## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (26-25) vs. SEATTLE MARINERS (27-25)

MAY 28, 2023 at T-Mobile Park, Seattle, WA -- GAME #52/ROAD #27

RHP LUIS ORTIZ (1-2, 4.02 ERA) vs. LHP MARCO GONZALES (4-1, 5.68 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...were shut out 5-0 in game two of their three-game series Saturday against the Mariners...Have gone 4-5 in their last nine games...Won seven straight games from 4/17-23, their longest winning streak since 2018 (11 games)...Are 0.5 game behind the front-running Brewers in the National League Central coming into today.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Luis Ortiz allowed two runs in 7.2 innings while earning his first career big league win in his last start Monday night against the Rangers at PNC Park...The 7.2 innings were the most for a Pirates rookie since Trevor Williams worked 8.0 innings on August 23, 2017, against the Dodgers...The 93 pitches (59 strikes) Ortiz threw also represented a career-high.

**CALL TO THE PEN:** Pittsburgh's bullpen allowed one unearned run in 6.0 innings of work Saturday afternoon against the Mariners...Pittsburgh's bullpen ranks eighth in MLB and third among all National League teams with a 3.51 ERA...The only two National League teams with a lower bullpen ERA are the Padres (3.27) and Cardinals (3.38)...Pittsburgh's bullpen has also surrendered a total of 14 home runs this season, which are tied for the fewest among all National League teams along with the Cardinals.

**BACK TO THE NL:** Beginning tomorrow afternoon 38 of Pittsburgh's next 41 games will come against the National League...The only three interleague games the Pirates will play will come against the A's at PNC Park during the team's next homestand from June 5-7...The stretch against National League teams will also end with the Giants in a three-game series at PNC Park after the All-Star break from July 14-16.

**BAE, BAE, BAE:** Ji Hwan Bae was hit by a pitch in his first plate appearance on Saturday that extended his on-base streak to nine games...Bae is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with three doubles, three RBI and a .412 on-base percentage during his current nine-game on-base streak...Bae ranks fifth among National League rookies in batting (.269) and first in stolen bases (15).

**ON DECK:** The Pirates will depart for San Francisco following today's game to continue their road trip tomorrow afternoon against the Giants...This will be Pittsburgh's first road series against a National League West team since a three-game sweep of the Rockies at Coors Field from April 17-19...Pittsburgh is 7-5 overall this year against the NL West.

**RULE FIVE RULING:** Jose Hernandez tossed 3.0 scoreless innings on Saturday, which was the longest outing by a Pirates relief pitcher this season...Hernandez, who was selected by the Pirates this past offseason during the Rule 5 Draft, comes into today ranked second among National League rookie relievers in ERA (2.38), tied for second in strikeouts (23), fourth in batting average against (.214) and third in OPS against (.608).

**LOVING LEFTIES:** Connor Joe enters today with the sixth-best OPS (.702) against left-handed pitchers in all of MLB while teammate Rodolfo Castro ranks seventh (.686)...Ji Hwan Bae is hitting at a .342 clip (13-for-38) against southpaws...Pittsburgh is 8-5 in games started by opposing lefthanders this season after going 22-33 last year.

**CUTCH'S MILESTONES:** Andrew McCutchen is two doubles shy of 400 in his career and two away from 300 as a Pirate...McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in team history in doubles...Paul Waner ranks first with 559, followed by Honus Wagner (556), Roberto Clemente (440), Willie Stargell (423), Max Carey (375) and Pie Traynor (371).

**MANNING THE DH:** Andrew McCutchen has made each of his last 30 starts as the team's designated hitter...McCutchen ranks seventh in all of MLB among designated hitters in home runs (seven) and slugging percentage (.432) and sixth in OPS (.778)...McCutchen's last start in the field came on April 13 at St. Louis when he had one chance while starting in right field.

**RUDY:** Rodolfo Castro is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with a pair of doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, .382 OBP, .542 slugging percentage and .923 OPS over his last 14 starts beginning on April 25...Castro has hit safely in each of his last four starts, going 6-for-14 with a pair of home runs and four RBI.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Right-handed pitcher Cody Bolton has allowed one run in 6.0 innings in his five appearances this month with Triple-A Indianapolis...Since allowing two runs in his Indianapolis season debut on March 31, Bolton has recorded a 1.13 ERA (16.Oip/2er), .157 batting average against and 0.75 WHIP in his last 12 outings with Indianapolis.
