**BIRDLAND BITES:** Baltimore continues its six-game road trip this afternoon through Pittsburgh (0-1, 2 to play) and Chicago-AL (3 to play)...The Birds enter play today in third place of the AL East, trailing the Yankees (6-1) and Blue Jays (4-3).

⚾ Yesterday's 5-4 defeat marked the sixth-straight one-run game played between the O's and Pirates since April 6, 2024.

⚾ **Blaze Alexander** (2-for-4, 2 R) tallied his 100<sup>th</sup> career hit with a seventh-inning single off Yohan Ramirez.

⚾ **Rico Garcia** tossed a scoreless eighth inning and has begun the season throwing 3.1 perfect innings with four strikeouts over three appearances.

**WIZARD OF BAZ:** **Shane Baz** has gone 33.2 straight innings without permitting a home run dating to August 26, 2025...It is the second-longest active streak among starting pitchers in MLB behind CIN's Graham Ashcraft (38.0 IP).

⚾ Today's opposing starter, **Carmen Mlodzinski**, has gone 51.0 straight innings without allowing a homer since July 6, 2025, but only four of his 21 outings during that period have come as a starter.

**SETTING THE TABLE:** **Taylor Ward** has doubled in three straight games, tied with four others for the longest active streak in the majors...It is tied for the longest streak of his career, joining runs from July 19-21, 2025 and August 13-16, 2024.

⚾ He has also driven in a run in three straight games...Ward is the first Oriole with 1+ double and 1+ RBI in three straight games since **Ryan Mountcastle** did so from June 19-21, 2024 (also 3 G)...Only four Orioles in franchise history (since 1954) have accomplished the feat in four straight games: **Ramón Hernández** (2006), **Chris Hoiles** (1993), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1983), and **Reggie Jackson** (1976).

⚾ After going 0-for-7 with two walks in his first two games to open the season, Ward is 9-for-20 (.450) with three doubles, two runs, five RBI, and three walks over his last five.

**THAT'S MORE LIKE IT:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first six games to open the season, slashing .294/.429/.529 (5-for-17) with four doubles, one run, two RBI, and four walks against two strikeouts.

⚾ The four doubles are tied with seven others for second most in the majors, trailing only HOU's Christian Walker (5 2B).

**TWO-OUT TENDENCIES:** Baltimore hitters have registered a .912 OPS with two outs, the fourth-highest mark in the majors behind Washington (.960), Philadelphia (.937), and Milwaukee (.928).

⚾ **Taylor Ward** is 5-for-7 with two doubles, three RBI, two walks, and zero strikeouts with two outs, while **Adley Rutschman** is 4-for-7 with three doubles, one RBI, two walks, and zero strikeouts.

⚾ The O's have 27 two-out hits, tied for second in the majors behind the Rangers (29 H).

⚾ With zero and one outs, the Birds have posted a combined .620 OPS, ranking 22<sup>nd</sup> in the majors.

**BOTTOMS UP:** **Blaze Alexander** and **Jeremiah Jackson** have served as the Birds nine-hole hitters thus far and have combined to hit .400 (10-for-25)...The 10 hits are tied with Toronto for the most knocks out of the nine spot in MLB.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** Despite a 1-for-9 performance in yesterday's defeat, the O's have recorded an .847 OPS with runners in scoring position, the third-highest clip in the AL behind the Athletics (.988) and Tigers (.956).

**EXTRA-EXTRA:** Ten different Orioles have recorded at least one extra-base hit this season, tied with the Guardians and Rays for the second-most players in the AL behind the Astros (12).

⚾ Baltimore's 13 doubles are tied for fifth most in MLB behind Houston (21), Arizona/Miami (both 15), and Detroit (14).

**RIGHT-SIDE STORY:** Entering play today, the Birds are one of five teams in MLB that have yet to face a left-handed starting pitcher, joining the Guardians, Tigers, Rockies, and White Sox.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** **Jackson Holliday** went 1-for-5 with two RBI in his fifth rehab appearance with the Tides yesterday and is batting .278 (5-for-18) with two doubles, three RBI, and two walks...**Dean Kremer** made his first start of the season with the Tides and tossed 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on three hits (1 HR) and two walks with six strikeouts.

⚾ Making his professional debut with High-A Frederick, **Joseph Dzierwa** earned the win after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and one walk while striking out nine...Dzierwa, selected by Baltimore in the second round of the 2025 First-Year Player Draft out of Michigan State University, is tabbed the No. 12 O's prospect by *MLB Pipeline*.

