TODAY'S GAME: The Giants kick off their 10-game homestand tonight with the first of four against the division-rival Arizona Diamondbacks...the 10-game homestand is SF's longest of the season, and will also include three-games series with New York-NL and Pittsburgh.

- SF is coming off a .500 road trip across the state of Florida in which they went 1-2 against Tampa Bay and 2-1 against the Marlins....the series win at Miami was SF's first since taking two-of-three there in 2016
- A win tonight would give SF consecutive wins for just the second time this season and first time since March 29-30 at San Diego (the second and third games of the season).
- The Giants went 6-7 against Arizona last season with a -10 run differential (48-58)...at Oracle Park, however, the Giants went $5-2$ with a +4 run differential (29-25) ...since 2019, SF is $28-14$ vs. Arizona at Oracle Park, outscoring the Diamondbacks 209-170 (+39).

SLICK NICK'S REVENGE: IF Nick Ahmed will take on his former team for the first time.

- The shortstop played parts of 10 seasons with Arizona, winning two Gold Glove awards (2018 and 2019)
- He finished his Diamondbacks tenure with 854 games at shortstop, which are the most in franchise history.

POWER HOUR: The Giants have been hitting the ball hard this season, with one of the largest increases in solid contact rate in comparison to last year...after finishing last season with a 88.7 mph average exit velocity (22nd in MLB), SF's 89.4 mph figure in 2024 is third-highest in the NL behind the Braves (90.5) and Cubs (90.1).

- SF's +0.7 increase in velocity ranks as the sixth-largest in MLB...its hard-hit rate is up +2.5 from last year, with the 41.6\% mark ranking fourth in MLB behind Atlanta (46.3\%), Baltimore (44.2\%) and Los Angeles-NL (42.9\%).
EARLY SEASON LaMONTE: Although a 0 -for- 1 day yesterday snapped a 12-game on-base streak, IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.
- Wade has reached base in 16 of 19 games this season, and is slashing $.378 / .472 / .511$ with seven runs, three doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- He ranks second in the Majors in batting average and third in on-base percentage entering play today (min. 50 PA )
- In his MLB career, Wade has excelled during the season's first month, slashing .298/.444/.521 in 47 March/Aprilgames with an $18.8 \%$ walk rate...Wade's .965 OPS in March/April is by far the best of any month in his career (May -.798, June .840, July - .734 , August - .655 , September/October - . 751)

GOING THROUGH CHANGES: RHP Logan Webb has thrown his changeup $36.1 \%$ of his pitches this season, with opponents batting .340 with a .420 slugging percentage on the pitch.

- The pitch has a - 1 run value thus far in 2024, compared to the +28 it had last season, which ranked as the second-best overall pitch in baseball (Baseball Savant).
- In his last start on April 13 at Tampa Bay, Webb allowed all six hits on his changeup (Sports Info Solutions)
- The Diamondbacks have not dealt a lot of damage against changeups this season, with a . 535 OPS against the pitch (22nd in MLB).
7TH (OR LATER) HEAVEN: The Giants have hit nine home runs and 19 extra-base hits in the 7th, 8th and 9th innings this season...only New York-NL has more home runs (10) and Atlanta has more extra-base hits (30) in those innings than SF this season (Stats, LLC).

8 IS GR8: SF has eight hits in each of its last five games, tied for MLB's longest active streak with Baltimore (Stats, LLC) ... only the Dodgers (15), Astros (14) and Yankees (13) have more eight-plus hit games than SF's 12 such games this season.

JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee logged two hits in yesterday's game, extending his hitting streak to nine games... he is slashing .333/.366/.385 with two doubles, an RBI, two walks, two steals and seven runs in that stretch (since April 7).

- Lee's 32 hard-hit balls for this season are tied for 10th-most in MLB entering play today.
STARTING OFF NOT HOT: SF has struggled against the opposing team's starter this season with its . 629 OPS ranking 25th in MLB, and .226 average ranking 24th...over the sixgame road trip, SF slashed .231/.265/.370 against the opposing starting pitcher with a $36.3 \%$ strikeout rate.

