**Matt Cain** tossed the 13th complete game of his career in the Giants' 3-1 win over the Washington Nationals. Cain allowed one earned run on five hits and a walk, while striking out 11 batters.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants open up their six-game, seven-day homestand tonight with the first of three games vs. the Nationals.

- ▶ SF is coming off a three-city, 10-game road trip in which it went 5-5 through Colorado (1-2), Milwaukee (2-2) and Chicago-NL (2-1)...SF ended the trip 4-1 over its last five games.
- ▶ The Giants hit .312 as a team on the 10-game road trip, which is the franchise's best mark on a road trip of 10+ games since batting .339 over a 10-game span June 20-29, 2000.
- ▶ SF's 68 runs scored on the trip were its most since scoring 73 over an 11-game road trip July 1-11, 2010.
- ▶ Last night's win made SF 3-3 in extra innings games in 2026.

**TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Logan Webb** looks to make it two in a row for the Giants...in his last start (June 3 at Milwaukee), Webb carried a no-hitter into the 7th inning, and ultimately finished the game with a win, 7.0 shutout innings, four strikeouts and just one hit and one walk allowed.

- ▶ Webb earned the win at Washington earlier this season after allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits (one homer) and two walks while striking out six in 6.0 innings.
- ▶ His most used pitch is his sinker (36.6%, +6 run value)...since returning from the IL, opponents are 1-for-10 vs. his sinker...WSH's .256 average vs. sinkers is 27th in MLB.
- ▶ SF starting pitchers have pitched at least 5.0 innings in five of the last six games and have combined for a 1.97 ERA (7er, 32.0ip) in that stretch (since June 2).

**FIREWORKS:** This series features two of the best offenses in the Majors over the last month as shown in the chart to the right.

- ▶ Overall, Giants pitchers have the ninth-highest ERA (4.46) while Nationals pitchers have the fifth-highest (4.61).

**VS. THE NATS:** SF won the first series between these two teams in D.C. 2-1 back in April.

- ▶ With a Giants series win this week, it would mark the first time that SF won multiple series vs. the Nationals in a single season since 2018.
- ▶ Since the start of the 2023 season SF is 10-12 vs. the Nationals, getting outscored 104-83 (-21)...at Oracle Park over that span SF is 3-6 having not won a series.

**LEE-DING THE WAY: OF Jung Hoo Lee** extended his career-best hitting streak to 15 games yesterday...the streak is also the longest active streak in the Majors and tied for the fourth-longest overall this season.

- ▶ The 15-game hitting streak is tied with a streak last season by **Dominic Smith** for the longest by a Giants batter since a 17-game streak by **Donovan Solano** July 25-August 15, 2020...Lee's streak is the longest by a Giants outfielder since **Ángel Pagán** had a 19-game streak in 2016.
- ▶ Lee is slashing .483/.500/.636 with 13 runs, four doubles, a triple, a homer, eight RBI and two stolen bases over the 15-game streak.
- ▶ His 28 hits over this streak are the most hits by a Giants batter in a 15-game span since **Buster Posey** did so with 28 hits from July 10-August 1, 2015.

**ALL ARRAEZ: IF Luis Arraez** has 80 hits through his first 63 games with the Giants...the last Giants batter to have as many hits through his first 63 games with the Giants was **Nori Aoki**, who also had 80 hits to start the 2015 season.

- ▶ Only four other Giants have started their SF career with 80+ hits in their first 63 games (no min. on PA or AB) with the team in the SF era (since 1958).

**PEN HELP:** The Giants received 5.0 shutout innings from their bullpen in yesterday's game, including **RHP Dylan Smith** recording his first MLB save...the bullpen threw 39.2 innings and logged an 8.17 ERA (36 er) over the 10-game road trip.

- ▶ Seven SF pitchers have recorded a save in 2026 in Smith, **LHP Matt Gage**, **RHP Caleb Kilian**, **LHP Erik Miller**, **RHP Blade Tidwell**, **RHP Ryan Walker** and **RHP Keaton Winn**.

**WEBBMASTER:** Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023... the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Is coming off his best start of the season and one of the strongest outings of his career...Webb was perfect through 5.0 innings last Wednesday at Milwaukee and didn't give up his first hit until after 6.1 innings, the longest no-hit bid of his career and longest by a Giant since **Blake Snell's** no-hitter on August 2, 2024 at CIN...overall, the righty was awarded his third win of the year after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings with one hit, a walk and seven strikeouts.

**VS. WASHINGTON:** Will face the the Nationals for the eighth time in his career and second time this year...earned the win his last time out on April 17 at Nationals Park after tossing 6.0 innings with four runs (three earned) on seven hits...walked two batters and struck out six in SF's 10-5 victory over Washington...overall, Webb is 5-1 with a 4.29 ERA (17er, 35.2ip) and 32 strikeouts in seven career starts vs. WSH...he's been particularly successful here at Oracle Park, where he has a 2-0 record with a 2.25 ERA (4er, 16.0ip) in three starts vs. the Nats.

