THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their 10-game homestand, losing a series 2-1 to the Diamondbacks over the weekend, followed by a win over the Yankees last night tonight, they will play the second of three against New York and complete the series tomorrow nightthey will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Guardians for four games this weekend — including a doubleheader on Saturday (make-up of May 20). ▼ Twins have 12 games remaining, six at home and six on the road.
FILTHY RICH-ARDSON: The Twins shut out the Yankees last night at Target Field, winning by a score of 7-0, marking their first shutout of the Yankees since a 4-0 victory on August 11, 2008 (G. Perkins over S. Ponson)Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter and winner, pitching

(G. Perkins over S. Ponson)...Simeon Woods Kichardson was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, three walks and a career-high 11 strikeouts...the Twins bullpen (Funderburk, Adams & Ohl), pitched 3.0 hitless innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, led by Brooks Lee, who went 2-for-4 with a double (15) and a home run (15)...Austin Martin added four RBI, which set a single-game career-high.

HOW DO YOU LIKE THEM APPLES?: The Twins and Yankees are playing the fifth of six games in 2025...Twins are 2-2 this season, going 1-2 at Yankee Stadium (August 11-13), followed by a win last night at Target Field.

♣ With their victory in the finale on August 13 in the Bronx, followed by last night's win, the Twins have won two-straight over New York for the first time since April 24-25, 2023...they are seeking their first three-game winning streak against the Yankees since September 8, 2022-April 14, 2023 (also 3).

♣ In four games against the Yankees this season, Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (4-for-13) with one double, one home run and three walks...Buck has a .999 OPS in his last 18 games against the Yankees, including five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI and a .629 slugging percentage.

NEW YORK GROOVE: Dating back to the fourth inning of August 13 at Yankee Stadium, the Twins have held the Yankees scoreless for 15 innings...below are Minnesota's longest scoreless streaks against the Yankees (since 1961) — per Elias Sports Bureau:

SLAP THE BASE: The Twins stole three more bases last night (Martin - 2, Wallner - 1), giving them 99 on the season, their most under a Rocco Baldelli-led team (since 1961)...99 is their most since stealing 99 in 2014...the last time they stole at least 100 was in 2012 (135)... since August 1, they have stolen 44 bases (53 attempts), tied with Arizona for third-most in baseball, trailing New York-AL (48) and New York-NL (47)...prior to August 1, the Twins stole 55 bases, sixth-rewest in baseball.

BASEPATH BANTER: Over their last 26 games, since August 18, the Twins have posted a 4.7 BsR (base running runs above average), which is the best in baseball...in 108 games leading up to the trade deadline (July 31), the Twins posted a -6.5 BsR, ranking 29th in baseball (lower left)...in 41 games since, they have posted a BsR of 3.2, fourth-best in baseball (lower right):

AWESOME AUSTIN: Over his last 19 games, Austin Martin has reached base 39 times (21 hits, 14 walks) in 74 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .479 in that span...over those 19 games, his batting average is .356 (21-for-59) with six doubles, 13 runs scored, just 11 strikeouts and a .937 OPS.

Martin has posted a .436 on-base percentage in 14 games this month, the seventh-best in the AL and 15th-best in baseball.

His walk percentage of 16.1 is seventh-best in the AL and 14th-best in baseball for September.

KEA PLAYER: Luke Keaschall has reached safely in 39 of 43 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .396 on the season, reaching base 74 times (51 hits, 18 walks, 5 hit-by-pitch) in 187 plate appearances...marks the second-most times on base in Twins history (1961-) through a player's first 43 career games (Luis Arraez - 76 in 2019).

♣ He ranks second among all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 150 plate appearances), trailing Roman Anthony (.396).

ROTATIONAL PULL: Through four games on the homestand, Twins starters have posted a 2.57 ERA (21.0 IP, 6 ER), with two home runs allowed (Alek Thomas, James McCann), eight walks, 30 strikeouts and a .184 opponent batting average.

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): With a win tonight or tomorrow night, the Twins will earn their 18th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 17-29-2 in series play, going 11-11-2 at home and 6-18-0 on the road.

Became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to reach 100 strikeouts in his first 18 career games.

FACING THE PINSTRIPES: Matthews is facing New York-AL for the second time in his career...his lone start against the Yankees was on August 11 where he was dealt his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 2-6 defeat...allowed three runs on six hits (career-high-tying 3 HR), with one walk and a career-high-tying nine strikeouts in 5.2 innings of work...threw a career-high 99 pitches.

◆ Became the fastest pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to reach 100 career strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Zebby has gone 3-3 with a 5.92 ERA (48.2 IP, 32 ER), 12 walks, 61 strikeouts and a .299 (61-for-204) opponent batting average in 11 career major league starts at home; compared to 2-6, 5.40 ERA (58.1 IP, 35 ER) with 21 walks, 62 strikeouts and a .289 (69-for-239) opponent batting average in 12 career major league starts on the road.

◆ In six major league starts at home this season, Matthews has gone 2-1, posting a 3.56 ERA (30.1 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks, 34 strikeouts and a .254 (30-for-118) opponent batting average.

victory, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts.

On June 9, 2024 at Northwest Arkansas, threw 7.0 scoreless innings with three hits, no walks and eight strikeouts for Wichita.

 Allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in nine-straight starts (4 with Cedar Rapids, 5 with Wichita) to begin the 2024 season...went 4-1 with a 1.38 ERA (52.1 IP, 8 ER) in that span.
