majors.
- ⚾ His .319 batting average ranks third in the AL and sixth in the majors.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW: RHP Conner Greene** made his Major League debut in last night's game (2.0 IP, 2 H, ER, 2 K), becoming the 12<sup>th</sup> Oriole to debut this season...The 12 debuts are the most in the majors this season...The O's club record for most MLB debuts in a season is 15, set in 2018...Overall, the Orioles have used 48 different players this season (29 pitchers and 19 position players).

**SECOND HALF NOTES:** The Orioles have gone 6-4 to begin the second half, including winning two of three series...Their .600 winning percentage ranks tied for the seventh-highest in the AL and tied for the ninth-highest in the majors.

- ⚾ The O's have hit at least two home runs in five-straight games for the first time this season, their longest stretch since homering 2+ times in 10-straight games from July 17-27, 2019.
- ⚾ O's pitchers have posted a 4.21 ERA (41 ER/87.2 IP) in the second half after posting a 5.60 (478 ER/768.2 IP) in the first half...O's pitchers have allowed 10 home runs in their 10 second-half games; allowed a Major League high 136 home runs in the first half (89 G).

**HOME COOKIN':**

- ⚾ The O's have committed just 14 errors in their 47 home games, including just three in their last 30 home games (since May 10); have a .992 fielding percentage at Oriole Park.
- ⚾ **OF Cedric Mullins** has hit safely in 10-straight home games and in 39 of 47 overall...His .335 (61-for-182) home batting average ranks as the third-highest in the AL and fourth-highest in the majors.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** The O's will play in their 14<sup>th</sup> Interleague game tonight, having gone 5-8 in their first 13 games (1-2 - MIA, 1-3 - NYM, 3-3, WSH).

- ⚾ The O's and Marlins will wrap up their season series tonight...The O's are looking to avoid being swept by Miami for the fifth time all-time, and second time at Oriole Park (also: August 4-6, 2020).
- ⚾ All time, the O's have gone 9-28 against the Marlins, including 6-14 at Oriole Park...The O's .243 all-time winning percentage against Miami is the lowest against a single opponent in Orioles history.
- ⚾ **INF Trey Mancini** is hitting .353/.411/.647 (18-for-51) in 13 Interleague games...His 1.058 OPS ranks as the eighth-highest in the AL during Interleague play.

**PAPA FRITA: LHP Paul Fry** has faced 162 batters this season without allowing a home run, the fourth-most batters faced without surrendering a long ball in the majors this season; **Adam Ottavino**, BOS leads with 180 BF...His 43.0 homerless inning streak, dating back to September 15, 2020, is the fifth-longest active streak in the majors...Fry has allowed just one extra-base hit this season (2B), the only pitcher in the majors (min. 15 IP) to have allowed one-or-fewer extra-base hits.

**THIS AND THAT:**

- ⚾ Orioles catchers lead the majors in caught stealing percentage (40.4%), throwing out 19-of-47 attempted base runners; their 19 catcher caught stealings lead the American League and are third-most in the majors.
- ⚾ The O's allowed 15 hits in last night's game, the 11<sup>th</sup>-time allowing 15+ hits, with eight of them being at Oriole Park; have gone 0-11 in these games.
- ⚾ **OF Cedric Mullins'** 31 multi-hit games are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and **INF Trey Mancini's** 28 multi-hit games rank tied for the 15<sup>th</sup>-most...The O's are one of six teams to have multiple players in the top 15 of multi-hit games in the AL.
- ⚾ **INF Ramón Urías** has hit safely in 24 of 31 games since April 30, slashing .324/.389/.451 (33-for-102) with seven extra-base hits and 19 RBI in this stretch.

**QUICK HITS:** López's 12 losses are the most in MLB...Has suffered the loss in six of his last eight starts since 6/12...Made consecutive quality starts on 5/26 and 5/31 for the fourth time in his career (last: 9/14-9/19/20); his three quality starts this year are one shy of his career-high (4, 2019)...Claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9/20 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16/20 vs. Washington...Started as a reliever with Baltimore before moving to the rotation on 8/30/20...Originally selected in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Milwaukee Brewers.

**LAST START:** Tossed 4.2 innings of one-run ball on 7/23 vs. Washington with four hits (one home run), two walks, and three strikeouts in the no decision...The home run he gave up in the fourth inning snapped a streak of four games without a homer; 25.2 homerless innings dating to 6/22 vs. Houston...Has not gotten through the fifth inning since his longest start of the season in that same game against the Astros (6.1 IP)...Was his fourth outing of the season allowing just one run (last: 5/31 vs. MIN).

**CAREER VS. MIAMI:** Is facing the Marlins for the first time since making the start on 9/6/19 at Miami while with Kansas City; earned the win through 6.0 scoreless innings with four hits and five strikeouts...Tossed 2.1 innings of relief in the loss on 7/11/18 at Miami while with Milwaukee; allowed one run on two hits and one walk with two strikeouts...Tonight marks his first appearance as the home team against the Marlins.

**AGAINST THE NL EAST:** Has appeared in 12 games (five starts) against the National League East in his career, going 2-2 and pitching to a 2.82 ERA (14 ER/44.2 IP) with 17 walks and 41 strikeouts...Is 2-1 in his five starts with a 2.96 ERA (9 ER/27.1 IP), eight walks, and 25 strikeouts...Two of those starts have come this season against the Washington Nationals, in which he has gone 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.2 IP)...Is making back-to-back starts against the NL East for the first time since 9/9/20 at New York-NL and 9/14/20 vs. Atlanta...Has not earned a win against a NL East opponent since that outing against the Braves.

**LATE INNING BLUES:** López has tossed 4.1 innings-or-more 15 times this season, but has completed 5.0 innings just seven times...Has pitched to a 14.63 ERA (26 ER/16.0 IP) in the fifth inning-or-later of games, including a 16.50 ERA (22 ER/12.0 IP) in the fifth frame alone, compared to a 4.04 ERA (35 ER/78.0 IP) across the first four innings combined...Opponents have hit .444 (28-for-63) against him during their third time through the lineup, compared to .265 (83-for-313) when facing him their first two times through the order...Opponents are batting .500 (33-for-66), with four homers and 14 RBI in the fifth inning alone...His .444 opponents' average the third time through the order ranks as the highest in the majors (min. 10 GS)...Has given up eight runs in the first inning across his last eight starts, after allowing just three total runs in the first inning through his first 12 starts of the season...He had not given up a home run in the opening frame until doing so twice on 6/17.

**RUN SUPPORT WOES:** Entered his start on 6/6 with a 1.94 run support average, the lowest mark among starters in the majors (min. 11 starts)...His 4.31 RSA (45 RS/94.0 IP) is now the ninth-lowest among MLB hurlers who have made at least 20 starts, and third-lowest in the American League...Has received one run of support-or-less in 13 of his 20 starts this season, including no run support in four of those...Is 1-22 in 31-career games as a starter when receiving two-or-fewer runs of support, compared to 9-5 in 22 starts when receiving three-or-more runs of support...Has exited the game with a lead just five times this season.

**SIX INNINGS:** Made his longest start of the season on 6/22 vs. Houston (6.1 IP), his longest start since 7.0 IP on 9/14/20 vs. Atlanta...Was the sixth time in López's career he has pitched into the seventh frame, and he is 3-2 in such starts...His three outings of 6.0 innings-or-more this year are the second-most on the team behind nine such starts from LHP John Means...Aside from Means, López is the only other O's starter to pitch into the seventh inning this season.
