**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game, 10-day road trip with the second city of their road trip with a three-game series in Philadelphia. The Cardinals road trip encompasses a three-game series in Cincinnati (May 27-29), Philadelphia (May 31-June 2) and Houston (June 3-5) with an open date yesterday in Philadelphia on this longest road trip of their 2024 season. Tonight is the first of five straight night games for the Cardinals after playing 2-of-3 day games in Cincinnati.

**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals held off the Cincinnati Reds 5-3 on Wednesday to win their 5th straight series. **Nolan Gorman** (#11) and **Matt Carpenter** (#1) each homered while **Masyn Winn** rapped off a career-high three hits to extend his hitting streak to a now MLB-active best 18 games. Starting pitcher **Andre Pallante** threw 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball for the win, making his first Major League start since July 31, 2022. Pallante hasn't allowed a run as a starting pitcher in 17.0 consecutive innings dating back to July 26, 2022.

**THAT FAMILIAR FEELING:** With the Cubs losing to the Brewers yesterday, the Cardinals moved into 2nd place in the National League Central for the first time since April 2, 2023, when they were in first place at 2-1. St. Louis is five games behind the first place Brewers.

**NOOTBAAR TO I.L.; FERMÍN RECALLED:** The Cardinals placed OF **Lars Nootbaar** on the 10-day injured list with a strained oblique, retroactive to May 30. INF **José Fermín** was recalled from Memphis (AAA). Nootbaar exited Wednesday's game after beating out an infield single in the 7th inning. This is Nootbaar's second trip to the Injured List after missing the first 13 games of the season with a ribcage fracture that occurred in Spring Training. Fermín is leading Memphis in batting (.346), on-base percentage (.461) and OPS (1.076).

**GALLEGOS STARTS REHAB ASSIGNMENT:** Cardinals RHP **Giovanny Gallegos** will begin an injury rehabilitation assignment in Memphis (AAA) tonight. Gallegos was placed on the Injured List May 6 with a right shoulder impingement.

**STILL CHASIN' MASYN:** Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** extended his hitting streak to 18 games on Wednesday with a career-high three hits. Winn moved up to 7th in the National League batting leaders with a .308 average. Winn's streak is currently the longest active in Major League Baseball and three behind the longest of the season held by **Ketel Marte** and **Anthony Volpe** with 21. Winn's 18-game streak is 2nd-longest in Cardinals history by a rookie behind only Philadelphia native **Joe McEwing's** 25-gamer in 1999. The 18-game streak is the longest by an MLB rookie since Kansas City's **Maikel Garcia** ran off 18 from 7/26-8/16/2023.

**STORMIN' NOLAN GORMAN:** **Nolan Gorman** homered for the second straight game for his team-leading 10th home run. Gorman leads the Cardinals with six home runs in the month of May, all hit since May 10, which leads the National League over that period. Gorman's 51 career home runs in his first 256 games is the second most in Cardinals history behind **Albert Pujols** (60). - *Jimmy the Lion*

**CLOSE & LATE AND LATE IN THE COUNT:** Cardinals boast a few clutch hitters as outfielder **Alec Burleson** is tied for the Major League lead with 13 hits in Close & Late situations with **Marcell Ozuna** (ATL) and **Amed Rosario** (CLE). Shortstop **Masyn Winn** is currently 2nd in MLB with a .311 BA in two-strike counts, trailing only **Kevin Pillar** (15-47, .319), while his 28 hits deep in the count are 8th in MLB (**Jose Altuve**, 1st, HOU, 33).

**ALUMNI PROUD:** Some Cardinals players and staff are alumni of the NCAA Division 1 Baseball Regional participants that begin today. RHP **Sonny Gray** (Vanderbilt - #2 Clemson Regional), RHP **Andre Pallante** (UC-Irvine #2 - Corvallis Regional) and OF **Alec Burleson** (East Carolina - #1 Greenville Regional). President of Baseball Operations **John Mozeliak** (Arizona - #1 Tucson Regional) and Assistant GM **Moises Rodriguez** (Connecticut - #3 Norman Regional). Announcers **Chip Caray** (Georgia - #1 Athens Regional) and **Ricky Horton** (Virginia - #1 Charlottesville Regional).

#### PHILADELPHIA CONNECTIONS

**Turner Ward** played 17 games for the Phillies and 70 games for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons (AAA) in his final season in 2001.

