RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals play the second a three-game series against the Miami Marlins tonight at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals won 7-1 last night behind starting pitcher **Andre Pallante**, who fired 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball and did not allow a hit until the 6th inning. The Marlins are the second opponent during this current homestand after splitting a four-game series with the San Diego Padres (July 24-27). This seven-game homestand runs the Cardinals into the end of July and the trade deadline on Thursday, July 31 at 5:00 p.m., Central.

BIRD WATCHING: St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the National League Central, 9.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 1.5 games behind 3rd place Cincinnati. The Cardinals currently are 3.5 games behind San Diego for the final Wild Card spot in the National League with Cincinnati in the median.

NACHO AVERAGE PUNISHER: A win tonight would give the Cardinals a fifth straight season winning their home series against Miami. Dating back to 2019, the Cardinals sport a 13-4 (.764) record over the Marlins. Miami last won a series at Busch Stadium in 2018 and split a four-game series in St. Louis in 2019.

GORMAN BEGINS REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Infielder **Nolan Gorman** (back tightness) begins an injury rehabilitation assignment with Springfield (AA) tonight and will start as the designated hitter. Gorman was placed on the 10-day Injured List on July 19.

GRAY AREA: Tonight's starting pitcher **Sonny Gray** has recorded 16 wins at Busch Stadium since joining the club in 2024. The veteran right-hander ranks T-2nd in home wins over that period behind **Tarik Skubal** (DET, 18) and tied with **Carlos Rodón** (NYY) and **Zack Wheeler** (PHI). The Cardinals are 12-1 at home this season in Gray's starts, the most home wins in a singular pitcher's starts in MLB.

CAROLINA RIPPER: Cardinals outfielder **Alec Burleson** hit his 14th home run of the season last night, tying **Willson Contereras** for the team lead. Since the start of 2024, Burleson leads the Cardinals in both home runs (35) and RBI (126). After homering on Sunday, Burleson has homered in consecutive games for the 3rd time this season (7th career) and is one shy of tying his career-best three games (June 2-4, 2024).

SECOND WINN: Since the All-Star Break, **Masyn Winn** leads the Cardinals with 17 hits, tied for 6th in MLB over that period with **Manny Machado** (SD), and trailing the MLB leader **Nick Kurtz** (ATH) with 23. The shortstop has hit safely in 10-of-11 games out of the break with 3 three-hit games (8 total this season). Winn punished two doubles last night and has 55 since the start of last season, T-4th most in MLB with **Gunnar Henderson** among primary shortstops (**Bobby Witt, Jr.** 81, **Francisco Lindor** 59, **Ely De La Cruz** 58).

OUT OF LEFT FIELD: Primary catcher **Iván Herrera** played his first game starting in left field last night and made a put out on the only fly ball hit in his direction. Herrera had previously played 94 games at catcher since his debut in 2022. He also started eight games at first base for Panama over three seasons in the Caribbean Series.

FISH STICKS: Cardinals third baseman **Nolan Arenado** has a string of success at Busch Stadium against the Marlins hitting safely in his last six games posting a .478 BA (11-23) with a home run and nine RBI. Over that period, Arenado drilled a walk-off three-run home run (July 18, 2023) in the 10th inning off **A.J. Puk** and had four straight multi-hit games (7/17-23-4/4/24).

FISHING IN THE DARK: The Cardinals all-time .604 win pct. (136-89) vs. the Marlins (1993-present) is their 2nd-highest against any opponent behind only the Diamondbacks (.609, 112-72). The winning percentage is the best of any National League team against the Marlins since they joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993 (*see chart above*).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 29, 2011): **Albert Pujols** connects on an RBI double vs. the Cubs off **Carlos Marmol** scoring **Ryan Theriot** for his 2,000th career hit joining **Stan Musial**, **Lou Brock**, **Rogers Hornsby** and **Enos Slaughter**. Since then, **Yadier Molina** also joined that list in 2020.

MIAMI CONNECTIONS

Miles Mikolas was born in nearby Jupiter, Fla... graduated from Jupiter (Fla.) HS and Nova South-eastern University...made MLB debut vs. the Marlins on May 5, 2012 at Petco Park (as a Padre).

Miles Mikolas (Jupiter), **Jordan Walker** (Jupiter), **Masyn Winn** (Jupiter) and **Nolan Gorman** (Pompano Beach) reside in the South Florida area.

