**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 7 game road trip with the second of 3 games against the Chicago White Sox (1-0)...the Mariners are coming off a homestand that featured a series win against the Braves (2-1), Atlanta's first series loss of the season, and a matchup against the Royals (0-3)...tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call with **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners won last night's series opener against the White Sox by a 12-8 score... Seattle is 9-5 over its last 14 games and 11-7 over its last 18 games.

- **Rizzs Returns Home** - Mariners radio broadcaster **Rick Rizzs**, who announced his plans to retire at the end of the 2026 season, grew up on the South Side of Chicago and is a 1975 graduate of Southern Illinois University in Carbondale...he'll be on the call against the White Sox in his final series in Chicago.
- **At Rate Field** - Since the start of the 2023 season the Mariners have yet to lose a series against the White Sox in Chicago...over that span the Mariners are 8-2 against Chicago-AL at Rate Field.
- **2-Out Rally** - 11 of Seattle's 12 runs last night were hit with 2-outs, the T-3rd most RBI on 2-outs in franchise history, trailing the franchise record 13 RBI hit on 2-outs on May 31, 2016 at San Diego.
- **Multi-Homer Madness** - Mariners batters have recorded 23 multi-homer games since 2022, ranking 3rd in the Majors during that span behind only the Yankees (27 G) and Braves (27 G).

**BRENDAN IS BACK**...infielder/outfielder **Brendan Donovan** was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List yesterday (left groin muscle strain)...in a corresponding move, **C Jhonny Pereda** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...in 18 games with Seattle prior to being placed on the IL, Donovan hit .304 (17x56) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 1 stolen base and 9 walks, reaching base at a .437 clip with a .954 OPS.

**ROCK YOUR SOX OFF**...in 4 career starts against the White Sox, **Luis Castillo** is 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (5 ER, 26.1 IP) with 28 strikeouts and just 1 walk...in his last start against the White Sox on May 19, 2025 at T-Mobile Park, Castillo tossed 7.0 shutout innings with 3 hits allowed and 5 strikeouts...in a start he made against them on Sept. 7, 2022 at T-Mobile Park, Luis tied a Mariners record by striking out each of the first 7 batters he faced.

**OH MY JOSH**...**Josh Naylor** went 3-for-5 with 3 runs, 1 home run and 3 RBI last night, his 4th 3+ hit game of the season...over his last 17 games (4/17-c), the first baseman is batting .394 (26x66) with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 6 walks and 7 stolen bases, reaching base at a .438 clip and slugging .576 for a 1.014 OPS...during that span, Naylor leads the Majors in batting average and ranks 8th in OBP among qualified players...Naylor has hit safely in the last 7-consecutive games (5/1-c), during which his is batting .379 (11x29).

**OFF THE RALES**...**Luke Raley** last night went 2-for-5 with a grand slam and a 3-run home run, his 3rd career multi-homer game and first since April 30, 2023 at the White Sox with Tampa Bay...he drove in a career-high 7 RBI and became the first Mariners player with a grand slam and 3-run homer in the same game since Nelson Cruz on July 23, 2016 at Toronto...after battling through a recent 0-for-20 stretch, Raley is 4-for-11 (.364) with 3 runs, 3 home runs, 10 RBI and 1 walk over his last 13 plate appearances.

**RED HOT J-ROD**...**Julio Rodríguez** went 2-for-5 with his 6th home run of the season last night, marking his 199th career multi-hit game...he has also homered in back-to-back games for the 20th time in his career...in 25 games since April 11, Julio is batting .327 (33x101) with 17 runs, 7 doubles, 6 home runs, 16 RBI, 7 walks and is 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .376 clip and slugging .574 with a .950 OPS in 109 plate appearances.

**NO FREE BASES**...The Mariners pitching staff has only issued 96 walks this season, the fewest in the Majors, ranking ahead of the next closest Yankees (118 BB) by a large margin...they also lead MLB in walks-per-nine innings (2.48) and strikeout-to-walk rate (3.39) this season...the Mariners currently have two starting pitchers among the league's best in both metrics: **Bryan Woo** ranks 2nd with 1.53 BB/9 and 7th with 4.75 K/BB...**Emerson Hancock** ranks 4th with 1.70 BB/9 and 3rd with 5.56 K/BB.

