THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY JULY 25

1980 - At Olympic Stadium in Montreal, the Astros stun the Expos with 7 runs in the 9th inning for a dramatic, 9-8, comeback win. Houston trailed the Expos, 7-2, entering that 9th inning before rallying for the improbable win.

2005 - In a 7-1 win over the Phillies, Craig Biggio and Lance Berkman become the 1st Astros teammates to hit back-to-back HR twice in the same game. They do so in the 1st and 3rd innings, with all 4 HR coming off Phils starter RHP Cory Lidle.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Tonight, the Astros and White Sox play the 2nd game of this 3-game series at Rate Field in Chicago...**RHP Hunter Brown** (1-1) starts for the Astros as he takes on White Sox **RHP Sean Burke** (7-4).

ROAD WARRIORS: Tonight is the 2nd game of a 6-game road trip for the Astros, during which they are scheduled to play 3-game sets vs. the Chicago White Sox (Fri.-Sun.) and Los Angeles Angels (Mon.-Wed.)...the Astros are 18-12 (.600) on their last five road trips combined and are 24-18 (.571) on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season.

ROAD SLUGGING: The Astros are T-1st in the AL in road HR (73) while ranking 2nd in road OPS (.746) and road SLG (.421) and 3rd in road runs scored (252).

BROTHER BROWN: **RHP Hunter Brown** will make his 9th start of the season and his 7th since returning from a lengthy stint on the IL with a right shoulder strain...**Last Start:** Took the loss on 7/19 vs. BAL (4.2 IP, 3 ER, 6 BB, 4 SO)...**FOUR-FOR-FOUR:** Brown is 4-0 in his 4 career starts vs. the White Sox with a 2.92 ERA (8ER/24.2IP) with 29 K's...**Top Rate:** He is 3-0 in 3 career starts at Rate Field with a 3.57 ERA (7ER/17.2IP) with 23 K's...his last start vs. the White Sox was an 8-3 win on May 3 at Rate Field (6 IP, 3 ER, 9 SO)...**Last Season:** Finished 3rd in the AL Cy Young voting after posting a 12-9 record with a 2.43 ERA and 206 strikeouts.

VS. THE CHISOX: The Astros are facing the White Sox for the 1st time in 2026...they were 3-3 vs. CWS last season, going 2-1 at home and 1-2 here in Chicago...the Astros are 21-13 (.618) vs. CWS over the past 6 seasons (2021-26), posting winning records in each of the past 5 seasons...HOU is 54-46 all-time vs. CWS...the Astros are now 4-0 in Chicago in 2026 (swept the Cubs at Wrigley, May 22-24).

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros rallied from a 5-0 deficit, thanks to an 8-run outburst in the 6th inning en route to a 9-5 win over the White Sox last night...a 3-run double by **Christian Walker** and a 2-run HR by **Cam Smith** were the key blows in the inning that saw the Astros send 14 men to the plate...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (5-6) earned the win in relief...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** started the game, but was forced to leave after just 1.0 IP due to right foot nerve irritation...**Jeremy Pena** (3x6) and **Jose Altuve** (3x5) both had 3-hit games.

RIDING THE LAMBO: **RHP Peter Lambert** continued his solid pitching on Wednesday, allowing just 2 runs in 6.0 IP...using a minimum of 95.0 IP, Lambert ranks 2nd in the AL in H/9IP (6.6), 6th in ERA (3.03) and T-8th in wins (8)...since May 24, he is 6-1 with a 2.73 ERA in 11 starts.

MOVING UP THE LIST: Manager **Joe Espada** earned his 225th win as the Astros skipper on Wednesday night vs. MIA, moving him past **Terry Collins** and into 10th place all-time in club history...**Hal Lanier** (254 wins) is 9th on the list.

FIRST BLOOD: The Astros rank 1st in the AL and 2nd in the Majors in 1st-inning runs (68)...additionally, HOU is 35-15 when scoring 1st this season.

CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 31-20 in games decided by 2 runs or less...22-12 in 2-run games, 9-8 in 1-run games.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** is a strong AL MVP candidate as he enters tonight leading the league in all three Triple Crown categories, ranking 1st in batting average (.327), HR (34), and RBI (77)...additionally, he currently leads all of baseball in OPS (1.084), OBP (.432), SLG (.652) and TB (245), and in the AL, he also ranks 1st in hits (123) and runs (71) and 4th in walks (67)...AL leaders below:

HOT STREAK: **Yordan Alvarez** enters tonight with a 10-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting a sizzling .486 (18x37) with 4 2B, 5 HR and 10 RBI.

