Cal Raleigh is aiming to become the first Mariners player to lead his league in homers since Ken Griffey Jr. led the AL with 48 HR in 1999...Griffey Jr. is the only player in team history to lead the league in HR, doing it 4 times: 1994, '97-'99... Junior led the AL all 4 seasons, but never led the Major Leagues.

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 6-game homestand today with the second of 3 games against the Athletics (1-0)...Seattle will also host the San Diego Padres for a 3-game set (8/25-8/27) on the homestand...the Mariners on Wednesday wrapped up a 9-game road trip against the Baltimore Orioles (1-2), New York Mets (1-2) and Philadelphia Phillies (0-3)...tonight's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call, and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** and **KTTH 770 AM** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners yesterday snapped their 5-game losing streak with a 3-2 win over the Athletics...Seattle is 21-15 over their last 36 games since July 11, and 36-26 over their last 62 games since June 13.

• **Where We 'Stand'** - Seattle (69-60) is 2.0 games back of Houston for the AL West Division lead... Seattle currently holds the third AL Wild Card spot, trailing the Red Sox by 1.0 game for the top AL Wild Card spot...Seattle also has a 3.0 game cushion over Kansas City.

• **The Power of Six** - The Mariners own a 42-19 record (.689) when their starting pitcher goes 6.0+ innings, and are 15-2 (.882) when their starter goes 7.0+ innings.

• **Men of Steal** - The Mariners are 130-for-160 (81.3%) in stolen base attempts, 4th-best stolen base percentage in the Majors...Seattle also ranks 4th in stolen bases, trailing the Rays (167), Brewers (138) and Cubs (133)...The Mariners have 9 players with at least 5 stolen bases, 5 players with at least 10 stolen bases and 2 players with at least 20 stolen bases.

• **Programming Note** - Tonight's game against the A's will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** at the conclusion of the Seattle Seahawks preseason game, approximately 6:30 pm...the entirety of today's game against the A's will be broadcast live on **770 AM KTTH**.

HOME SWEET HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE...the Mariners are 16-4 over their last 20 home games since July 4, including going 9-1 on their last homestand from July 31-Aug. 10 against the Texas Rangers (3-1), Chicago White Sox (3-0) and Tampa Bay Rays (3-0)...Seattle is 38-25 (.603) at home this season...when drawing 40,000+ fans since the start of 2024, the Mariners are 14-3 (.824) which is the best record in the Majors in front of 40,000+ (min. 2 games).

100 100 100 100 100...first baseman **Josh Naylor** recorded his 100th career home run last night, a go-ahead blast in the 7th inning...he is the 5th Mariners player to record his 100th career home run this season, joining **Cal Raleigh** (4/16), **Mitch Garver** (6/20), **Randy Arozarena** (6/30) and **Julio Rodríguez** (8/3)...the Mariners are the first team in MLB history to have 5 players each record their 100th career home run in the same season.

THE LATE SHOW...the Mariners have hit 18 go-ahead or game-tying home runs in the 7th-inning or later this season, tied for 3rd-most in MLB, trailing only the Angels (19) and Yankees (19)...**Cal Raleigh's** 6 go-ahead or game-tying home runs in the 7th-inning or later lead MLB...since the 2021 season, the Mariners lead the Majors with 94 go-ahead or game-tying home runs after the 6th inning, with 3 active Mariners players ranking in the top-10 during that span: Raleigh (T-6th, 14), **Eugenio Suárez** (T-6th, 14) and **Josh Naylor** (T-9th, 13).

GENO REACHES 40 BOMBS...**Eugenio Suárez** hit his 40th home run of the season in last night's game, becoming the 6th player to record a 40+ home run season while playing for multiple teams within the same season, along with J.D. Martinez-ARI/DET (45 HR, 2017), Adam Dunn-ARI/CIN (40 HR, 2008), David Justice-CLE/NYY (41 HR, 2000), Mark McGwire-OAK/STL (58 HR, 1997) and Greg Vaughn-MIL/SD (41 HR, 1996)...**"Geno"** is also 2 RBI away from reaching the 100 RBI mark for the 4th time in a season in his career and would join only 4 other players with 4+ seasons of 100+ RBIs since 2018, along with Pete Alonso-NYM (4x, 2019, '22-23, '25), Nolan Arenado-2Tms (4x, 2018-19, '21-22), Manny Machado-3Tms (2018, '21, '22, '24) and José Ramírez-CLE (4x, 2018, '21-22, '24)...over his last 9 games (8/13-c), he is batting .294 (10x34) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 6 RBI, reaching base at a .333 clip with a .980 OPS.