**J.P. CRAWFORD: GOOD BASEBALL PLAYER**...**J.P. Crawford** has reached base safely in 10-consecutive games (4/27-c), batting .259 (9x35) with 9 runs, 3 home runs, 5 RBI, 11 walks to just 5 strikeouts and 1 stolen base, reaching base at a .435 clip, slugging .514 for a .949 OPS...Crawford has walked (26) more than he has struck out (21) this season, for a 1.24 walk-to-strikeout rate that ranks 2nd in the Majors in 2026...additionally, Crawford's 19.5% walk rate ranks 4th in MLB...since 2022, his 314 walks rank 7th in MLB and 2nd in the AL behind only Aaron Judge-NYY (484 BB).

**RELIABLE 'PEN**...The Mariners bullpen owns a 3.28 ERA (45 ER, 123.1) this season that currently ranks 3rd in the Majors behind only Texas (2.93 ERA) and New York-AL (3.18)...their 44 walks allowed are the fewest in the Majors this season and their 1.33 WHIP ranks 7th...Seattle is the only team in MLB to have 4 relievers with an ERA under 2.50 this season (min. 10.0 IP): **Eduard Bazarro** (1.53 ERA in 17.2 IP), **Matt Brash** (0.00 ERA in 11.1 IP), **Cooper Criswell** (2.20 in 16.1 IP) and **José A. Ferrer** (1.89 in 19.0 IP).

**ALL IS FERRER IN LOVE AND WAR**...Mariners reliever **José A. Ferrer** holds a 1.89 ERA (4 ER, 19.0 IP) with 3 walks, 16 strikeouts and 2 saves in 20 appearances this season...Ferrer has held opponents to a 17.5% hard-hit rate that ranks 6th among qualified relievers this season.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Luke Raley** hit a grand slam in the 3rd inning of yesterday's series opener, his first career grand slam...but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...the Mariners have hit 19 grand slams since 2023, which ranks 4th-most in the Majors during that span behind only the Diamondbacks (26), Dodgers (22) and Orioles (20)?...**Cal Raleigh** and **J.P. Crawford** have each hit 5 grand slams during that timeframe, T-2nd most (also: 4 others) behind only Max Muncy-LAD (6).

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 9

- **1986** - Alvin Davis, in the middle of a 14-game hitting streak (May 1-14), set a Mariners single-game record, and an AL season best with 8 RBI, going 3-for-4, including a grand slam and a three-run HR, his first-ever multiple home run game, as the Mariners topped Toronto 13-3 at the Kingdome.
- **1997** - Joey Cora ties a Mariners record with five hits in an 8-2 win at Baltimore...he also hits his first-ever home run from the right side of the plate off reliever Arthur Rhodes.
- **2002** - The Mariners set club records with 16 walks and 6 stolen bases in an 8-7, 11 inning win vs. Toronto.
- **2016** - Félix Hernández wins his 146th career game, surpassing Jamie Moyer for most wins in club history...he went 7.0 innings against the Rays, giving up 4 hits, 2 runs and 2 walks while striking out 4.

ABOUT CASTILLO...

- The 33-year-old right-hander is set to make his 8th start of the year and his 251st career start...it will also be his 1st start of the season against the White Sox and the 5th of his career.
Originally signed as an international free agent by the San Francisco Giants on Dec. 23, 2011.
Made MLB debut on June 23, 2017 vs. Washington (w/ CIN).
Signed a 5-year contract extension with the Seattle Mariners on Sept. 24, 2022 after being acquired in a trade with Cincinnati on July 30, 2022.
Named an All-Star in 2019 (CIN), 2022 (CIN) and 2023 (SEA).

LAST TIME OUT...L#3 on May 3 vs. Kansas City...tossed 5 strikeouts across 6.0 innings and allowed 4 runs (4 ER) on 6 hits and 2 walks...he threw a season-high 101 pitches (62 strikes) in his 7th start of the season.

"I'm about nine years in the league ... (and) same routine, same preparation from one start to another...Sometimes there are obstacles that happen throughout the season and there's bad luck. But it's not going to last the entire season. So just continue working, preparing and good things will come."

SEASONED VET...made his 250th career start in his last start on May 2nd vs. Kansas City...became 1 of 5 active pitchers with 250+ starts since 2017, joining Patrick Corbin-4Tms (270 GS), José Berríos-MIN/TOR (259 GS), Aaron Nola-PHI (259 GS), and Kevin Gausman-5Tms (258 GS)...among 19 active pitchers with 250 career starts, his 3.62 ERA and 9.5 strikeouts-per-nine innings each rank 8th.

