**THE WORD ON THE BIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their longest homestand of the first half playing nine games over 10 days with their second opponent, the Texas Rangers. St. Louis is 2-2 so far this homestand against Chicago (2-1) and Texas (0-1), with the second of a three-games series against the Rangers tonight. The Cincinnati Reds will conclude the homestand this weekend (June 5-7).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and percentage points ahead of Pittsburgh and Chicago, also 5.5 games back. The 5.5 games is the largest deficit of the season for the Cardinals.

**JJ CAN PLAY:** Cardinals rookie second baseman **JJ Wetherholt** was named the *Sports Info Solutions* Defensive Infielder of the Month. His 7 defensive runs saved in May were the most among all second basemen.

**LOU GEHRIG DAY:** Major League Baseball, in coordination with all 30 Clubs, will observe the sixth annual Lou Gehrig Day today — a date carrying the significance of both the 1925 game when Gehrig became the Yankees' starting first baseman to launch his legendary "Iron Horse" consecutive game streak, and also the day he passed from ALS complications 16 years later. On this special day, all players, managers and coaches will wear custom "4" decals — designed to honor Gehrig's retired number. MLB will utilize official Lou Gehrig Day lineup cards and special Rawlings base jewels in all matchups, uniting teams and fans across the country to celebrate the Hall of Famer's enduring strength, remember those lost to the disease, support the organizations aggressively pursuing a cure and providing care.

**WHAT'S IN A MONTH?:** Cardinals starting pitcher tonight, **Dustin May**, was an unfortunate 0-4 during month of his name-sake. May received more than one run of support in only one of his last six starts (5/15 vs. KC - 3 runs). The redheaded Texan posted a solid 3.86 ERA in his five starts and is only one of three pitchers in Cardinals history to go winless in four May decisions with an ERA of 3.86 or less joining **Danny Cox** (1984) and newly announced Cardinals Hall of Famer **Bill Sherdel** (1918).

**NICE SHOOTING, TEX!:** Shortstop **Masyn Winn** hit his 2nd home run of the season last night to provide the Cardinals only offense. Both of Winn's home runs this season have come against teams from his home state of Texas, homering against the Astros at Daikin Park on April 18. This season, Winn is 6-for-19 with 2 HR and 8 RBI over four games with an RBI in all four games vs. Texas-based teams. Winn has hit safely in 6-of-7 career games vs. the Rangers with two solo home runs.

**TOUGH ON TUESDAY:** A 6-0 loss last Tuesday at Milwaukee snapped the Cardinals seven-game win streak on Tuesdays to begin the season. Only the New York Yankees have more wins (8) or a higher winning pct. (.889, 8-1) on this day in Major League Baseball. The Rangers have also had success on Tuesdays posting a 6-3 record this season.

**NOOT NEWS:** Cardinals outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** (heel surgery) had his injury rehabilitation assignment transferred from Springfield (AA) to Memphis (AAA) today. Nootbaar's 20-day assignment will come to an end after Wednesday's game and is planning to play a stretch of 4-of-5 games. Through 10 games, Nootbaar is batting .259 (7-27) with 2 HR, 4 RBI and 7 walks.

**BUSCH 100 CLUB:** Last night, Texas Rangers pitcher **Jacob deGrom** became the 16th active pitcher to achieve 100 career wins. The Stetson University baseball alum was the first to hit the century mark at Busch Stadium III since 2013 when Sunshine State native **Zack Greinke** won his 100th game with the Dodgers on Aug. 5, 2013. deGrom (DeLand, FL) and Grienke (Orlando, FL) were born just 50 miles away from each other on the I-4 corridor in Central Florida. Former pitcher **Kyle Lohse** was the last Cardinals pitcher to hit the century mark at home, Aug. 28, 2011 vs. Pittsburgh as part of the Cardinals World Series run for their 11th World Championship.

**Brad Miller** was an infielder on the 2020 Cardinals and is now a TV talent with Rangers TV. Miller is the last Cardinal to achieve a 7-RBI game 9/1/2020 vs. CIN.

**Masyn Winn** was born in Katy, Texas... Graduated from Kingwood (Tex.) High School in 2020...resides in Kingwood, Texas.

**Michael McGreevy** made his MLB debut against the Rangers (July 31, 2024 at Busch III).

**George Soriano's** first cousin, **Alfonso Soriano**, played two All-Star seasons with Texas (2004-05).

**Thomas Saggese** was originally selected by Texas in the 5th round of the 2020 MLB Draft...played parts of his first three seasons (2020-23) in the Rangers system before traded to St. Louis with RHP **Tekoah Roby** and LHP **John King** for **Jordan Montgomery** and **Chris Stratton** (July 30, 2023).

**Dustin May** was born in and resides in Justin, Texas...graduated from Northwest High School in Justin...signed his college letter of intent to play at Texas Tech Univ. before drafted by the Dodgers.

**Michael Helman** played in 18 games for Memphis (AAA) in 2025.

**Skip Schumaker** played eight years in St. Louis (2005-12) and was the 2022 Cardinals bench coach...member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals...selected by St. Louis in the 5th round of the 2001 MLB Draft.

