## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (19-23) vs. MILWAUKEE BREWERS (24-17)

May 14, 2024 at American Family Field, Milwaukee, WI - 6:40 CDT - GAME #43/ROAD #22 RHP QUINN PRIESTER (0-3, 3.86 ERA) vs. RHP JOE ROSS (3-0, 3.29 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...opened their seven-game road trip with an 8-6 win last night...Have gone 10-11 on the road this year...Will look to win back-to-back road games for the first time since starting the season 5-0 from 3/28 to 4/1 (was the second time in team history the Pirates won each of their first five road games along with 1983)...Have had three

of their last five games decided by one run and seven of their last 15 decided by one run dating back to April 27...Have the fifthlowest ERA (3.57) among all starting rotations in the National League (11th-best in all of MLB)...Have been involved in 23 games against the Brewers decided by either one or two runs since the beginning of 2022 (the most such games between any two National League teams in that time).

**DOING DAMAGE:** The Pirates hit two home runs with runners on base Monday night with Jack Suwinski's two-run blast in the first inning along with Yasmani Grandal's two-run shot in the eighth...Pittsburgh now has nine home runs with runners on base this month, which are tied for the third-most in MLB along with the Yankees...The only two teams with more home runs this month with runners on are the Athletics (13) and Dodgers (10)...Special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

**HIGH FIVE:** Last night Bryan Reynolds recorded the first five-hit game of his career and the first by a Pirate since Ke'Bryan Hayes on June 9 of last year against the Mets...Reynolds' 10 total bases were also the most by a Pirate since Carlos Santana also had 10 last year on July 24 at San Diego... Prior to last night, Jared Triolo was the last Pirate to record a hit in five straight at-bats after doing so from September 23-24 of last season...The last Pirate to record more than five straight hits was Ke'Bryan Hayes from September 25-27, 2020 (eight straight).

**GOING THE EXTRA MILE:** The Pirates have recorded 31 extra base hits dating back to May 4... That's tied for the fourth-most in all of MLB along with the Royals and Brewers...The only three teams to have more extra base hits in that time are the Athletics (38), Phillies (34) and Twins (33).

**CATCH THIS:** Yasmani Grandal has gone deep twice in his last three games while driving in five runs during that span...Since the beginning of 2016, Grandal has the fourth-most home runs (136) among all backstops in MLB behind only Gary Sanchez (147), Salvador Perez (142) and J.T.

**ON Q:** Quinn Priester will make his fifth start of the season tonight after being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis on April 19...The 23-year-old righthander was charged with his third loss (4.2ip/5r/3er) in his last start one week ago tonight against the Angels...The Pirates have

not scored a run when Priester has been in the game in each of his first four starts...Priester allowed five runs in 4.1 innings in his season debut with the Bucs on April 19 against the Red Sox...Since then he has recorded a 2.70 ERA (16.2ip/5er) in his last three starts.

**BEER BATTERS:** Oneil Cruz has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games against the Brewers, going 18-for-47 (.383) with five doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, .474 OBP, .745 slugging percentage and 1.217 OPS...Andrew McCutchen is 7-for-18 with a pair of leadoff home runs against the Crew this year...Bryan Reynolds is a .352 lifetime hitter (44-for-125) with 10 doubles, two triples, five home runs and 17 RBI in 37 career games at American Family Field.

CRUZING ALONG: Oneil Cruz is hitting at a .354 clip (23-for-65) with six doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI in his last 19 games dating back to April 22...Cruz' .354 average since April 22 is the third-highest among all National League players, trailing only Alec Bohm (.372) and William Contreras (.354)...Cruz has also recorded the third-highest OPS (1.031) in the National League during that time...The only two National League players with a higher slugging percentage since April 22 are Bryson Stott (1.129) and Shohei Ohtani (1.062).

**GO JOE:** Connor Joe hit a two-run home run leading off the 10th inning Sunday after connecting for a three-run homer on Friday...Prior to this past weekend, the last time Joe had hit a homer in two straight games as a pro was for the Albuquerque Isotopes (AAA) on June 27-28, 2021...Joe is now 6-for-16 with a pair of doubles, two home runs and six RBI in his last four games.

#### **ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**

May 14, 2023: Mitch Keller struck out 13 batters without walking a batter and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in a 4-0 win at Baltimore. Keller became the first Pirates pitcher with 13 strikeouts, no walks and no runs allowed in an outing in the Live Ball Era (since 1920) and the Bucco pitchers set a club record by striking out 17 batters without issuing a walk.