Brant Brown served as the Marlins hitting coach in 2023.

Jon Jay was born in and resides in Miami...attended Christopher Columbus High School and the University of Miami...served as the First Base/Out-field Coach for Miami for two seasons (2023-24).

Garrett Hampson played in 98 games for the Marlins in 2023.

Pedro Pagés resides in Doral, Fla...graduated from Gulliver Prep High School in Miami...played college baseball at Florida Atlantic Univ...made MLB debut vs. Marlins (April 7, 2024 at Busch).

Iván Herrera caught his first MLB shutout against the Marlins, June 27, 2022 at Busch Stadium from **Adam Wainwright** (7 IP), **James Naile** (1 IP) and **Jake Woodford** (1 IP) in a 9-0 win.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 High School Home Run Derby at Marlins Park during All-Star Week.

Sandy Alcántara pitched in eight games for St. Louis in 2017...Originally signed with the Cardinals as an International free agent on July 2, 2013 (signed by **Moises Rodriguez**)...traded to Miami with **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Magneuris Sierra** for **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Marlins Minor League Operations Assistant **Lizzy Millner** previous served as a Cardinals Baseball Operations Fellow in 2023.

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter, Fla. as their Spring Training site... RDGS is also the home to the Palm Beach Cardinals and Jupiter Hammerheads of the Single-A Florida State League.

Miami and St. Louis played the first regular season game at then Marlins Park (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter is set to make his 22nd start of the season (329th career appearance/320th start); it's his 50th career start for St. Louis.
- Is 7-1 with a 3.39 ERA (6 HR) in 13 home starts, but 3-3 with a 5.84 ERA (8 HR) in eight road starts.
- Sonny's 16 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-2025) are tied for 2nd-most in the majors behind **Tarik Skubal** (18). **The Cardinals are 12-1 in his 13 home starts this season (only loss vs. NYM on May 2), most in MLB for team home wins in starts by a singular pitcher this season.**
- Has not allowed a home run to a left-handed batter in his last 12 starts (160 batters faced). Is the only MLB pitcher since May 20 without a HR allowed vs. a left-handed batter (100 TBF).
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (27.1%) - 12th-best in the NL.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks 28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in 17-of-21 starts this season; Cardinals are 12-5 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 2nd-most in MLB behind Detroit's LHP Tarik Skubal (9)**
- The Cardinals are 16-5 in his 21 starts this season, with two of his defeats coming in starts against the Mets.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (224 K). **Trevor Rosenthal** ranks 10th with 244 strikeouts.
- 14 of his 120 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **23 of his 60 runs (38.3%) allowed this season have come via HR's.**
- His 14 HR's allowed have surpassed his season total (8) for all of the 2023 season.
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (331, T-8th), SO/9 IP (10.54, 10th), and wins (23, T-5th).
- St. Louis is 33-16 (.673) in his 49 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 23-13 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his 10th win in 9-7 slugfest vs. Padres last Thu. (7/24); allowed 7 runs on 11 hits in his 5.0 IP; yielded a career high 11 hits in consecutive starts for the 1st time in his career; joined **Adam Wainwright** (5/12/16) & **Burleigh Grimes** (5/29/31) as lone Cardinals to earn a win with 5.0 IP, 7+runs and 11+hits in a game.

2025:

- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug, 22, 2022.*
- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone's** perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.*
- His 19 starts before the All-Star Break tied his single-season most (2014).

CAREER NOTES:

- Ranks in the Top 10 among active pitchers in wins (121, 7th), games started (319, 7th), innings pitched (1,853.2, 9th), strikeouts (1,852, 9th) and ERA (3.56, 7th).

GRAY VS. MIAMI:

- Making his 7th career start vs. Miami and his 2nd as a member of the Cardinals; it's his 1st career start vs. the Marlins at Busch Stadium.
- His teams are a perfect 6-0 in games that he has started vs. the Marlins.
- Is 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA career vs. MIA with 4 quality starts in his match-ups with the Marlins.
- Has allowed just one career HR to a Marlins batter, that coming on 8/26/19 in Miami while pitching for Cincinnati (Neil Walker).
- Is a career 13-7, 3.98 ERA in 38 starts vs. N.L. East opponents, including 1-1 mark this season.
