RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a six-game homestand with the second of a three-game series against the New York Mets. St. Louis dropped 2-of-3 to the Chicago White Sox to begin the homestand. The Cardinals have lost three straight and 5-of-their-last-6 to drop to five games below .500, their lowest watermark of the season. St. Louis is 6-10 at Busch Stadium this season.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis opens today in 5th place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee (20-13), and 1.5 games back of the Cincinnati Reds (16-18) for 4th place ... St. Louis is home for 15 games in a 22-game stretch from May 3-26.

BUT WE JUST "MET"?: When this series concludes tomorrow, it will be the last time the Cardinals will play the Mets this regular season. This is the earliest the season series against the Mets has concluded since 2018, when both teams completed the series by April 26.

DEBUTS: When he appears in his first game, rookie RHP **Chris Roycroft** will become the 4th Cardinals player to make his MLB debut this season and second pitcher joining **Ryan Fernandez**. The San Francisco Giants lead all of MLB with six Major League debuts this season.

THIS MEANS WAR: The Cardinals are 4-2 on Tuesday this season, their most successful day of the week. Only Arizona (5-0) and Los Angeles (4-1) have a better record in the National League on the day named after the "God of War".

BIG APPLE BASHERS: Entering tonight's game, **Paul Goldschmidt** and **Nolan Arenado** rank in the Top 12 among active players in home runs and RBI against the New York Mets (see chart left). Since 2013, Goldschmidt has hit at least one home run every season against the Mets, except for 2017. Arenado has hit 13-of-16 home runs against the Mets when his team has been tied or trailing.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE MONTH: The Cardinals announced their Minor League Pitcher and Player of the Month for April. LHP **Quinn Mathews**, the Cardinals 4th round selection out of Stanford in 2023, was 2-0 with an 0.50 ERA over 18.0 innings pitched with 38 strikeouts at Palm Beach (A). Mathews jumped from No. 24 to No. 10 in the most recent *Baseball America* Top 30 Cardinals organization prospect rankings. Outfielder **Nathan Church**, the Cardinals 11th round selection in 2022 out of UC-Irvine, batted .349 and led all Cardinals minor leaguers in runs (17), hits (30) and total bases (44) this month while playing at Springfield (AA).

THREE'S COMPANY: With three runs scored last night, the Cardinals are tied with Oakland, Colorado and Chicago (AL) for the most games scoring three runs or less with 22. St. Louis and Oakland each have six wins in those games, trailing only Milwaukee (7) and Kansas City (7) for most wins in games scoring three runs or less this season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The 2024 Cardinals have yet to post a double-digit run total in a single game with their highest total of nine runs at Arizona on April 12. The longest starts to a Cardinals season without a double-digit run total took place 1972 (57 games) and 1966 (48 games). -*Elias Sports Bureau*

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY - May 7, 1997: The Cardinals offense busts out for 14 runs, highlighted by a nine-run 7th inning, in a 14-7 win over Philadelphia at Busch Stadium II. The 14 runs are the first double-digit run total for the Cardinals, who went 31 games without a double-digit run total. Cardinals home runs were hit by **Gregg Jefferies**, **Ray Lankford**, **Ron Gant** and **Gary Gaetti** in the offensive outburst.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Tommy Edman doubled off **Steven Matz** for his first career MLB hit (June 14, 2019 at Citi Field).

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Adam Ottavino was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft...pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Statton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Matt Carpenter's younger brother, Tyler, played two seasons in the Mets organization (2011-12).

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Mets VP of Amateur Scouting **Kris Gross** was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Taylor Megill's older brother, **Trevor Megill**, was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign, returning to Loyola Marymount (Calif.) University.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals reporter **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeremy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals AGM/Player Dev. **Gary LaRocque** previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 8th start of the season and his 158th career (186th appearance).
- Leads the team with six decisions, but is still seeking his 1st home win of 2024.
- Is facing the Mets and opposing José Buttó for the 2nd time in the past 10 days, having recorded a 4-2 win at Citi Field on April 26.
- Has enjoyed career success in the month of May, posting an 11-7 mark with a 2.87 ERA, his lowest monthly ERA. Went 3-0 with a 1.89 ERA in six starts last May.
- In his 147 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 59-30 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings, while the Cardinals are 22-36 when he works 5.2 innings or less.
- Is 23-24 in his 72 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal, with 42 Quality Starts. The Cardinals are 40-32 in those games.
- Mikolas is an amazing 44-4 (.917 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 58-13 in those 71 games). He's just 8-47 (.145) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 23-54).
- His loss vs. MIL (4/20) was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Has entered his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (871.1), wins (52), strikeouts (640) and games started (147) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** had 35 in 2009 to do so.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is one of two pitchers (**Erick Fedde**) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018 (min. 100 TC).

LAST TIME OUT

- Faced the Detroit Tigers for the 1st time in his career and threw a season-high 101 pitches, working 6.0+ IP for the 3rd time this season in a 4-1 defeat at Comerica Park.
- Retired his final 10 batters faced after allowing three runs in the first 3.0 innings.

- Earned his first career win against the Mets (4/26) at Citi Field, his 17th different active Major League stadium with 5.2 innings allowing two runs. His second straight start without a walk issued, first time in consecutive starts since July 8-17, 2023.
- Notched his 1st win of the season, besting the Padres and **Yu Darvish** by a 5-2 score on April 2 at PETCO Park. It was his 1st win in San Diego since May 10, 2018, and marked the 6th quality start among seven career starts against his former team.
- His loss on 4/20 vs. MIL was his 1st ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Was 2-0 with a 2.14 ERA in five Grapefruit League starts this spring. He led the staff in IP (21.0) and starts (5) and co-led in wins (2) and strikeouts (15).

CAREER

- Two-time National League All-Star (2018 and 2022). Did not appear in the 2022 contest at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
- St. Louis is 81-67 (.547) in his 148 career outings (147 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Has registered 32 or more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) with the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.1%.

- Was a 4-2 winner at Citi Field just 10 days ago, allowing 2 runs over 5.2 IP. It was his 1st win against the Mets since 4/20/19 and his 1st career win at Citi Field.
- Allowed HR and double to Tomas Nido in 4/26 start & pair of hits to JD Martinez.
- Earned his 1st career win against the Mets on April 20, 2019, at Busch Stadium, allowing two runs over 8.0 innings. Faced the Mets again in 2022 at Busch Stadium and left after both he and Max Scherzer pitched 7.0 scoreless innings each for no decisions, as the Mets won late 5-2 with five runs in the 9th inning.