NO-HITTER ON THE FARM: Three Giants prospects combined to toss a no-hitter yesterday for High-A Eugene, the second by the Emeralds in as many years... RHP Dylan Cumming struck out four while allowing just a single walk in 3.0 shutout innings...RHP Nick Sinacola would earn the win with four strikeouts and two walks over 3.0 shutout frames...LHP Seth Corry would finish off the no-hitter with four strikeouts and two walks allowed over the final 3.0 innings.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension last April that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.
LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his first win of the season last Saturday at Tropicana Field as the Giants blasted the Rays, 11-2...Webb spun 7.0 innings, allowing one run on six hits while striking out four in the 96-pitch effort...run support, which seemingly is an issue for Webb in his outings (see below) was not the case in the Tampa Bay start as the Giants plated 10 runs for Webb while he was in the game.. that total was the third-highest he's received in a single game in his career and most since he got 11 runs from the Giants offense on October 3, 2021 vs. San Diego.

EL CAMBIO: Webb dominated hitters last year with his changeup, using the pitch $41.6 \%$ of the time with opponents hitting .225 with a . 309 SLG\% off the pitch...according to Statcast, Webb's changeup was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at $+28 \ldots$ only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball) (run value is defined as the run impact on an event based on the runners on base, outs ball \& strike count)...in the early going in 2024, it has not been as dominant a pitch as it was a season ago...through four starts, opposing hitters are batting .340 with a .420 SLG\% off his changeup... in his last start the Rays recorded all six of their hits off Webb on his changeup, going 6 -for- 16 with six singles.
VS. ARIZONA: Faces the D-Backs for the first time this season today after facing them four times last year...last season, Webb was 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9er, 27.0ip) in his four starts against Arizona. SF went 2-2 in those games...tonight's start marks his 11th career start vs. AZ overall...he's 5-3 with a 2.80 ERA in his prior 10 outings against them.

TAKE THE RATTLE AWAY: In six career outings against the D-Backs here at Oracle Park, Webb is $4-1$ with a 2.45 ERA (10er, 36.2ip) and 32 strikeouts...SF is 5-1 as a team in his six starts against the Diamondbacks here at Oracle with the lone loss coming August 18, 2022.

SUP, HOMIE?: Webb is $23-16$ with a 2.75 ERA (101er, 330.0ip) in 54 career starts at home here at Oracle Park...SF has won five of his last seven starts here dating back to August 2 of last year with Webb logging a 2.39 ERA (13er, 49.0ip) in that span...Webb has a long way to go to catch some recent Giants legends in terms of starts here at Oracle but his 2.75 ERA so far stacks up with some of the best hurlers to pitch in this ballpark.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 56-39 (.589) in Webb's 95 regular season starts since 2021...SF went 15-18 in his 33 starts in 2023 and gave him two or fewer runs of support in 22 of those 33 starts ( $66.7 \%$ ) ...Webb had the lowest run support average of any qualified starter in baseball last year (3.21)...Webb went 9-1 in 2023 when receiving at least three runs of support. SF is 2-2 in his four starts so far this year and Webb has received three or fewer runs of support in three of his four outings with the exception being his last outing vs. Tampa Bay.


0-1 IS MUCH BETTER THAN 1-0: Webb's first pitch strike percentage is $72.0 \%$ through four starts in 2024...last time out vs. Tampa Bay, Webb's first pitch strike percentage was $74.1 \%$... his career-best number for a season is a $66.6 \%$ first strike percentage from his breakout 2021 campaign...overall, Webb's career average is $64.8 \%$.

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Webb's 62.7\% ground-ball rate led the Majors in 2023, and was up from 2022's 57.8\% mark.. his $62.7 \%$ mark last season also established a career-best, slightly upping his 62.2\% total from his breakout 2021 campaign...through four starts this year he owns a $50.6 \%$ ground ball rate...below is a chart of Webb's groundball breakdown by start so far in 2024.

A RECORD YEAR: Last season, Webb finished second in the NL Cy Young voting behind current rotation-mate LHP Blake Snell...Webb went 11-13 with a 3.25 ERA, setting new career bests in starts (33), innings pitched (216.0), strikeouts (194) and fewest walks in a full season (31)...his 216.0 innings a season ago led the Majors, something someone 26 or younger had not done on any Major League team since Justin Verlander did so as a 26-year-old in 2009...Webb was the first Giant to lead MLB in innings pitched since Gaylord Perry in 1970.

2023 LEADERBOARDS: Outside of leading MLB in innings pitched, and being tied for the lead in quality starts, Webb ranked among the Majors' best in ERA $(3.25,10$ th $)$, complete games (two, T-3rd), games started (33, T-3rd) and WHIP (1.07, 6th).