⚾ The Keys received offensive contributions from **Wehiwa Aloy** (1-for-3, 3B, 2 RBI, 2 BB), **Nate George** (1-for-3, 2 R, BB, SB), and **Ike Irish** (2-for-5, 2 2B, 2 R, RBI).

**WELCOME TO BIRDLAND:** Eight players on the Opening Day roster have made their O's debut: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...Nunez made his major league debut on March 28.

⚾ Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

**AHOY!** The Birds and Pirates play their lone series of the 2026 campaign this weekend...Baltimore swept the three-game set last season at Camden Yards from September 9-11.

⚾ All three matchups between the clubs in 2025 were decided by one run, with the first two contests ending in extra-innings...On September 9, **Samuel Basallo's** RBI-single in the 11<sup>th</sup> secured a 3-2 Baltimore win...The following night, **Dylan Beavers'** RBI-single in the 10<sup>th</sup> clinched a 2-1 win.

⚾ Baltimore Orioles Hall of Famer **Nick Markakis'** lone home run onto Eutaw Street came off Pittsburgh's **John Grabow** on June 14, 2008.

**QUICK HITS:** Baz is scheduled to make his second start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...Over three Grapefruit League starts, he went 0-1 with a 2.61 ERA (3 ER/10.1 IP) on five hits, four walks, and 14 strikeouts...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Baz did not factor into the decision of his first career start as an Oriole on March 29 vs. Minnesota...Tossed 5.1 innings, allowing four runs on seven hits and one hit batter with four strikeouts...Threw 78 pitches, 53 strikes.  
 ⚡ Broke a 20-game streak of walking at least one batter dating to June 4, 2025.  
 ⚡ Six of the seven hits he allowed came against left-handed hitters, marking only the third of his 55 career starts in which he permitted 6+ hits to lefties (7 H, 8/1/25 vs. LAD & 6 H, 7/11/24 vs. NYY).  
 ⚡ Opponents went 1-for-6 with a double off his knuckle curve, compared to 4-for-6 with three doubles against his four-seam fastball.

**FAMILIAR FOE:** Baz is set to make his second career start opposite the Pirates...He earned the victory over Pittsburgh as a member of Tampa Bay on April 1, 2025, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings while scattering seven hits with zero walks and 10 strikeouts.  
 ⚡ The 10 strikeouts marked one of three double-digit strikeout outings for Baz in 2025, joining April 14 vs. Boston and July 1 vs. the Athletics (both 11 K).  
 ⚡ Baz was originally selected by the Pirates with the No. 12 overall pick of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

**LIMITING THE LONG BALL:** Baz has gone 33.2 straight innings without permitting a home run dating to August 26, 2025...It is the second-longest active streak among starting pitchers in MLB behind CIN's Graham Ashcraft (38.0 IP).  
 ⚡ Today's opposing starter, Carmen Mlodzinski, has gone 51.0 straight innings without allowing a homer since July 6, 2025, but only four of his 21 outings during that period have come as a starter.

**NO APRIL FOOL:** He has made five career starts in the month of April, going 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA (8 ER/29.1 IP) while limiting opponents to a .553 OPS...In six career starts in May, Baz is 1-3 with a 7.26 ERA (25 ER/31.0 IP) and a 1.001 opponent OPS.

**GOING THE DISTANCE:** Baz was one of three Rays starters in 2025 to remain active all season, along with Ryan Pepiot and Drew Rasmussen...Five of his 31 starts last year went 7.0+ innings, tying Zack Littell for the club lead...That included a start on June 26 at Kansas City, when he tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in a winning effort...Marked the first start of 8.0 scoreless innings or more by a Rays pitcher since Tyler Glasnow on May 26, 2021 vs. Kansas City.

**CAREER RECAP:** Made 31 starts with the Rays in 2025, going 10-12 with a 4.87 ERA (26 ER/166.1 IP) on 158 hits (26 HR), 64 walks, nine hit batters, three wild pitches, and 176 strikeouts...Set career highs in starts, wins, strikeouts, innings, and quality starts (11).  
 ⚡ Went 4-3 in 2024 with a 3.06 ERA (27 ER/79.1 IP) across 14 starts with Tampa Bay in his return from Tommy John surgery, which he underwent on September 28, 2022.  
 ⚡ On September 20, 2021 vs. Toronto, made his major league debut at 22 years, 95 days old and earned the victory, becoming the third-youngest Ray to start and win his MLB debut behind Scott Kazmir (20y-212d) on August 23, 2004 at Seattle and Joe Kennedy (22y-013d) on June 6, 2001 at Toronto.
