BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles opened a six-game homestand last night and improved to .500 with a 10-3 win against the Red Sox...Following with three-game set with Boston, Baltimore welcomes Houston to Camden Yards for a three-gamer from Tuesday-Thursday next week.

👉 Last night, the O's set season highs in runs (10), hits (20), home runs (6), and total bases (39)...The six home runs and 39 total bases are both single-game highs by an MLB team this year.

👉 The 20 hits were their most in a game since June 27, 2025 vs. Tampa Bay (21 H)...The six home runs were their most in a game since March 27, 2025 at Toronto (also 6 HR) and the most in a home game since June 19, 2021 vs. Toronto (also 6 HR).

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** opened the scoring with a leadoff home run, the first by an Oriole since September 3, 2025 at San Diego (Holliday)...Henderson now has 13 career leadoff homers, tied for third in team history (since 1954) with Al Bumbry, Brian Roberts, and Don Buford, behind Brady Anderson (44) and Cedric Mullins (18).

👉 **Adley Rutschman** drove in six runs for the second time in his career (also 6/9/24 at TB)...The six RBI are the most in the majors by a primary catcher this season...He homered twice, his fourth career multi-homer game (last: 3/27/25 at TOR) and first such effort against a team besides the Blue Jays.

👉 **Coby Mayo** has homered in three consecutive games for the first time in his career...He's the first Oriole to do so since **Tyler O'Neill** from July 25 to 29 (G1), 2025 (4 G).

👉 **Samuel Basallo** tallied a career-high four hits...He had never had more than two in a game in his career entering last night.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles reinstated left-handed pitcher **Keegan Akin** (left groin strain) from the 15-day Injured List today and optioned right-hander **Cameron Foster** to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game.

👉 Akin has not pitched in a game this season...He began a rehab assignment with Norfolk on April 15 and posted a 2.25 ERA (1 ER/4.0 IP) in four appearances.

SEEING RED: In 42 career games against the Red Sox, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .258/.375/.561 (40-for-155) with 11 doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 32 runs, 25 RBI, 27 walks and four steals.

👉 Among all active players, his .936 career OPS against Boston is fourth highest in the majors (min. 175 PA) behind CHC's Alex Bregman (1.013), PIT's Brandon Lowe (.998), and LAD's Teoscar Hernández (.985).

👉 Henderson has only four at-bats against LHP Garrett Crochet, going 0-4 with a walk, a hit by pitch, and three strikeouts...He's batting .208 (5-for-24) vs. lefties this season but four of those hits have gone for extra bases (2 2B, 2 HR).

ACTION JACKSON: **Jeremiah Jackson** has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games since April 10, slashing .315/.339/.630 (17-for-54) with two doubles, five homers, nine runs scored, 15 RBI, and two walks...During that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in RBI (T-3rd) and total bases (T-10th, 34)

👉 He recorded one hit and scored one run in each of his three games in Kansas City while striking out only once...He went 2-for-13 (.154) with one homer, three RBI, one walk, one steal, and six strikeouts during the four-game set in Cleveland.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 24 of the last 25 games since March 28 while slashing .323/.433/.485 (32-for-99) with 13 doubles, one homer, 14 runs scored, 11 RBI, 19 walks, one hit by pitch, and one steal during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

👉 His 13 doubles lead the majors ahead of ATL's Matt Olson (11)...Ward's 13 two-baggers are tied for the most by an Oriole in the first 26 team games of a season in team history (since 1954) with Manny Machado (2016).

👉 Ward has faced 529 total pitches this season, fifth most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (562), teammate **Gunnar Henderson** (533) and ATH's Nick Kurtz (533), and SEA's Cal Raleigh (530).

TIGHT SQUEEZE: Of Baltimore's 26 games, 20 have been decided by three runs or less, tied with the Mariners for the most such games in the majors this season...The Orioles are 9-11 (.450) in those games...The O's have also played 15 games decided by two or fewer runs, tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors, going 9-6 (.600) in those affairs.

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks third in the AL with a 3.36 ERA behind the Rangers (3.07) and Mariners (3.32).

👉 **Rico Garica** has posted a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP) with 13 strikeouts across 12 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

👉 The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*

👉 Overall, the team's 13.8 percent inherited runners scored rate (4 IRS/29 IR) is second in MLB behind the Rockies (13.6%; 6 IRS/44 IR).

SHIPPING DOWN TO BALTIMORE: The Orioles and Red Sox are meeting for the first of two series at Camden Yards this season...Boston returns to Baltimore for a four-game set from September 3-6, while the Birds have two series at Fenway Park from June 2-4 and July 20-22.

