



San Francisco Giants (73-78) at Baltimore Orioles (84-67) RHP Hayden Birdsong (3-5, 4.74) vs. RHP Dean Kremer (7-9, 4.10)





TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to secure a series win tonight here in Baltimore after blanking the Orioles 10-0 last night in the series opener.

- ▶ This is the second game of the Giants final road trip of the year...after this series the Giants travel to Kansas City for a weekend series with the Royals, SF's first trip to Kauffman Stadium since 2017...the Giants then wrap the road trip in Arizona next Monday-Wednesday.
- ▶ The Giants ended their four-game losing streak last night but are still 12-20 (.375) since August 11...the .375 winning percentage in that span is worst in the National League and third-lowest in the Majors ahead of the Angels (10-24, .294) and White Sox (8-25, .242).

ROSTER MOVES: IF Matt Chapman was placed on the Paternity List and **IF Casey Schmitt** (#10) has been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.

BALTIMORE SUN: This visit is just the third time SF has come to Baltimore since Interleague play began with the only other prior visits coming in 2004 and 2019...SF is 5-2 in this facility.

- ▶ **OF Mike Yastrzemski**, who was originally drafted by the Orioles in 14th round in 2013, has gone 6-for-15 in four games played here with a triple, two homers, five RBI, seven runs scored and four walks.
- ▶ Baltimore-native **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.** played his first-ever MLB game in this ballpark last night, going 2-for-5 a run scored and two RBI...with last night's game, Wade has now played a game in all 30 MLB stadiums.

SHAKE AND BLAKE: With 6.0 scoreless innings last night, **LHP Blake Snell** now owns a 1.33 ERA (11er, 74.1ip) in his 13 starts since July 9, lowest among qualified MLB starters in that time...SF is 11-2 in his 13 starts since July 9.

- ▶ Snell has held opposing hitters to a .124 average against in this span...according to *MLB's* Sarah Langs and *Elias*, there have only been two other pitchers in the live-ball era (since 1920) with an opponent's average against that low over a 13-start span (excluding openers).
- NYM's Jacob deGrom held hitters to a .122 clip over a 13-start stretch from April 17-July 7, 2021 and MIL's Freddy Peralta held hitters to a .113 average over a 13-start span from May 11-July 29, 2021.

ROAD CHALLENGES: The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter today with a 32-41 (.438) road record... the .438 road winning percentage is 22nd of 30 MLB clubs and fourth-worst in the NL ahead of only Washington (32-44, .421), Miami (27-48, .360) and Colorado (23-55, .295).

▶ SF did win its last road series in San Diego from September 6-8, taking two-of-three from the Padres and are 6-6 on the road since August 11...in that same span at home, oddly, the Giants have gone 6-14.

BAT SIGNAL: Giants hitters own a .685 OPS in 54 games since the All-Star break, 24th of 30 MLB clubs and second-lowest in the National League ahead of only the Pirates (.676).

- ▶ The club's 27.0% strikeout rate is second-highest in the Majors in that time behind only the 28.0% strikeout rate of the Colorado Rockies.
- ▶ SF has averaged 4.00 runs/game since the break, second-lowest in the NL just ahead of the Cardinals (3.93) and 25th of 30 MLB teams in that time.

BIRDS AND THE BIRDS: RHP Hayden Birdsong makes his 14th start of the year for SF as he faces the Orioles for the first time in his career.

- ▶ Birdsong turned in one of his best outings since the end of July in his start last Thursday against the Brewers at Oracle Park...he spun 5.0 scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one and struck out four...it was his first time completing 5.0 innings since July 27.
- ▶ The 23-year-old has made 13 starts with SF but also made 13 minor league starts before his promotion...his 26 starts this year are one more than he made in his first full year last year (he appeared in 28 games, 25 as a starter) while his 114.1 innings have surpassed his 100.2 MiLB innings in 2023.

ON A HEATER: OF Mike Yastrzemski clubbed his 16th homer of the year last night, fifth this month...in fact, seven of his 16 homers have come in his last 19 games since August 24.

- ▶ It's the first time Yastrzemski has homered five times in a month since March/April of last year when he also hit five... the only times in his career he's homered more times in a single month are August 2019 (nine) and July 2021 (seven).
- ► Since August 24, Yastrzemski has a .940 OPS with two doubles, seven homers, 13 RBI, 14 runs scored and 10 walks in 19 games.
- ► For the year, Yastrzemski has been worth 2.3 bWAR with a 115 OPS+.


