### SNAKEBITES

**U OF A NIGHT TONIGHT:** Tonight is U of A night @ Chase Field, which includes a special ticket package where fans will receive a co-branded D-backs x U of A cap...school mascots, Wilbur and Wilma, will take the field for a pregame celebration that also includes the University of Arizona football team, with a ceremonial first pitch from quarterback Noah Fifita...the University's Vice President and Director of Athletics, Desireé Reed-Francois, will also be recognized pregame.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 6-3 vs. Astros last night to snap their 4-game win streak.

- Eugenio Suárez homered (solo in third inning) in his third consecutive game...ninth time in his career with 3+-consecutive games with a homer (last: 4 straight from Sept. 29, 2024 [final game of season] - March 29, 2025 [first game of season]).
- Zac Gallen recorded his 1,000th career strikeout in the fourth inning (Brice Matthews)...became the second pitcher to debut in 2019 and reach 1,000+ strikeouts, joining Dylan Cease [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- · Relievers Kendall Graveman, Andrew Saalfrank and Trevor Richards combined for 3.0 scoreless inninas.

**SNAKEBITES:** Eugenio Suárez has hit each of the D-backs' last 7 home runs, tied for the longest streak of a team's homers by 1 player in the expansion era (1961), with Sammy Sosa/CHC (Aug. 11-20, 2000) and Mike Schmidt/ PHI (May 3-15, 1979) [h/t @SlangsOnSports, Elias Sports Bureau].

- Against lefty starting pitchers, the D-backs' 17.2% strikeout rate ranks second lowest in the Majors, behind the Blue Jays (16.9%) while their 9.5% walk rate is third highest, behind the Padres (9.7%) and Yankees (9.7%).
- D-backs offense, in their last 4 games with RISP, are hitting .314 (11-for-35)/.457 SLG/.847 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 18 RBI and 5 walks (6 K).
- The D-backs' defense has committed 1 error in their last 61.1 innings (7 games), dating back to July 11 @ Angels.
- Kevin Ginkel is scoreless in 6 of his last 7 games (1.29 ERA; 1 ER in 7.0 IP,
- **Corbin Carroll's** 13 triples are 1 shy of tying his career-high 14 in 2024.
- **Ketel Marte** is 3 games shy of 1,000 games as a D-back.

3-4-5 COMBO: D-backs' 3-4-5 batters in the lineup, since July 1, ranks among NL teams in walks (1st, 27, ahead of Marlins/26), hit-by-pitches (1st, 5, ahead of Brewers/4), homers (T-1st, 14, with Marlins), fewest strikeouts (2nd, 37, behind Padres/34) and OPS (3rd, .857, behind Braves/.944 and Cubs/.928).

GENO'S 85+ RBI IN FIRST 100 GAMES: Eugenio Suárez (86 RBI in 99 G) is 3 RBI shy of surpassing his 88 RBI thru 100 games in 2018 with the Reds.

• Is 1 of 4 Venezuelan-born players all-time to have multiple seasons of 85+ RBI thru their first 100 games: Eugenio Suárez (2025 with AZ and 2018 with CIN), Miguel Cabrera (2010 and '13 with DET), Magglio Ordóñez (2000 with CWS and 2007 with DET) and Andrés Galarraga (1996-97 with COL and 1998 with ATL).

GENO IS A MON-STAR: Since July 1, Eugenio Suárez's 10 homers are the most in the Majors, ahead of Kyle Stowers/MIA (9), Randy Arozarena/SEA (8) and Salvador Perez/KC (8).

- Is the second D-back all-time with 55+ homers in any 162-game span (2024-25), joining Luis Gonzalez (2000-01).
- His 6 multi-homer games are second in MLB, behind Cal Raleigh/SEA (8).
- Since the 2024 All-Star break, Suárez's 56 homers are third in the Majors, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (60) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (60).

7 HOMERS IN 6 GAMES: Eugenio Suárez is the third D-back all-time to hit 7+ homers in a 6-game span, joining J.D. Martinez (7 HR from Sept. 4-10, 2017) and Reggie Sanders (7 HR from April 17-23, 2001)...is the first MLB player with 7+ homers in a 6-game span since Aaron Judge/ NYY (7 from Aug. 20-25, 2024).

- The only D-back with 8+ homers in a 7-game span was J.D. Martinez (8 HR from Sept. 2-10, 2017).
- The last MLB player with 8+ homers in a 7-game span was Joey Votto/ CIN (8 HR from July 25-31, 2021).

**STARTING RHYTHM:** D-backs' starting pitchers, in their last 5 games, are 4-1 with a 3.00 ERA (10 ER in 30.0 IP), opponent .179 AVG, 0.97 WHIP, 10 walks and 27 strikeouts.

**RELIEVERS RECENTLY:** D-backs relievers, in their last 14 games since July 4, are fifth in the Majors with a 2.30 ERA (11 ER in 43.0 IP)...are scoreless in 9 of the games and limited to 1 run in 2 of the games.

The D-backs bullpen's 2.77 ERA in July is currently their lowest of any month, ahead of April (4.26), June (4.99) and May (5.87)...their last month finishing with a sub-3.00 ERA was Sept. 2023 (2.16).

**VS. OPPOSING STARTERS:** Opposing starting pitchers have lasted fewer than 6.0 innings vs. D-backs in 8 straight games, tied for the second longest active MLB streak with the Guardians, behind the Angels (9).

- In those 8 games vs. starters, the D-backs are hitting .335 (55-for-164)/.391 OBP/.610 SLG/1.001 OPS with 13 doubles, 4 triples, 8 homers
- The D-backs' 307 runs vs. opposing starting pitchers are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Yankees (296), Red Sox (291) and Dodgers (290).
- Since July 1, the D-backs' offense vs. starting pitchers ranks among the NL in runs (1st, 56), times on base (1st, 134), walks (1st, 42), pitches seen (1st, 1,468, ahead of Cubs/1,402), doubles (1st, 21), triples (1st, 4) and homers (T-2nd, 16 with Dodgers, behind Braves/17).

AT CHASE: Josh Naylor has reached base safely in 13 of his last 16 home games since June 1, hitting .305 (18for-59) with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 12 RBI and 7 walks.

- · Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 home games, since June 28, with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 home games, since June 27, with 1 double, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks.

MORE ON OFFENSE: Corbin Carroll, when ahead in the count, has an MLB-best 1.976 OPS [league AVG: 1.106], ahead of Aaron Judge/NYY (1.819), Bryce Harper/PHI (1.781) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (1.776).

- Eugenio Suárez, when behind in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2) has an MLB-best 14 homers [league AVG: 2.4], ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (11), Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (11), Francisco Lindor/NYM (10) and Kyle
- Geraldo Perdomo, when behind in the count (0-1, 0-2, 1-2, 2-2) has reached 60 times [league AVG: 18.0], second most in MLB, behind Luis Arráez/SD (61).

### **NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (10-6, 4.82)**

- · Has won in consecutive starts for the first time since April when he won in 5 straight from April 4-27.
- In his last start on July 18 vs. Cardinals, tossed 7.0 shutout innings for his third scoreless start and second straight without a walk.
- Is the first D-back with 10+ wins in the first 20 starts of a season since Zac Gallen in 2023 (11 W).
