**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 1-4 through five games on their six-game roadtrip to open the 2026 season, going 1-2 at Baltimore last weekend, followed by consecutive losses in Kansas City on Monday and Wednesday...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale at Kauffman against the Royals...following today's game, Minnesota will travel home to begin its 17th season at Target Field with a three-game weekend series against the Tampa Bay Rays...following the Rays, the Twins will host the Tigers for four games from Monday-Thursday. **☞** Twins return home tomorrow where they went 38-43 last season...they won their final game at Target Field on September 21 at Cleveland (6-2) but went 18-32 in their final 50 in Minnesota to finish last season. **☞** Today marks day two of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on April 16.

**APRIL FOOLS ON US:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 13-9...Twins entered the game having allowed 14 runs through four games on the season... Joe Ryan was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing five runs on nine hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...Cody Laweryson and Zak Kent both made their season debuts pitching in relief...the offense recorded nine hits and walked a season-high nine times — their most since August 4, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL (also 9)...Austin Martin reached base safely four times, going 1-for-3 with two walks and a hit-by-pitch...Josh Bell also added a home run, a three-run shot in the ninth inning off Bailey Falter, his first as a Twin.

**FOUNTAINS AND LAKES:** The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the third of 13 games in 2026...their next series after this will be four games at Target Field from June 4-7...the next time the Twins will travel to Kauffman will be for three games from August 4-6. **☞** Twins have 196 wins all-time at Kauffman Stadium, their most in any opposing ballpark in their history (since 1961).

**☞** Twins are just 2-11 in their last 13 at Kauffman Stadium...in that span they have been outscored 29-61 (-32)...they have scored 2.2 runs-per-game in that span. **☞** Josh Bell is hitting .330 (30-for-91) with six doubles, six home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.007 OPS in 25 career games vs. Kansas City...he has a .929 OPS in 16 career games at Kauffman.

**AUSTIN POWER:** Austin Martin has reached base safely in seven of nine plate appearances in this series...has gone 3-for-8 (.375) with four walks, one stolen base and just one strikeout through four games this season...dating back to September 4, 2025, he is hitting .310 (27-for-87) with six doubles, seven RBI, 12 runs scored, 14 walks and a .417 on-base percentage...in that span against lefties, he is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with a .436 on-base percentage and an .848 OPS.

**FINAL DESTINATIONS:** Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the first time this season...they were swept six times in 2025: three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15), three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), three games vs. the Athletics (August 19-21) and four games vs. Chicago-AL (September 1-4). **☞** The last time the Twins were swept by the Royals was in three games at Kauffman Stadium, from September 6-8, 2024.

**ONE MORE LEFT AND WE'LL MAKE A SQUARE:** Minnesota is facing its third-straight lefty starter...Ragans will mark the fourth lefty on the season in six games...Twins hitters are 15-for-82 (.183) with six extra-base hits off lefties this season. **☞** Since the start of last season, Byron Buxton is hitting .280 (33-for-118) with 10 home runs, a .619 slugging percentage and a .965 OPS against lefties. **☞** Notables lifetime vs. Cole Ragans: Byron Buxton is 3-for-9 (.333) with two walks and a .455 on-base percentage...Royce Lewis is 2-for-7 with a home run and a walk...Austin Martin is 2-for-4 with a double.

### THIS AND THAT:

**☞** Twins enter today having used the ABS challenge system 22 times, the most in baseball... Twins have won 16 of those challenges, posting a 73% success rate...they have won nine of 12 on the hitting side and seven of 10 on the pitching side...last night, Minnesota set league highs for a game in challenges requested (9) and overturned called (8). **☞** Royce Lewis has posted a .667 slugging percentage through five games played, tied for 13th-highest in the AL among all players with a minimum of 15 plate appearances. **☞** Luke Keaschall has made four outs on balls hit 100+ mph...that ranks tied for seventh-most in baseball.

**NO PLACE LIKE HERE:** Baseball returns to downtown Minneapolis tomorrow and the Minnesota Twins are celebrating with a daylong party for the 2026 Home Opener presented by U.S. Bank... below is a list of highlights for the day:

**☞ Breakfast on the Plaza (6:00-9:00 am):** Fans can drive, walk or bike down 7th Street (adjacent to the Twins New Era Team Store) to pick up a complimentary ballpark-inspired breakfast, enjoy live music and enter giveaways for Opening Weekend tickets.

**☞ Gate Giveaway (1:00 pm):** The first 10,000 fans through the gates will receive a Twins Beanie, courtesy of U.S. Bank.

