RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals play the third of a four-game series against the Cincinnati Reds this afternoon. This four-game series will conclude a 10-game "home" stand tomorrow. The homestand began at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., on June 20 against the San Francisco Giants and continued with two games at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals swept the Giants and took 2-of-3 against the Atlanta Braves in a series that included a split doubleheader on Wednesday. The Cardinals are 6-2 on the homestand, the best home mark since going 7-1 from May 17-26 vs. Boston (2-1), Baltimore (3-0) and Chicago-NL (2-0).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the National League Wild Card race. Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis is tied for the most wins in MLB (27) and owns the best winning percentage in the National League at .643 (27-15) with a +22 run differential.

A MOMENT FOR THE BABY BULL: The Cardinals send their condolences out to the family and friends of **Orlando Cepeda** who passed away last night at the age of 86. Cepeda was a member of the 1967 Cardinals World Championship team and was the National League Most Valuable Player that season. The Hall of Famer played parts of three seasons with the Cardinals organization after being traded from San Francisco for LHP **Ray Sadecki**, four days before Busch Stadium II opened. The Cardinals were 254-178 (.587) in games Cepeda played for the club over his tenure with two World Series appearances. The Cardinals will honor Cepeda with a moment of silence prior to today's game.

HALFWAY THERE...: The Cardinals played Game No. 81 of their schedule last night marking the halfway point of the 162-game schedule. Last season, the Cardinals were 34-47 on July 1 and finished 71-91. The last time the Cardinals had 42 or more wins at the midway point was July 2, 2022, with a 44-37 record en route to the 2022 National League Central Division Championship with a 93-69 record.

SACRIFICING FOR THE GREATER GOOD: Last night's 1-0 win by the Cardinals was a victory earned on a sacrifice fly by **Alec Burleson** to the shortstop in shallow centerfield scoring **Michael Siani**, which proved to be the winning run. Since divisional play began in 1969, this was the only 1-0 win in Major League Baseball on a sac fly to an infielder. The last in MLB overall was Minnesota pitcher **Dave Boswell** to Cleveland's first baseman **Tony Horton** scoring **Cesar Tovar** on May 29, 1968. In the National League, Houston Colt 45s **Walt Bond** hit a sac fly to Mets second baseman **Rod Kanehl** to score **Joe Morgan** in a 1-0 win on Sept. 20, 1964. - **Elias Sports Bureau**

MAKING THEM COUNT: Alec Burleson recorded his team-leading 8th game-winning RBI last night. It's the most by a Cardinals player pre All-Star Break since **Yadier Molina** had 10 in 2021. The last pure Cardinals left-handed hitter with eight or more GW-RBI pre All-Star Break was **Matt Adams** with nine in 2014.

ONE AND DONE: The Cardinals enter today's game with 26 games decided by one run and have posted a 15-11 record in those games. The 15 wins in one-run games ranks second among National League teams behind only the New York Mets (16-9) and 4th in MLB behind the Tampa Bay Rays (16-7) and Seattle Mariners (18-9). The National League Central boasts four teams with 26 games or more decided by one run. The Reds have played the fewest one-run games in the division with 21 (Chicago 33, Milwaukee 26, Pittsburgh 26, St. Louis 26).

FLAWLESS: Over the last nine games, the Cardinals have not committed a defensive error with their last coming on June 18 at Miami by **Brandon Crawford** at shortstop. St. Louis opened the season with a team-high nine straight games without an error and matched that last night. The last time the Cardinals went 10 games without an error was June 10-20, 2017.

SAVE CRAVE: Ryan Helsley has converted 29 straight save opportunities since April 1, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the longest in Cardinals history. The 29 straight saves is the Majors longest streak since **Josh Hader** nailed down 32 straight from July 18, 2021 to June 5, 2022. With his next save before the All-Star Break, Helsley will tie **Lee Smith** (1993) for the franchise record for most saves by a Cardinals pre All-Star Break with 30.

NOOT NEWS: Cardinals outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** (oblique strain) began his injury rehabilitation assignment with Springfield (AA) last night and was 0-for-3 with a strikeout while playing five innings in right field. Nootbaar last played in a Major League game on May 29 at Cincinnati and has appeared in 39 this season, missing 42 due to injury.

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiserman** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over two seasons (2022-23).

Sonny Gray pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois University (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois University (1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray's** pitching coach at Vanderbilt University.

Willie McGee (May 10, 1982 at Busch II) and **Steven Matz** (June 28, 2015 at Citi Field) made MLB debuts vs. the Reds.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**, spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Drew Rom was born in Cincinnati...graduated from Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Kentucky...resides in Fort Thomas.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

- Makes his 15th start of the season tonight, and second career start against the Reds after pitching for the organization from 2019-21.
- Retired the first 20 batters in his last start vs. SF (6/23), the second longest start of his career in which he did not allow a hit (4/6/15 vs. TEX - 21 batters).
- Opened the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, is tied for the Major League lead with nine wins and T-6th with 103 strikeouts.
- His 103 strikeouts over his first 14 starts with the Cardinals organization is the most in franchise history. Is the 9th pitcher in Cardinals history overall to record 100+ strikeouts in his first 14 starts of any season. **Bob Gibson** leads with four such seasons (1965, 1966, 1969, 1970).
- Has struck out 100 or more batters in nine seasons of his career since 2014.
- Is 6-2 with a 1.51 ERA (47.2 IP) and .145 Opp. BA with two home runs allowed at Busch Stadium this year. Leads all Major League pitchers in home opponent BA (.145), tied for 2nd in home wins (6) and 2nd in home ERA.
- Yielded seven home runs this season in 83.1 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched (among 2023 qualifiers).
- Has a 58.6 strikeout % on his Sweeper pitch (fanning 58 in 99 plate appearances), the 14th-highest K% of any MLB pitcher.
- Recorded a decision in his first 12 starts to start his Cardinals career, 7th Cardinals pitcher in the organization since 1901 to hit the 12 mark and first since **Kip Wells** (2007)
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); Has 16 career double-digit strikeout games, two this year.
- Only **Jaime Garcia** (0.46 in 2011) had a lower Home ERA over his 1st five home starts to begin a season at Busch Stadium III than Gray (0.93). Garcia had 0.81 ERA through his 1st six home starts
- Ranks 13th among active pitchers with 105 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (138, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (108, T-10th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Carried a perfect game 20 batters (6.2 IP) into the game before Patrick Bailey broke it up with a solo home run to right field with two outs in the 7th inning.
- Has pitched 7.0 or more innings in three straight starts for the first time since 2015 with Oakland.