**JoJo Romero** pitched parts of three seasons in Philadelphia (2020-22)...originally selected by the Phillies in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

**Edmundo Sosa** signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (July 2, 2012)...played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2018-22)...traded to Phillies for **JoJo Romero** (July 30, 2022).

**Kyle Gibson** pitched parts of two seasons with the Phillies (2021-22)...was originally selected by Philadelphia in the 36th round of the 2006 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Mizzou.

**Michael Siani** was born in and resides in Glenside, Pa...graduated from William Penn Charter School in Philadelphia...same high school as Phillies broadcaster **Ruben Amaro**.

**Nolan Arenado** is the last Cardinal to hit for the cycle (2nd career) on July 1, 2022 at Philadelphia...became the 17th in Cardinals history and first since **Mark Grudzielanek** in 2005.

**Paul Goldschmidt** was born in nearby Wilmington, Del...moved to Texas when he was one.

Phillies Amateur Scouting Director **Brian Barber** was a 1st-round (#22) selection in the 1991 MLB draft by St. Louis from Dr. Phillips (Fla.) High School, same school as **Oliver Marmol**...pitched in 10 games for St. Louis (1995-96).

Phillies Bullpen catcher/Asst. Catching Coach **Brad Flanders** played two seasons (2003-04) at the University of Missouri...coached at Saint Louis University for three seasons (2011-13).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Bill White** played three seasons with Philadelphia (1966-68)...traded to the Phillies in 1965 and back to St. Louis in 1969.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** was originally selected by the Phillies in the 2nd round of the 1993 MLB draft... Played parts of seven seasons with Philadelphia (1996-2002)...Traded to St. Louis with **Doug Nickle** & cash for **Placido Polanco**, **Bud Smith**, & **Mike Timlin** (July 29, 2002).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tom Herr** was born in nearby Lancaster, Pa. (April 4, 1956)

Phillies Visiting Clubhouse Manager **Kevin Steinhour** began his career as a batboy & clubhouse worker for Springfield (A) in the Cardinals organization (1981-87) before serving as Louisville Redbirds (AAA) Equipment Manager (1988-89).

Phillies Sr. Director, International Scouting **Sal Agostinelli** was selected by St. Louis in the 20th round of the 1983 MLB draft... played six seasons (1983-88) in the Cardinals minor league system.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 12th start of the season and his 162nd career (190th appearance).
- All three wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (30-27) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (23-25).
- Is 16.2 innings pitched away from 1,000 for his career.
- This season, has the 2nd-highest qualifying ERA (5.64) in the National League and 4th-highest opponent BA (.286). **Patrick Corbin** (6.12 and .322) leads both categories.
- Has enjoyed career success in the month of May, posting an 12-8 mark with a 3.19 ERA (180.2 IP), his lowest monthly ERA. Went 3-0 with a 1.89 ERA in six starts last May.
- In his 151 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 61-30 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings, while the Cardinals are 23-37 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 45-5 (.900 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 60-14 in those 74 games). He's just 8-47 (.145) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 24-54).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 4th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Tossed a quality start for a no-decision last Saturday against the Cubs at Busch Stadium, limiting Chicago to three runs with six strikeouts in 6.0 frames. St. Louis scored four runs in the 8th inning to hang on to a 7-6 come-from-behind win.

- Is 23-25 in his 74 starts at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal. The Cardinals are 42-32 in those games.
- Ranks among Busch Stadium III rankings in starts (74, 6th), innings pitched (451.0, 7th), ERA (3.43, 6th), quality starts (42, 6th), and wins (23, T-5th).

**CAREER**

- St. Louis is 84-68 (.552) in his 151 career outings (152 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Has entered his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (886.0), wins (53), strikeouts (650) and games started (150) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
- Two-time NL All-Star (2018 & 2022). Did not appear in 2022 at Dodger Stadium and chose to miss the 2018 game in Washington D.C. to be with his wife as they welcomed twins.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee. Was the first Cardinals pitcher since **Chris Carpenter** (35 in 2009) to do so.
- Has registered 32 or more starts in every season in which he was not injured or sidelined by COVID-19 protocols.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) with the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.3%.

**2024**

- Did not walk a batter for four consecutive starts 4/20-5/7, a new career-high. Tied with **Zack Littell** for most consecutive starts without a walk in the 2024 season. The previous Cardinals pitcher to pitch five starts without a walk was **Mike Leake** in 2016.
