**UNDER REVIEW:** Orioles manager **Brandon Hyde** challenged the call of no catcher's interference in the bottom of the sixth inning...Upon further review, the call on the field was overturned.

## ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles defeated the Yankees by a score of 9-6, improving to 15-24 and 10-10 at home...**RF Anthony Santander** hit a three-run walk-off home run in the ninth inning; marked Baltimore's third walk-off this season and their first walk-off home run since August 11, 2019, vs. Houston (Rio Ruiz)...Snapped a season-high six-game losing streak...**2B Rougned Odor** gave the Orioles their fifth hit by a pinch-hitter with a run-scoring single in the sixth inning; Orioles pinch-hitters are now 5-for-27 on the year...Scored more than five runs for the first time since May 9 vs. Kansas City (6 runs)...Turned three double plays; entering today the O's led the American League with 46 double plays.
- **LHP Bruce Zimmermann** did not factor in the decision...Pitched 5.0 innings and gave up five runs on seven hits...The five runs matched a career-high (3x, last: 5/22/21 at WSH)...Has thrown at least 5.0 innings in six of his eight starts this season...Threw 78 pitches, 52 strikes.
- **RF Anthony Santander** (3-for-4, 2-2B, HR, 3 RBI, 3 R, BB) hit his first career walk-off home run and first walk-off hit with his three-run home run in the ninth inning...Had his second three hit game of the season (also: 5/10 at STL)...Matched a season-high three RBI (3x, last: 5/1/22 at BOS).
- **1B Trey Mancini** (2-for-5, R) has reached base in a season-high 13 consecutive games dating back to May 8 (G1) vs. Kansas City; is batting .360 (18-for-50) with two home runs and five RBI during that span.
- **C Robinson Chirinos** (1-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, R) hit his first home run as an Oriole and first since September 15, 2021, at Philadelphia...Posted his second multi-RBI game this season (also: 4/22 at LAA).
- **1B Tyler Nevin** (2-for-4, RBI, 2 R) had his second career multi-hit game...Is batting .500 (5-for-10) with two RBI over his last three games.

## YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees fell to the Orioles by a score of 9-6, falling to 28-10 and 14-6 on the road...Drop to 18-1 when scoring five-or-more runs this year...Had their four-game winning streak snapped and their six-game winning streak against Baltimore snapped...Allowed more than five runs for the first time since May 12 at Chicago-AL...Were walked off for the third time this season, and the second time at Baltimore; surrendered a walk-off homer for the first time since August 12, 2021 at Chicago-AL.
- **LHP Jordan Montgomery** received a no decision...Pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits with three strikeouts...Allowed more than two earned runs for the second time this season (also: 4/10 vs. BOS)...Surrendered a home run in his third consecutive start...Threw 76 pitches, 49 strikes.
- **LHP Wandy Peralta** struck out Jorge Mateo in the seventh inning for his 200<sup>th</sup> career strikeout...Has not allowed a run over his last seven outings (9.0 IP).
- **DH Giancarlo Stanton** (2-for-3, HR, 3 RBI, R, 2 BB) hit his 11<sup>th</sup> home run of the season and his fifth in his last eight games...Had his fourth game this season with at least three RBI...Is batting .426 (26-for-61) with three home runs and 11 RBI in his last 15 games at Oriole Park.
- **1B Anthony Rizzo** (2-for-4, 2B, 2 R) has hit safely in seven of his last eight games; batting .242 (8-for-33) with one home run and two RBI during that span...Ejected by home plate umpire Manny Gonzalez in the eighth inning.