HISTORIC HOMERS: **Yordan Alvarez** has 34 HR through the Astros' 1st 105 games, which are the 3rd-most in franchise history at this point in a season...see below (per Elias):
Most HR thru 105 G: Bagwell-36 ('94), Bagwell-35 ('99)

PENA POWER: **Jeremy Peña** has hit safely in 6 straight games at .478 (11x23) with 3 HR and 6 RBI...during this stretch, Pena homered in 3 consecutive games (7/20-22), becoming the 5th different Astros SS to do so...the others are: **Carlos Correa, Jed Lowrie, Andujar Cedeno, Craig Reynolds.**

HIT PAREDES: **Isaac Paredes** has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games at .353 (12x34) with 2 HR and 7 RBI in that span...since June 3, Paredes is batting .297 (46x155) with 22 runs scored, 6 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR, 30 RBI and 19 walks in 42 games.

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros rank 2nd in the AL in fielding pct. (.988) and have the 2nd-fewest errors in the AL (43)...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in his 100 games played at 1B...dating back to last season, Walker has not made an error in his last 128 games at 1B (last error was Aug. 23, 2025 at BAL).

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 73 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (59%)...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-23 challenges (65%), ranking third in the Majors in challenges won...**3B Isaac Paredes** (11-for-13, 85%) has been the most efficient challenger for the Astros.

BRYAN'S BACK: **RHP Bryan Abreu** has a 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP) in his last 10 apps. with just 6 hits allowed and 12 K's in that span...additionally, since May 1, he has a 2.45 ERA (7ER/25.2IP) in 26 apps., and is 5-for-5 in save opp. in that span...prior to May 1, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his 1st 11 apps. of the season.

ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have recalled **LHP Bryan King** from Triple A Sugar Land and have placed **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** on the 15-day Injured List due to right foot nerve irritation...King will join the Astros today in Chicago.

LAST START, JULY 19 vs. BAL: Made his first start after the All-Star break on Sunday vs. the Orioles...worked 4.2 innings, allowing 4 runs on 3 hits...walked a career-high 6 batters and tied his career high with 2 HBP...tossed 92 pitches, including 45 strikes...this outing was his 6th since being activated off the IL.

THE DIESEL: The Astros 2026 Opening Day starter, Brown has been limited to just 8 Major League starts on the season due to a 2-plus month-long IL stint due to a right shoulder strain...went 1-0 with a 0.84 ERA (1ER/10.2IP) in his first 2 starts of the year prior to the injury...in his 6 starts since returning from the IL, has gone 0-1 with a 5.22 ERA (17ER/29.1IP).

SAVANT SAYS: Among all Major League pitchers, is in the 96th percentile in avg. exit velo (85.4), 93rd percentile in groundball perc. (53.9), and the 90th perc. in expected batting average (.200).

FOUR SEAMS: Has had trouble locating his 4-seamer this season, but when he does throw it for strikes, it has been effective...has held opponents to a .158 batting average (6x38) with his 4-seam fastball and has tossed the pitch at a 33.3-percent rate, the highest of all his pitches.

VS. CWS: Is a perfect 4-0 with a 2.92 ERA (8ER/24.2IP) in 4 career starts against the White Sox...last started against them on May 3, 2025 at CWS (3ER/6IP) in an Astros 8-3 win...his 4 wins against the White Sox tie as his most against any opponent, also the Rangers (4-4) and the A's (4-3).

MINOR LEAGUE WORK: Made 4 rehab appearances this season on his way back from injury between Double A and Triple A...combined for a 1.88 ERA (3ER/14.1IP) with 21 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.77 WHIP and a .157 opponent average.

ALL-STAR SEASON: A 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...in 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)...among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft (No. 28 overall)...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration...the Astros used that selection on **RHP Jack Radel** out of Notre Dame.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/25 at CWS): Struck out 2 batters and worked around 1 hit while tossing a scoreless 7th inning in last night's win at CWS, picking up his 6th hold of the year.

HEAT OF THE SUMMER: Over his last 10 appearances (since June 20), he's posted a 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a .167 opponent batting average and a 0.84 WHIP.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 2-1-5 with a 2.45 ERA (7ER/25.2IP)...has also recorded 29 strikeouts, a 1.13 WHIP and a .195 opponent batting average during the stretch...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is T-2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak)...prior to May 1, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.

VS. CWS: In 14 career appearances vs. the White Sox, he's recorded an 0.00 ERA (0ER/14IP) with 25 strikeouts, 2 walks, a 0.36 WHIP and a .065 opponent batting average...is the only AL team he hasn't allowed a run to.

MILESTONE MARKERS: Is currently at 493 career strikeouts and is seeking to become the 4th reliever in Astros history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining LHP Billy Wagner (694), RHP Brad Lidge (557) and RHP Dave Smith (529)...logged his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history.

AT DAIKIN: Has made 176 career appearances at Daikin Park...is 3 apps. from tying RHP Ryan Pressly (179 apps.) for the 3rd-most in the venue's history.

CAREER: In 355 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (117ER/364.2IP) with 493 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP, a 12.17 K/9 and a 0.79 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 3rd in appearances among AL relievers.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/24 at CWS): Worked 2.0 scoreless innings with 2 strikeouts, while working around 1 hit and 1 walk, last night at CWS...entered the game in the 2nd inning after starter RHP Spencer Arrighetti exited the game with right foot nerve irritation.