RALEIGH GOOD CASE FOR AL MVP...in 126 games played this season, catcher **Cal Raleigh** is batting .246 (116x472) with 83 runs, 19 doubles, 47 home runs, 102 RBI, 75 walks and 14 stolen bases, getting on base at a .353 clip, slugging .585 with a .938 OPS...he ranks 1st in home runs, 2nd in RBI, 3rd in slugging, 4th in OPS, T-3rd in extra-base hits (66) and 4th in total bases (276) in MLB...Cal is 1 home run away from tying Salvador Perez-KC (48 HR in 2021) for the most home runs hit by a catcher in a single-season in Major League history, 7 home runs away from tying Mickey Mantle (54 HR in 1961) for the most home runs in a season by a switch hitter and 9 home runs away from tying Ken Griffey Jr. (56 HR in 1997 and '98) for the franchise record.

JULIO: HOT AT THE PLATE...in 35 games since July 11, **Julio Rodríguez** is batting .304 (45x148) with 27 runs, 9 doubles, 1 triple, 14 home runs, 27 RBI, 8 walks and 8 stolen bases, reaching base at a .348 clip, slugging .662 with a 1.010 OPS in 158 plate appearances...he ranks 4th in slugging, 8th in OPS and 2nd in fWAR (2.3) during that span...the 24-year-old is 5 HR and 7 stolen bases away from his second career 30/30 season (also: 32 HR and 37 SB in 2023).

I SPEI A GREAT RELIEVER...over his last 16 appearances (7/18-c), left-handed reliever **Gabe Speier** owns a stellar 0.79 ERA (1 ER, 11.1 IP) with 11 strikeouts, 1 walk and a 0.71 WHIP, limiting opponents to a .171 batting average...among relievers with at least 40 innings this season, Speier ranks 3rd in strikeouts-to-walks (6.30), leading the Majors among left-handed relievers in SO/BB and ranking 5th in K/9 (11.81).

WOO'S WORLD...yesterday **Bryan Woo** continued his MLB-record streak to begin a season with his 25th consecutive appearance of 6.0+ innings and 2-or-fewer walks...Woo is also tied for the 5th longest all-time streak of 6.0+ inning games with 2-or-fewer walks allowed in MLB history (also: Hall of Famer Cy Young, 2x, 1904-05), trailing Jesse Tannehill's record 29-game streak from 1901-02.

HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS...the Mariners have a number of exciting promotions on the homestand, including **Filipino Heritage Night** tonight, **Kids Appreciation Day** tomorrow and the finale of the annual **Vedder Cup** series against the Padres (8/25-8/27) ...Seattle is 1 win away from securing the Vedder Cup title and season series against San Diego (3-0)...tickets and more information can be found by visiting **Mariners.com/tickets**.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Andrés Muñoz** recorded his 30th save of the season last night, becoming the 10th Mariners pitcher to record at least 30 saves in a season and the first since Edwin Diaz in 2018, and...**AS YOU ALSO MAY KNOW**...Muñoz has 69 saves with Seattle, tied for 5th-most in franchise history with David Aardsma, trailing franchise leader Kazuhiro Sasaki (129), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Muñoz is just the 3rd Mexico-born pitcher to record a 30 save season?...he joins Joakim Soria (3x, 2008-10) and Roberto Osuna (2016-17, '19) as the only Mexican closers with at least 30 saves...Soria owns the single-season saves record among players born in Mexico with 43 in 2010 with Kansas City.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- 27-year-old right-hander is making his 17th start of the season and his 1st start against the Athletics...is also making his 106th career start and 9th against the A's.
- Is in his 4th season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
- Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record.
- Is the highest drafted player out of Elon University.

LAST TIME OUT...L#6 on Aug. 17 at New York Mets, tossing 4 strikeouts across 4.2 innings and allowing 12 hits, 7 runs, 3 walks, 1 home run in his 16th start of the season.

IT'S BEEN DECIDED...has factored into the decision in his last 10 consecutive starts (6/25-c) with a 7-3 record across the span...it marks his 2nd-longest such streak, trailing a 14-game streak from Aug. 7, 2024-June 8, 2025 when he went 7-7 across the span.

VS. THE A'S...has been the winning pitcher in each of his last 4 starts against the Athletics (5/4/23-c), combining for 23 strikeouts across 25.0 innings...the Mariners are 7-1 in Kirby's starts against the Athletics, including a 7-game winning streak since June 22, 2022...has only made 2 career starts against the Athletics at T-Mobile Park, allowing just 1 run to 9 strikeouts across 7.0 innings pitched in his last home start on July 2, 2022.

HOME SWEET HOME...his 3.05 ERA (99 ER, 292.1 IP) at home is tied for the 3rd-best home ERA in Mariners history (min. 50 GS), trailing teammate **Luis Castillo** (2.77) and **James Paxton** (2.99)...his 7.34 strikeout-to-walk ratio is a franchise-best mark at home while his 1.040 WHIP ranks 3rd-best, trailing teammates **Logan Gilbert** (0.976) and **Luis Castillo** (1.004).