AWARD SZN: Minor League Baseball earlier today announced their end of season league awards and All-Star teams for the Single-A California League and the Giants had two representatives on the lists from their San Jose affiliate.

- ▶ Left-handed reliever **Cesar Perdomo** was named to the end of season California League All-Star team as a reliever... Perdomo went 5-1 with a 1.26 ERA (6er, 43.0ip), 50 strikeouts, a .219 opponent's average against and a 1.07 WHIP in 13 games (one start) for San Jose before a promotion to High-A Eugene on June 25.
- ▶ Perdomo, 22, was originally signed by SF out of Venezuela as a minor league free agent on July 2, 2021.
- San Jose Manager **Ydwin Villegas** (pronounced id-win) was named the California League's Manager of the Year after leading the club to the best overall record in the league at 74-57 and a playoff berth.
- ▶ Villegas was in his first year managing in 2024 after spending the 2023 season as San Jose's Fundamentals Coach...from 2020-2022 he was the Fundamentals Coach with the ACL Giants and in 2019 he was the Bullpen Catcher at San Jose.

TODAY'S START: The 23-year-old is scheduled to make his 14th big league start today...he's gone 3-5 with a 4.74 ERA (30er, 57.0ip) in his 13 starts, with the Giants going 4-9 in his outings... had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26.

LAST TIME OUT: Had one of his strongest outings since late July last Thursday at Oracle Park after throwing 5.0 shutout innings against the Brewers...allowed just two hits, struck out four over and walked only one in his efficient 68-pitch outing.

BACK ON TRACK: Birdsong is steering back on course after struggling last month...his 5.0 inning outing last Thursday was his first since his start on July 27...in his previous six starts (8/6-9/4), Birdsong posted an 8.31 ERA (20er, 21.2ip) and allowed batters a .253 average and a .926 OPS...the Giants were 0-6 in those six starts...in his first six starts w/SF, Birdsong posted a 2.97 ERA (10er, 30.1ip) and held batters to a .204 average and a .664 OPS... the Giants went 4-2 in those six starts.

THROW THAT CURVE: He's thrown 218 curveballs this season at the MLB level and batters are 6-for-51 (.118) with 25 strikeouts against it...the Orioles have done well against the curveball this season...their .252 average against it ranks fourth-best in the Majors, while their .469 slugging percentage is best in the league.

VS. THE LEFTY: Lefties are batting just .204 (23x113) with a .327 slugging percentage off Birdsong this season, while righties are hitting .234 (22x94) with a .500 SLG...however, Birdsong issues far more walks to lefties (6.89 BB/9) vs. righties (4.21 BB/9).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Birdsong owns a 3.67 ERA (11er, 27.0ip) at home versus a 5.70 ERA (19er, 30.0ip) on the road...opponents own a .788 OPS against Birdsong on the road and a .697 OPS at home.

NEED TO WORK AHEAD: Birdsong got ahead with more first pitch strikes in his last outing against Milwaukee, logging a 64.7 first pitch strike % in the outing...in his tough six start stretch that preceded his Milwaukee start his first pitch strike % was 46.7%...he owned a 60.2 first pitch strike % in his first six outings (SF went 4-2)...after Birdsong falls behind 1-0, opposing batters have walked 24 times while posting an .852 OPS...when he's gotten ahead 0-1 they have a .637 OPS and have drawn just 12 walks.

HEAVY LIFTING: Birdsong has worked a combined 114.1 innings this year between Double-A Richmond (48.1ip), Triple-A Sacramento (9.0ip) and the Giants (52.0ip)...in fact he's already passed his innings total from last year (100.2 innings across three levels), which was his first full year in pro ball after being drafted in 2022.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: The Illinois native entered the 2024 campaign as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America* and #7 according to *MLB.com...*he has since graduated from the prospect rankings given his accrued MLB time this year but is still one of SF's younger pitching hopefuls having just turned 23 on Aug. 30.

EARLY ARRIVAL: Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining **OF Wade Meckler** (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just four players from the *first* round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels, OF Jordan Beck with Colorado, IF Brooks Lee with Minnesota)...at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.