**GUESS WHO'S BACK:** Webb has been dominant since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29, sporting a 0.79 ERA (2er, 11.1ip) with nine strikeouts, a .105 BAA and 0.71 WHIP in two starts...he had a 5.06 ERA in eight starts prior...Webb landed on the IL on May 9 and missed 20 games with right knee bursitis in what was his first trip to the injured list since October 2022 (low back strain).

**STAY GROUNDED:** Leads the Majors with a 59.1% ground ball rate this season (min. 50ip), currently his highest mark since averaging a career-best 62.7% ground ball rate in 2023.

**GET IN THE ZONE:** Has a few outliers this season that could have contributed to his slow start to the year...Webb's 20.3% strikeout rate this year is his lowest since averaging a career-low 18.7% strikeout rate in 2020 (13 starts)...additionally, the righty has been walking batters at a 7.6% rate, his highest since a 9.8% mark in 2020.

**HOME VS. ROAD:** Is 0-3 with a 6.26 ERA (16er, 23.0ip), a .316 BAA and .805 OPS in four games at Oracle Park this season...his numbers flip completely on the road, where he's gone 3-1 with a 2.97 ERA (12er, 36.1ip), .197 BAA and .587 in six outings...overall through his career, Webb is 39-28 with a 2.98 ERA at Oracle Park (91 starts), compared to a 34-29 record and 3.89 ERA on the road (96 GS).

**TOUGH LUCK:** SF is 3-7 in Webb's 10 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago (they were 16-17 in his 33 starts in '24)...since 2022, SF as a team is 40-72 in Webb's 142 starts, yet his 3.29 ERA in that time is fifth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).

**WORKHORSE:** Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 879.1 innings...the next closest pitcher is Framber Valdez, who has logged 840.1 innings... Webb's 91 quality starts and 142 total games started since 2022 are most in MLB over that span.

**SECOND THOUGHTS:** Batters have caused the most damage against Webb on their second time facing him in a game this season...opponents are slashing .325/.400/.512 (.912 OPS) in Webb's second time through the lineup with 10 extra-base hits (seven 2Bs, 3B, two HRs) and 17 runs...in his first and third time, respectively, they are batting just .229 and .180 with a combined 13 runs.

2026 RECORD: 2-5, 5.49 ERA

- ▶ Received a no-decision in his last start vs. his former team (MIL) in a 12-9 SF victory...pitched 4.1 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on five hits.
- ▶ Will be Houser's eighth game (sixth start) against the Nationals...in matchups with WSH, he's 0-1 with a 2.49 ERA (7er, 25.1ip)...will be his second start against the Nats this year, as he got a no-decision after 5.2 IP (5r, 4er, 7h) in a 7-6 Giants win in Washington on April 18.
- ▶ Is looking to build on a solid month of May, in which he had a 3.81 ERA and a .253 BAA over five starts...will hope to improve upon his 6.97 ERA at home this year.

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 6/4 at MIL; 1.0ip, h, r, er, hr (12 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on May 31 (second stint with SF)...has surrendered seven runs in 3.0ip in three games since his recall and has a 10.50 ERA in five appearances (6.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(*BR00-baker*)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, h (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 1.76 ERA (3er, 15.1ip) in his last nine games.
- ▶ Has a 1.53 ERA (3er, 17.2ip) in 13 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 12 of 22 contests (4.64 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .212 (7-for-33) off his slider, .231 (12-for-52) off his sinker and .250 (4-for-16) off his changeup.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(*HENT-chiss*)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/6 at CHC; 0.0ip, h, r (5 pitches)

- ▶ Has made 11 appearances with SF, logging 8.2 innings and allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits with 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has walked 11 batters in 8.2 innings (11.42 BB/9ip).
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-16 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(*kill-EE-en*)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, k (6 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May but has thrown 4.2 scoreless inning with three hits and 5K's in his last five games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 11-for-60 (.183) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 9-for-46 (.196) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/7 at CHC; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 15 walks in his 19.1ip (6.98 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 64.1 innings pitched dating back to August 14, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-36 (.167) off him while left-handers are 9-for-35 (.257).
- ▶ Holding opponents 4-for-27 (.148) off his slider and 6-for-35 (.171) off his sinker.

### #77 CARSON SEYMOUR ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Slider, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/5 at CHC; 3.0ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, hr, bb, k (45 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Friday.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 4.04 ERA (22er, 49.0ip) and 23 strikeouts in 11 games (nine starts) with the River Cats this season.
- ▶ In his last three starts with Sacramento leading up to his recall, Seymour was 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3er, 16.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.38 ERA (10er, 26.2ip) in 13 games out of the bullpen for SF in 2025...also made three starts, posting a 8.68 ERA (9er, 9.1ip) and .325 BAA as a starter.
- ▶ His most effective pitch last season was his four-seamer...batters were 5-for-31 against it (.161) with eight strikeouts.

### #66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/7 at CHC; S, 1.0ip, k (11 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded the first save of his MLB career yesterday, pitching a scoreless 10th inning at Chicago-NL.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento last Tuesday, his second recall of the season...has made three appearances so far for SF, throwing 2.2 scoreless innings with a walk and three strikeouts.
