RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals play the second of a fourgame series against the Cincinnati Reds tonight. This four-game series will conclude a 10-game "home" stand on Sunday. The homestand began at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., on June 20 against the San Francisco Giants and continued with two games at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals swept the Giants and took 2-of-3 against the Atlanta Braves in a series that included a split doubleheader on Wednesday. The Cardinals are 5-2 on the homestand, the best home mark since going 7-1 from May 17-26 vs. Boston (2-1), Baltimore (3-0) and Chicago-NL (2-0).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the National League Wild Card race. Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns the best record in the National League at 26-15 (.650) with a +21 run differential.

GRACEFFO SELECTED; LEAHY OPTIONED; MATZ MOVES TO 60: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals selected the contract of rookie RHP Gordon Graceffo from Memphis (AAA). RHP Kyle Leahy was optioned to Memphis and LHP Steven Matz was transferred from the 15-day to 60-day Injured List. Graceffo, 24, was the Cardinals 5th round pick out of Villanova in the 2021 MLB Draft. In 14 starts at Triple-A, the New Jersey native was 8-5 with a 3.84 ERA over 75.0 innings pitched. He would become the 7th Cardinals player to make his Major League debut this season and 5th pitcher.

"THE LOU" COMES THROUGH: Tonight, the Cardinals will wear their red City Connect uniforms for the fourth game of 12 this season. The previous three games have resulted in Cardinals wins with the most recent a 5-3 victory over San Francisco on Sunday as Sonny Gray retired the first 20 batters of the game.

HALFWAY THERE...: The Cardinals will play Game No. 81 of their schedule tonight marking the halfway point of the 162-game schedule. Last season, the Cardinals were 34-47 on July 1 and finished 71-91. The last time the Cardinals had 41 or more wins at the midway point was July 2, 2022, with a 44-37 record en route to the 2022 National League Central Division Championship with a 93-69 record.

THE REDS MENACE: Tonight's starting pitcher **Andre Pallante** has won all four decisions against the Cincinnati Reds in his career and has compiled a 1.55 ERA over his 13 appearances. Pallante's 1.55 ERA since he joined the league in 2022, is the lowest among pitchers with 10 or more appearances and at least one start. His four wins vs. Cincinnati are his most against any opponent and his 13 appearances are his most tied with the Pirates. Earlier this season, Pallante hurled 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball en route to a series clinching 5-3 win at Great American Ball Park on May 29.

FLAWLESS: Over the last eight games, the Cardinals have not committed a defensive error with their last coming on June 18 at Miami by **Brandon Crawford** at shortstop. St. Louis opened the season with a team-high nine straight games without an error and can match that tonight. Through June 27, the Cardinals rank 16th in Major League Baseball with a .985 fielding percentage.

MARGINAL ERROR: Last night, the Cardinals fell to the Reds 11-4, marking the sixth game this season the Cardinals have lost by seven or more runs. Three times they have lost by seven and once each by eight, nine and 13 runs. The Cardinals largest margin of victory this season was six runs on May 28 at Cincinnati (7-1).

SAVE CRAVE: Ryan Helsley has converted 28 straight save opportunities since April 1, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the longest in Cardinals history. The 28 straight saves is the Majors longest streak since **Josh Hader** nailed down 32 straight from July 18, 2021 to June 5, 2022.

NOOTBAAR BEGINS REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Cardinals outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** (oblique strain) will begin an injury rehabilitation assignment with Springfield (AA) tonight when they host Arkansas (Mariners) at Hammons Field. Nootbaar last played in a Major League game on May 29 at Cincinnati and has appeared in 39 this season, missing 41 due to injury.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois University (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois University (1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray**'s pitching coach at Vanderbilt University.

Willie McGee (May 10, 1982 at Busch II) and Steven Matz (June 28, 2015 at Citi Field) made MLB debuts vs. the Reds.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office William DeWitt Jr. was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals... his father, William O. DeWitt, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

- Making his 6th start of the season and 16th career. It's his 4th career start vs. the Reds
 and has a 3-0 record in his previous three starts (4-0 record overall)
- Was moved from his last start vs. Atlanta on Wednesday and pushed to tonight.
- Started and earned the win in his last start vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined **Alan Benes** (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Has been involved in the decision in all five of his starts this season alternating wins and losses over the five games (W-L-W-L-W).
- Made five starts this season and has thrown three-hit scoreless starts in two of them (5/29 at CIN 6.0 IP & 6/9 vs. COL 5.0 IP), alternating starts.
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP last Wed. (5/29) in start at CIN.
- Is 6-5, 4.21 ERA in 15 career starts (77.0 IP/36 ER) and 3-1, 2.91 ERA (34.0 IP/11 ER) in six career home starts.
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option on April 21.
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Since his 7/31/22 start at WSH, was 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA over 90 relief appearances with 19 Holds and 63 strikeouts over 104.0 innings pitched. Leads Cardinals with 90 appearances since his 7/31/22 start at WSH. Giovanny Gallegos ranks 2nd with 89.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 100 vs. PHI on July 10, 2022.
- Has been known as a reverse split pitcher holding left-handed batters to a .236 opponent BA as opposed to .320 vs. right-handed batters. Continuing that trend in 2024 with lefties batting .185 (10-54, 1 XBH) and .390 vs. righties (16-41, 2 HR).

Was the first Cardinals rookie pitcher since John Urrea in 1977 to accomplish the feat and the first rookie in MLB since Hisanori Takahashi for the New York Mets in 2010.
- Ranked 3rd among National League rookies with 108.0 innings in 2022.
- Led all MLB rookies with 17 ground into double plays in 2022.
- Finished the 2021 Arizona Fall League season with 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings.
 Named an Arizona Fall League All-Star with a 1.29 ERA, 2nd in the league.