AGAINST THE AL WEST...is 22-5 with a 2.66 ERA (62 ER, 210.0 IP), 29 walks and 211 strikeouts across 36 career starts against AL West rival teams...is 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER, 22.2 IP), 33 strikeouts and just 6 walks allowed against AL teams this season...Kirby went 14-2 with a 2.16 ERA (28 ER, 116.2) and 101 strikeouts to 11 walks across 19 starts against AL West opponents from 2023-24.

GOING THE DISTANCE...the Mariners are 7-2 when Kirby pitches 6.0+ innings this season, compared to 3-4 when he tosses fewer than 6.0 innings...across Kirby's career, they are 44-21 when he tosses 6.0+ innings and are 15-25 when he tosses fewer than 6.0 innings.

BEST IN ALL THE LAND...among active starting pitchers since 2022 (min. 500 IP), he leads the Majors in fewest walks allowed (87), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.64), walks-per-nine innings (1.30), and walk rate (3.6%).

QUALITY STUFF...has tossed 8 quality starts this season and in 4 consecutive starts from July 26-Aug. 12, marking his longest streak of quality starts since his career-high streak of 9 consecutive quality starts from June 9-July 26, 2024...his 9 consecutive quality starts was also the 4th-longest stretch in MLB.

VINTAGE GEORGE...has tossed 6.0+ innings without a walk in 4 games this season (last: 8/12 at BAL) and in 34 career starts, the most in MLB among starters since 2022, ahead of **Logan Webb-SF** (27) and the 4th-most in Mariners history, trailing **Hisashi Iwakuma** (35)...his 41 total starts without a walk are also the most among MLB starters since 2022, ahead of **Miles Mikolas-STL** (40) and are tied for 4th-most such games in franchise history among Mariners starters, alongside **Hisashi Iwakuma** and trailing teammate **Logan Gilbert** (41).

FEW FREE BAGS...has allowed 2-or-fewer walks in 99 of his 105 career starts, which are the 3rd-most such games by a starting pitcher since 2022, trailing **Miles Mikolas-STL** (114) and **Logan Webb-SF** (102) and are the 11th-most games by a starting pitcher in Mariners history...owned a 68-game streak of 2-or-fewer walks (4/3/23-6/8/25), which was the 3rd-longest all-time by a starter behind **Carlos Silva's** 99-game streak (8/2/03-5/10/07) and Hall of Famer **Cy Young's** 85-game streak (5/17/04-7/2/06).

14:0...recorded a career-high 14 strikeouts on June 8 at LAA, becoming just 1 of 3 pitchers in Mariners history with 14+ strikeouts and no walks in a single start, joining **Randy Johnson** (2x: 6/14/93 and 6/24/97) and **Mark Langston** (5/10/88)...his 14 strikeouts are the 3rd-most in Mariners history by a right-handed pitcher, trailing **Mike Moore** (16 SO, 8/19/88) and **Felix Hernández** (15 SO, 6/8/12)...his 14 strikeouts remain the 2nd-most in a game this season among MLB, trailing **Grant Holmes-ATL** (15 SO on 6/15 vs. COL).

A PART IN HISTORY...tossed 6.1 scoreless innings with 9 strikeouts and no walks on July 9 vs. PIT, contributing to the 3-game series sweep and the team's 3rd consecutive shutout win, marking the first time in franchise history the Mariners have recorded 3 consecutive shutouts.

CENTURY MARK...made his 100th career start on July 21 vs. the Brewers, joining 21 pitchers, including teammate **Logan Gilbert**, in Mariners history with 100+ career starts...he also became the 10th pitcher in franchise history to reach 100 career starts before turning 28 years old.

THROUGH 100...his 7.05 SO/BB is the highest SO/BB ratio by a starting pitcher through their first 100 career games since 1901, ranking ahead of **Shane Bieber-CLE** (5.29)...issued 77 walks across 100 career starts which is 10 fewer than any other pitcher who made their debut in the modern era (1901-c) issued in his first 100 starts (**Carlos Silva** - 87 BB), *h/t Opta Stats*.

500 CLUB...reached 500 career strikeouts on June 8 vs. Los Angeles-AL, joining **James Paxton** (563), **Félix Hernández** (539), **Logan Gilbert** (526), and **Erik Hanson** (503) as the only pitchers in Mariners history to collect 500+ strikeouts in their first 93 career starts..allowed just 68 walks to his 509 strikeouts, which are the 2nd-fewest walks allowed by a player through his first 500 career strikeouts, behind **Koji Uehara-4Tms** (63 BB).