**Jimmy Crooks** was born in Euless, Texas...graduated from Trinity High School in Euless... Played the COVID-shortened 2020 season at McLennan College in Waco, Texas.

**Brant Brown** coached for six seasons in the Rangers minor league organization with AAA-Round Rock (2012), AA-Frisco (2009-11), and High-A-Bakersfield (2007-08).

**Hunter Dobbins** was born in and resides in Bryan, Texas...played college baseball at Texas Tech University (2019-20).

**Julio Rangel** previously served as the Rangers Pitching Coach for two seasons (2019-20).

**Jake Burger** was born in St. Louis...was a 2014 graduate of Christian Brothers College High School in St. Louis...played college baseball at Missouri State University (2015-17)

Rangers Special Assistant to the GM **Darren Oliver** pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1998-99).

**Stubby Clapp** played college baseball at Texas Tech University.

**Ramón Urías** originally signed as a 16-year old international free agent with Texas (December 2010) and played his first two minor league seasons in the Rangers system (2011-12) before being loaned to the Mexican League.

**Brandon Allen** was born in Conroe, Texas...graduated from Montgomery (Texas) High School... earned a football scholarship to Rice University as a linebacker/defensive end and had a baseball scholarship at the University of Houston.

Cardinals AGM/Scouting Dir. **Randy Flores** made his MLB debut with Texas in 2002, pitching in 20 games that season...originally became a Ranger in a trade by the Yankees for **Randy Velarde** (Oct. 12, 2001).

Cardenales Spanish broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played the second half of the 2010 season for Texas after being traded by San Francisco in exchange for pitchers **Michael Main** and **Chris Ray**...later served as First Base/Catching Coach

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 12th start as a member of the Cardinals (69th career start & 83rd appearance) tonight.
- Is making his first start since taking a no-hitter into the 8th inning last Wed. (5/27) at MIL, only to lose 2-1.
- The **Justin, TX native** (Northwest High School) is making his 2nd career start/appearance against the Rangers, last doing so on 8/28/20 at Globe Life Field while pitching for the LA Dodgers.
- Has received one run of support or fewer in five of his last six starts (April 27-present), and a total of just seven runs in his last six starts.
- Pitched 6.0 innings in every start over a four-game stretch (April 27-May 15), the longest streak of his career and tying **Michael McGreevy** for the longest by a Cardinal this season. All were quality starts.
- Has four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, T-2nd (also **Matthew Liberatore**) among Major League pitchers behind **Michael King** (SD) with six.
- Issued just one walk to a right handed batter this season to San Diego's **Ramon Laureano** on a full count at Petco Park (May 9); 92 total batters faced.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

**LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, May 27 at Milwaukee):** L, 2-1; 7.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 9 SO, 87 pitches.

- Dropped his career-high 4th-straight decision despite taking a no-hitter into the 8th inning.
- Threw a season-high 7.0 IP and struck out a season-high 9 batters, one shy of his career high.

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**OH NO-NO:** Took a no-hitter in the 8th inning on 5/27 at MIL, broken up by a Garrett Mitchell lead-off double, and eventually lost 2-1; Threw a season-high 7.0 IP and fanned a season-high 9 batters; the only Brewers batsmen to reach safely before the 8th came via a HBP and catcher's interference.

**DECISIONS, DECISIONS:** His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight loses, then 3-straight wins and now a career-high 4-straight losses.

**STEADY STARTER:** Has quality starts in 7 of his 11 starts; Has allowed 3 runs or fewer working into the 6th inning in each of his last 9 starts for a 3.01 ERA (53.2 IP/18 ER) in that span. He has received just seven runs of support over his last six starts.

**KICKING THE BABIP HABIT:** 17 or his 60 hits allowed this season came in his first two starts; he still owns the 7th-highest BABIP (.324) in MLB.

**DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS:** Has the 2nd-lowest walk percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind Michael McGreevy (6.3%) with 7.4%.

**MAY'S DAY:** Started on May 3 while wearing uniform No. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

**EARLY BIRD:** Has made a team-high 7 starts in Day games this season (1-6, 5.73 ERA), ranking T-2nd in NL; is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA in his 4 Night starts.

**BACK-TO-BACK JACK:** Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

**MILESTONE WIN:** Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

**TIGER STRIKE:** Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

**OPENING ACT:** Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

## MAY VS. TEXAS:

- The **Justin, TX native** (Northwest High School) is making his 2nd career start/appearance against the Rangers, last doing so on 8/28/20 at Globe Life Field while pitching for the LA Dodgers.
- Owns a 4-2 career mark with a 2.82 ERA in his 9 career games/8 starts against American League West opponents. Has made just two starts vs. AL West teams (both in 2025) since the 2021 season.
- Was a member of the 2020 World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers that defeated Tampa Bay in the neutral site World Series played at Texas' Globe Life Field during the pandemic-shortened MLB season.
