AROUND THE HORN

THE HONDO RODEO FEST RETURNS NOV. 13-15: The Hondo Rodeo Fest returns to Chase Field for its third year from November 13-15, featuring a weekend of elite rodeo action and full-length concerts by Tim McGraw with Miranda Lambert on Friday, Nov. 13, Blake Shelton with Turnpike Troubadours on Sat., Nov. 14 and Parker McCollum with Lynyrd Skynyrd on Sunday, Nov. 15...tickets go on sale Monday, June 1 at 12:00 p.m. AZ.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs' 14 wins (14-4) are the most in the Majors (ahead of the Brewers' 13).

- The D-backs are 10-1 in their last 11 games and 11-2 in their last 13 games.
- The D-backs own a season-high-tying 5-game winning streak...the last time the D-backs won 6 straight was in 2024 (2x, Aug. 9-14 and Aug. 19-25).
- The D-backs are a season-high 7 games above .500...their first time at 7+ above since the end of 2024 (16 above on Sept. 29, 2024 at 89-73).
- Since May 10, **Ketel Marte** (1.191 OPS) and **Corbin Carroll** (1.108 OPS) rank second and fourth, respectively, in MLB, behind Juan Soto/NYM (1.210 OPS)...no other club features multiple players in the top 10 OPS leaders in that span.
- **Ketel Marte's** season-high 11-game hitting streak is tied for the Majors' longest active streak (also: Willson Contreras/BOS)...is batting .511 (24-for-47)/1.432 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 17 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado's** season-high 17-game on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Majors...has reached base 28 times (15 H, 10 BB, 3 HBP)/.400 OBP and owns a .918 OPS with 8 doubles, 2 homers and 10 RBI in that span.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games, hitting .375 (21-for-56)/1.182 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 12 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 3-2 @ Giants for their sixth straight win (9 of last 10) and second straight 3-game sweep vs. Giants.

- Second time ever with multiple sweeps vs. Giants (3 or 4-game series) in a season (also: July 25-27, 2008 and Sept. 15-18, 2008).
- **Michael Soroka** earned his team-leading seventh win and won his third consecutive decision (6.0 IP, 2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K).
- **Adrian Del Castillo** (1B) and **Ildemaro Vargas** (SF) had 1 RBI apiece to even the game at 2-2 in the sixth inning.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** recorded the go-ahead and eventual game-winning RBI sac fly in the seventh.
- **Ketel Marte** extended his season-high 11-game hitting streak with a seventh-inning single.
- **Paul Sewald** recorded his 100th career save.
- **Ryan Thompson** (0.2 IP), **Brandyn Garcia** (0.1 IP), **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP) and **Paul Sewald** (1.0 IP) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings (2 H, BB, 2 K).

SLAY DAY FOR SLADE: Double-A outfielder and No. 3 prospect (MLB Pipeline), **Slade Caldwell**, recorded his first 5-hit game and reached base 6 times (HR, 3 RBI, BB) yesterday vs. Everett, including a 10th-inning walk-off RBI single.

COMEBACK WINS: The D-backs have won after trailing in 3 straight games and 4 of their last 6...their 19 comeback wins are tied for most in the Majors, along with the Braves.

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 6 series, including 2 sweeps (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants).

30+ WINS: The D-backs have reached 30+ wins thru 54 games or fewer for the third time since 2017 (31 in 2023 and 32 in 2017).

KETEL KILLIN' IT: Since May 16, **Ketel Marte** leads the Majors in OPS (1.432), AVG (.511), SLG (.894), hits (24), RBI (17), extra-base hits (10) and total bases (42).

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 17 quality starts in their last 22 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 15 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in wins (T-1st, 15), innings (1st, 143.2), IP/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (1st, .257), WHIP (1st, 0.99) and ERA (2nd, 2.51).
- The D-backs' 17 quality starts in May are 1 shy of tying the club's all-time May record of 18 set in 2002.
- It is only the D-backs' second season all-time with 17+ quality starts in May (last: 18 in 2002) and ninth time with 16+.

ERROR-FREE: Since May 17 (ninth inning) @ Rockies, the D-backs are errorless in 91.0 consecutive innings, the Majors' longest active errorless streak...second streak of 80.0+ errorless innings (also: 84.0 innings from April 13-25).

UPCOMING MILESTONES: The D-backs are 2 wins shy (2,198) of 2,200 regular-season wins as a franchise.

- **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** is 3 hits shy of 500 career.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 5 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** is 1 win shy of 100 career.

VS. MARINERS: The D-backs swept the last series (3-0) June 9-11, 2025 at home...outscored Mariners 23-9.

- Have won 4 straight games since April 28, 2024.
- Are 7-4 in their last 11 games and have taken 2 of their last 3 road series (July 27-29, 2015 and Sept. 10-12, 2021).

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: The D-backs are 9-6 in Interleague play this season, including a 3-3 record on the road.

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, in his last 10 games, is hitting .405 (15-for-37)/1.098 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 triples, 3 RBI and 5 walks, including 6 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 15 games, is hitting .327 (16-for-49)/1.178 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 15 walks, including 11 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- **Nolan Arenado**, in his last 13 games, is hitting .375 (18-for-48)/1.112 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI and 3 walks, including 7 multi-hit efforts.

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (2-3, 4.65)

- Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings in his last start on May 24 vs. Rockies (W, 1 ER, 6 H, 3 BB, 3 K).
- In his last 4 road starts, is 1-1 with a 2.28 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 23.2 IP), opponent .180 AVG, 0.85 WHIP, 4 walks and 24 strikeouts.
- Will make his first career start vs. Mariners.