**☞ Pregame Happy Hour (1:00-3:10 pm):** Enjoy \$2 beers (21+), \$2 hot dogs and \$2 snacks at select stands.

**☞ Olympic Rings (Pregame):** A celebration of the 2026 Milano Cortina Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games...Cory Thiesse, Corey Dropkin and Mike Schultz will throw out ceremonial first pitches...the Twins will also recognize the gold medal-winning U.S. Olympic Women's Hockey Team.

**☞ "The Star-Spangled Banner"** will be performed by Aniya Bostick and Harriet Spencer, who alternate in the role of Dorothy in the Children's Theatre Company production of The Wizard of Oz, running April 21 through June 14.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2010, the Twins opened Target Field with a "dry-run" exhibition game against the St. Louis Cardinals, losing by a score of 8-4...the game was played in front of 32,995...they completed their spring training season with another game against the Cards the next day on April 3.

- Bradley will make his second start of the season and 75th of his career this afternoon...this will be his fourth career start against the Royals.
- In three career starts against Kansas City, Bradley holds a 1-1 mark with a 0.96 ERA (18.2 IP, 2 ER), seven walks, 12 strikeouts and a .131 (8-for-61) BAA.
- Taj opened his 2026 campaign going 4.1 innings, giving up one run on three hits with nine strikeouts.
- Bradley's nine strikeouts were the most in a season debut in his career, surpassing his previous high of eight, which he recorded in his big-league debut in April of 2023.

**GIVE 'EM THE HEATER:** Making just his second career start in March, Bradley tossed 4.1 innings of one run ball against the Orioles in a 4-1 Twins win; he did not factor into the decision...his nine strikeouts were the most in a season debut in his career.

- Bradley's fastball averaged 97.4 mph, up from his 2025 average of 96.2 mph.
- In the third inning, Taj struck out Baltimore catcher Adley Rutschman on a 99.6 mph fastball, the fastest pitch by a Twins starting pitcher in the Statcast Era (2015-present), per Baseball Savant.

**SPRING RECAP:** Bradley made five starts in Twins major league spring training, going 1-1 with a 4.67 ERA (17.1 IP, 9 ER), seven walks and 23 strikeouts...Bradley's 23 spring strikeouts ranked second on staff, only trailing Mick Abel's 27 strikeouts, while his 17.1 innings pitched ranked third.

**2025 RECAP:** At the major league level in 2025, combined to go 6-8 with a 5.05 ERA (142.2 IP, 80 ER), 56 walks and 127 strikeouts in 27 starts between Tampa Bay and Minnesota...made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2 with a 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER), 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.

- Acquired by Minnesota on July 31 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax; initially assigned to Triple-A St. Paul.
- Tallied 13 quality starts over the course of the year, the most in a single season in his career, eclipsing his previous career high of 10 in 2024.

**CAREER VS. KANSAS CITY:** Bradley will face Kansas City for the first time this season and fourth time in his career...has a career 1-1 record against the Royals with a 0.96 ERA (18.2 IP, 2 ER), seven walks, 12 strikeouts, a .131 (8-for-61) BAA, a .164 opponent slugging and a .381 OPS against.

- His 0.96 career ERA against Kansas City is his lowest against any AL opponent and fourth lowest overall, trailing only Chicago-NL, Cincinnati and Washington (all 0.00 career ERA against).
- In his most recent start against Kansas City on June 24, 2025, Bradley pitched 6.2 IP of scoreless ball, the longest scoreless start of his 2025 campaign, and third longest of his career.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Over the course of his career, Bradley is 11-15 with a 5.10 ERA (194.0 IP, 110 ER), 64 walks, 218 strikeouts and a 1.27 WHIP in 37 career home starts compared to 8-12 with a 4.55 ERA (195.2 IP, 99 ER), 81 walks, 201 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 39 road appearances (37 starts).

- In 2025, between Tampa Bay and Minnesota, Bradley went 4-4 with a 5.89 ERA (70.1 IP, 46 ER), 27 walks, 64 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP in 14 home starts while going 2-4 with a 4.23 ERA (72.1 IP, 34 ER), 29 walks, 63 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP in 13 road starts.
- Bradley held opposing hitters to a .215 (58-for-270) BAA on the road in 2025, tied with Joe Ryan for eighth lowest in the American League (min. 70.0 IP on road).

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Last season, left-handed hitters slashed .237/.319/.431 (62-for-262) against Bradley, while righties slashed .249/.314/.375 (69-for-277).

- Lefties posted an average exit velocity of 89.2 mph and a 23.1 whiff percentage, while righties posted an 88.6 mph exit velocity and a 25.3 whiff percentage.
- Hitters combined exit velocity against Bradley was 88.9 mph, nearly two mph lower than in 2024 (90.6 mph).

**THE ARSENAL:** In his season debut start, Bradley threw four different pitches, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.