KEEPING IT 100...threw 100+ pitches for the first time this season in his last start on May 2nd vs. Kansas City...is 1-of-2 Mariners starters to throw 100+ pitches in a start this season, joining Emerson Hancock who did so the night before, on Randy Johnson's Number Retirement Ceremony night (5/2/26 vs. KC)...has thrown 100+ pitches in 101 career games, tied for 5th-most games in MLB since 2017.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX...is making his first start against the White Sox since May 19, 2025 where he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just 3 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts...is 2-0 with a 1.71 ERA (5 ER, 26.1IP) and 28 strikeouts to 1 walk across 4 career starts against the White Sox...has tossed 7.0 innings without a walk in each of his last 2 starts against the White Sox, both at Guaranteed Rate Field.

REMEMBER WHEN...he threw 7.0 innings allowing just 1 run (1 ER) on 5 hits, 0 walks and 9 strikeouts on Aug. 21, 2023 at the White Sox, finishing his outing with 47 consecutive fastballs...he was incredibly efficient during his streak of fastballs, allowing no runs, just 3 hits and striking out 6 batters...his 83.2% fastballs (79 of 95 total pitches) during the outing is still the 3rd-highest mark of his career.

WELL TRAVELED...is making his 4th road start of the season (last: 4/27 at MIN)...his 120 career road starts are 5th-most in MLB since 2017...has thrown 5.0+ innings in 99 career road starts (7th-most such games in MLB since 2017), 6.0+ in 63 starts, and 7.0+ in 18 starts...his 666.1 career innings pitched on the road ranks 7th-most in MLB since 2017.

MAY FLOWERS...across 16 starts in May as a Mariner (since 2023), he is 4-6 with a 3.42 ERA (36 ER, 94.2 IP), 91 strikeouts to 27 walks allowed for a 3.37 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 8.65 SO/9...has tossed 6.0+ in 12 of those 16 starts in May, including 10 quality starts.

AMONG MARINER GREATS...his 3.61 ERA with Seattle is T6th for the lowest ERA in franchise history (min. 500.0 IP), behind Félix Hernández, Randy Johnson, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton (all 3.42 ERA), and George Kirby (3.54), alongside Logan Gilbert (3.61)...his 664 strikeouts with the Mariners are 10th-most in franchise history (next: Hisashi Iwakuma, 714 SO)...his 1.171 WHIP and 9.2 strikeouts-per-nine innings each rank 4th-best among Mariners with 500.0+ innings pitched.

WHIFF LEADER...registered a season-high 17 swings and misses and 7 swinging strikeouts in his first start of the season (3/30 vs. NYY)...leads MLB since 2017 with 3,467 swings and misses across his career, ranking ahead of Kevin Gausman (3,450) and Max Scherzer (3,308)...his 1,273 career swinging strikeouts are 3rd-most in MLB since 2017, trailing Max Scherzer (1,320), Kevin Gausman (1,309), and ranking ahead of Gerrit Cole (1,267).

LA PIEDRA...among qualified pitchers since 2017 (his debut season), he is 5th in quality starts (136), 5th in games started (249), 6th in innings pitched (1439.0), 7th in total strikeouts (1519) and 12th in wins (84).

ALL-DECADE ACCOLADES...is one of 5 pitchers in the last 10 seasons (2017-c) to have at least 1,500 strikeouts and a WHIP below 1.20, joining Gerrit Cole, Aaron Nola, Max Scherzer, and Zack Wheeler.

1,500...collected his 1,500th career strikeout on a swinging strikeout to Aaron Judge in the 6th inning of his March 30 start vs. Yankees...he became just the 7th pitcher to throw 1,500 career strikeouts since 2017.

GOING THE DISTANCE...has tossed 6.0+ innings in 150 career starts, the 6th-most in MLB since 2017...has tossed a quality start in 136 of those starts, the 5th-most games since 2017 and has thrown 6.0+ scoreless innings in 40 career starts, T2nd-most since 2017, alongside Kevin Gausman, trailing only Zack Wheeler (42 G).

IN COMMAND...has tossed 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks in 55 career games since 2023 (last: 5/3 vs. KC), 5th-most in MLB across that span, trailing only Logan Webb (71 G), teammate George Kirby (61 G), Zack Wheeler (61 G) and Tarik Skubal (57 G).
