San Francisco Giants (99-54) at Colorado Rockies (71-81)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Rockies play the first game of this three-game series... SF has won 15 of its last 20 games overall entering play today and hold a 1.0 game lead over the Dodgers for the NL West with nine games remaining on the regular season schedule...SF's magic number to clinch the NL West stands at nine.

ONE MORE FOR 100: The Giants need just one more win for 100 this year...just seven Giants teams in franchise history have won 100 games: 1904 NY Giants (106), 1905 NY Giants (105), 1912 NY Giants (103), 1962 SF Giants (103), 1993 SF Giants (103), 1913 NY Giants (101) and 2003 SF Giants (100)...this 2021 club is on pace for 104 wins.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants are 12-4 against the Rockies this season, outscoring them by a 105-54 margin...the most wins the Giants have ever had against Colorado in a single season was when they went 13-5 against them in 2011...the Giants enter tonight having won six of the last seven meetings.

BEST IN THE BIGS: The Giants (99-54, .647) enter today with the best record in MLB, 1.0 game ahead of the Dodgers (98-55, .641)...the .647 winning percentage through 153 games is the club's best in the SF-era and the best by a Giants team since 1913.

115 AND COUNTING: The Giants have held the best overall record in MLB this year for 115 days...the Dodgers are second on this list (19 days), followed by the Padres (13) and Rays (11) (*Stats, LLC*).

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST YOU'RE LAST: The Giants were the first team to 50 wins this season, the first to 60 wins, the first to 70, 80, 90 and with one more win will be the first team to 100 victories in 2021.

NATIONAL LEAD: The Giants' 99-54 current record puts them in contention for the best record by an NL team in the divisional era...their 99 wins through their first 153 games are the fourth-most in the NL since 1969...the 1975 Reds and 1986 Mets each finished the year with 108 wins, which is the best mark for any NL team since 1969.

ROAD WARRIORS: San Francisco is 50-28 (.641) away from home this season, its fifth-best road win percentage in franchise history...SF has won 14 of its last 17 road games.

MOON SHOTS: The Giants have reached 230 home runs this season, surpassing the 2000 club (226) for second-most all time by a Giants team in a single season...the team needs just five more homers to match a franchise-best 235 home runs done by the 2001 club...20 different Giants players have homered this year and 10 have reached double-digit homers, with **IF Brandon Belt** pacing the team with 26...the Giants could have the most home runs among teams that did not have a 30-homer player that season.

JUST SCORE FIRST: SF is 71-14 (.835) when scoring the game's first run...that's the best overall winning percentage in MLB, ahead of the Dodgers (73-20, .785), Rays (60-17, .779) and Brewers (64-21, .753) (*Elias*).

ONE RUN WINS: The Giants are 29-16 (.644) in one-run games this year, tops in MLB.

PINCH ME: OF Austin Slater's pinch-hit, go-ahead three-run homer yesterday at San Diego marked the Giants' 17th pinch-hit homer this season, matching the 2016 St. Louis Cardinals for the most in MLB history.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

RHP Peter Lambert, who underwent Tommy John surgery in July of 2020, makes his season debut tonight...the 24-year-old has faced the Giants twice in his career (2019) and has fashioned a 4.50 ERA in two starts.

LHP Alex Wood is scheduled to make his 25th start of the season and his fourth against Colorado...in three previous starts he's 2-0 with a 3.06 ERA (6er, 17.2ip), allowing two runs in each of the three outings...Wood owns a 9.00 ERA in nine games (eight starts) here at Coors Field.

GIANTS HOME RUNS

The Giants enter today with 230 homers, second-most in the Majors behind Toronto (242)...SF has scored 50.3% of their runs off home runs (380 of 756 total runs), most in the Majors...only two Giants teams since 1950 have led MLB in home runs (including ties for the lead) and only one since the team moved West in 1958: 1954 NY Giants (186 HR tied with Brooklyn) & 1972 SF Giants (150 HR)...the 230 homers are second-most in team history behind the 2001 club, who hit a franchise-best 235 homers.

TODAY'S OUTING: Wood is set to make his 25th start of the season with his start today...it will be his second since coming off the Covid IL after testing positive for Covid in late August...made his first appearance back last time out on September 18 where he threw 3.0 scoreless, hitless innings with four strikeouts only using 37 pitches.

DOUBLE TIME: Wood has reached the double-digit win threshold for the fourth time in his career and for the first time since 2017 when he recorded a career-best 16 victories with the Dodgers.

WORKIN HARD: He has thrown 128.2 innings so far in 2021 a significant jump from 2020 where he threw 12.2 regular-season innings and 6.2 more in the postseason...overall, it's the most innings he's thrown in a regular season since 2018 when he tossed 151.2 frames.

LAST FOUR: Prior to hitting the IL, Wood had allowed two runs in each of his three prior starts and he tossed 3.0 scoreless last time out in his first start back...he has a 2.70 ERA (6er, 20.0ip) over those four outings with 24 strikeouts in 20.0 innings.

A TALE OF TWO GAMES: In the first two innings of his starts in 2021, Wood has been tremendous with a 1.50 ERA (8er, 48.0ip) ranking second in MLB behind Lance Lynn (1.21 ERA) (min. 40ip)...however, from the 3rd inning on his ERA jumps to 5.47 (49er, 80.2ip).

VS. COLORADO: Faces the Rockies for a fourth time this season and for the first time since earning a win against them on August 15 at Oracle Park...is 2-0 with a 3.06 ERA (6er, 17.2ip) in his three prior starts vs. Colorado this year...in his lone start at Coors Field in 2021, Wood allowed two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings back on May 4.

HARD CONTACT: Wood's hard hit percentage (the percentage of balls that are hit 95+ mph) steadily climbed higher as the season has gone on...it was 34% in April, 39% in May, 42% in June and 44% in July...in five August starts it was only 32%, his lowest of the season for a single month.

PUNCHES: Has 139 strikeouts this year, matching the third-highest total of his career (also 2015)...his two best strikeout seasons were 2014 with Atlanta (170) and 2017 with the Dodgers (151)...Wood is averaging 9.7 K/9ip this year, his best total in a full season since a career-best 9.8 K/9ip in 2016 with LA.

DICK TIDROW
1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, MO. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children— Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