👉 Vice President, International Scouting & Operations **Koby Perez** played for two seasons in the Red Sox organization from 2002-03.

👉 Director, Minor League Operations **Kent Qualls** spent eight years with the Boston Red Sox from 1995-2002, working as Director of Player Development and Director of Baseball Operations.

April 25, 1989	- With President George Bush on hand in Anaheim, the Orioles hit into five double plays but get home runs from Mickey Tettleton, Jim Traber, Bill Ripken, and Steve Finley to beat the Angels, 8-1.
April 25, 1998	- Cal Ripken, Jr., playing in his 2,500 th consecutive game, drives in three runs to lead the Orioles to an 8-2 win over the Athletics at Camden Yards. Ripken's sixth-inning single drives in two runs to break a scoreless tie. The crowd of 46,026 gives Ripken a huge ovation when the game becomes official in the fifth.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season and 108th of his career today vs. Boston...Was voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining **Randy Myers** (1997), **Mike Cuellar** (1974), and **Dave McNally** (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since **Rodrigo Lopez** (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second consecutive loss on April 19 at Cleveland, allowing a season-high six runs (5 ER) on six hits (2 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...Threw 95 pitches, 68 strikes...Has given up 10 runs (9 ER) over his last two starts (9.2 IP) after working 6.0+ innings and allowing two runs or fewer in each of his first three starts (19.0 IP) to open the year.

- ⚾ Has issued four walks over his last four starts (21.2 IP) after walking four hitters over 7.0 innings in his Opening Day start vs. Minnesota.
- ⚾ Allowed six or more runs only once last season on September 26 at New York-AL (also 6 R).

BEANTOWN: Rogers is set to make his sixth career start vs. Boston today, going 1-2 with a 2.13 ERA (6 ER/25.1 IP) in his previous five outings...Both of his starts against the Red Sox in 2025 came at Fenway Park, including his most recent one on August 18 in which he earned the win after tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball on four hits and one walk with seven strikeouts...He didn't factor into the decision of his other start at Boston on May 24 despite 6.1 scoreless innings, but the O's pulled out a 2-1 victory.

- ⚾ His 2.13 ERA against the Red Sox is his lowest mark vs. any opponent (min. 5 GS).
- ⚾ Holds a 4-4 record and 3.02 ERA (28 ER/83.1 IP) over 17 career starts opposite the AL East, but his teams are just 7-10 (.412) in his starts.

BEST OF THE BEST: Since making his 2025 season debut on May 24 (G2) at Boston, Rogers' 2.28 ERA (35 ER/138.1 IP) is third lowest in MLB (min. 125.0 IP), trailing PIT's Paul Skenes (1.89) and DET's Tarik Skubal (2.09).

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL: Rogers has been nearly a full run better during the day compared to night starts in his career, posting a 4.25 ERA (146 ER/309.1 IP) at night compared to a 3.31 mark (88 ER/239.1 IP) in the daytime...Last season, Rogers allowed three runs or fewer in his first 10 starts at night while pitching to a 1.37 ERA (9 ER/59.1 IP) before allowing six runs in 3.0 innings on September 26 at New York-AL...Four of his five starts this season have been during the day.

- ⚾ Allowed two runs or fewer in 10 straight daytime starts from July 6, 2025 to April 7, 2026, snapping the streak in his last outing on April 19 after giving up six runs (5 ER) at Cleveland...Marked the second-longest such streak among starting pitchers in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Kyle Bradish's** 12-game run from June 25, 2023-May 26, 2024.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Rogers allowed his first two home runs of the season in his last start on April 19 at Cleveland...However, since making his MLB debut on August 25, 2020, Rogers has allowed 0.84 home runs per nine innings, the seventh-lowest mark in the majors (min. 500.0 IP), trailing SF's Logan Webb (0.61), NYY's Max Fried (0.67), DET's Framer Valdez (0.70), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.76), BOS' Ranger Suarez (0.79), and LAD's Blake Snell (0.80).

- ⚾ Since making his season debut in 2025, Rogers has permitted nine home runs over 138.1 innings, three of which came in last year's season finale at New York-AL.

FOUR-SEAM FOCUS: Last season, Rogers featured his four-seam fastball 40.8 percent of the time and limited the opposition to a .158 (22-for-139) clip on the offering...The .158 opponent average was the second lowest among all MLB starters (min. 100 AB ending in pitch), trailing SEA's Bryan Woo (.153, 42-for-274).

- ⚾ Thus far in 2026 opponents are 13-for-45 (.289) off his four-seamer, including 2-for-4 with a double and a home run in his last outing on April 19 at Cleveland.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of **Dave McNally** (1.95 ERA, 1968) and **Jim Palmer** (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).
