RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers wrap of their three-game series today from American Family Field on the YouTube MLB Game of the Week ... After today's series finale, St. Louis travels to San Diego for a three-game weekend series at Petco Park in a rematch of the 2020 Wild Card Series.

STL FLY: Winners of 14 of 19 since April 23, the Cardinals enter play today in 1st place in the NL Central, 2.0 games ahead of Milwaukee and a half game behind San Francisco (22-14) for the best record in the National League ... St. Louis has a +25 run differential (4th in NL and tops in NL Central).

BOTTOMS UP: Since the Cardinals and Brewers began play in 1997, St. Louis owns Major League Baseball's best winning percentage (110-79, .582) of any team to visit Milwaukee, while their .587 win pct. (98-69) since American Family Field opened in 2001 is tops among teams to annually play in Milwaukee.

WHY SO SERIOUS: Jack Flaherty leads MLB in run support (54), run support per 9 IP (11.76) and wins (6) as the Cardinals have won each of his first seven starts this season with a +45 run differential (66-21) ... The last time St. Louis won the first eight games of a starter's season was in 2015 when Michael Wacha began his season 7-0 and the Cardinals won his first nine starts (Apr. 11-May 24), the same season and stretch that former Cardinals outfielder Matt Holliday reached base safely in his first 45 games to begin the season.

SENIOR CIRCUIT SLUGGERS: The Cardinals sport the NL's best record when homering (20-6) and when going yard multiple times (12-2) in games (2-9 when not homering) ... St. Louis ranks 3rd in the NL in home runs (47) while the Cardinals and Reds are the only two NL team with four players with six+ home runs (Nolan Arenado, Paul DeJong, Paul Goldschmidt, Tyler O'Neill) ... The Cardinals lead all of MLB in home runs with runners on base (26), runners in scoring position (18), total runners on base that score via home runs (39), and homers (38) in team wins. The Redbirds (86 of 168, 51.2%) trail only Atlanta (88 of 163, 53.9%) in both runs scored via home run and % of runs scored via homer.

BREW CREW BASHERS: The Cardinals have hit 208 home runs in Milwaukee since 2001 (most among all opponents), with Yadier Molina's 18 homers ranking 4th-most all-time among visiting players and his most for any road venue in his career ... Among Major Leaguers with at least 80 career plate appearances at American Family Field, both Paul Goldschmidt and Nolan Arenado rank in the top 5 in batting, on-base pct., slugging, and OPS all-time in MLB history ... Goldschmidt has homered 14 times in 40 career games in Milwaukee while Arenado has hit safely in 15 of 19 games and going yard in seven.

DOING IT BADER: Since his activation from the injured list on April 29, Harrison Bader has recorded a hit and/or RBI in all 12 games while reaching base safely in 11 (.275/.333/.525) with three home runs and eight RBI (STL is 9-3) ... Bader leads all Major League outfielders in Statcast's catch probability (91.7%, 11 of 12); paces MLB centerfielders (min. 12 games) in total chances/9 (3.51), put-outs/9 (3.43), range factor/game (3.33); and shares the NL lead in zone rating (1.000), outs above average (2), and defensive runs saved (3).

I'LL RACE YOU: Three Cardinals rank among the NL's top-24 in Sprint Speed (feet/second) according to Statcast with Tyler O'Neill (4th, 29.9), Harrison Bader (11th, 29.1) and Tommy Edman (24th, 28.5) leading the way. The Marlins (4) were the only other team with three or more players in the top 30 (6th-Jon Berti, T15th-Magneuris Sierra, T15th-Jazz Chisholm Jr., T15th-Lewis Brinson).

OH CANADA: In 13 games against the NL Central this season, O'Neill is slashing .341/.370/.795 (15-44) with six home runs, two doubles, 12 RBI, and a 1.165 OPS (STL is 9-4 in those games).

HOME RUN TROTS: Tyler O'Neill's team-leading average home run trot speed (18.4 seconds) and is the 4th-fastest in MLB with multiple homers, while Yadier Molina enjoys his trips around the bases the longest (25.7).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong graduated from Antioch (Ill.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (Sept. 23, 2004).

Carlos Martinez (May 3, 2013 at Miller Park) and **Ryan Helsley** (April 16, 2019 at Miller Park) made their MLB debuts vs. Milwaukee.

Mike Maddux served as Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Tyler Webb pitched for Brewers in two games in 2017...originally traded by Yankees to Brewers for 1B **Garrett Cooper** (July 13, 2017).

Kolten Wong played eight seasons (2013-20) with St. Louis and winner of two Gold Gloves (2019-20)...selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (22nd overall) of the 2011 MLB Draft.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Cardinals Director of Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB draft.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and won the 1980 Silver Slugger...traded by St. Louis with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** to Milwaukee for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate...started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his team-leading 8th start of the 2021 season (83rd career) and his first against the Brewers in 2021.
- Had a MLB-leading 6 wins and the Cardinals have won in each of his first seven starts.
- The last time St. Louis won the first seven games of a starter's season was in 2015 when Michael Wacha began his season 7-0 and the Cardinals won his first nine starts (April 11-May 24).
- St. Louis sports a 43-39 overall record in Flaherty's 82 career starts. In his first 51 starts from his MLB debut (9/1/2017) until the 2019 All-Star Break, St. Louis went 21-30 (.412). In his last 31 starts (July 16, 2019-present), St. Louis is 22-9 (.710).
- Is 3-0, 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP/2 ER) in his three starts at home this season, allowing just nine hits and one walk. Is 3-0, 4.43 ERA in his four road starts (22.1 IP/11 ER).
- Has already surpassed his IP total of 40.1 from the 2020 shortened season with 41.1.
- Leads all of MLB in run support (54) and run support per 9 IP (11.7) this season.
- In 82 career starts, is 28-7 when receiving 2+ runs of support, 22-1 when receiving 3+ runs, and 20-0 with 4+ runs of support. Has received 2 runs of support or fewer in 50 of 82 (60.9%) career starts. (see chart at right).

LAST TIME OUT

- Blanked the Rockies over 7.0 IP last Fri. (5/7) for his Major League-leading 6th win and also hit his 1st career home run.
- Cardinals improved to 7-0 in his games started with +45 run differential (66-21).

- Made his second consecutive Opening Day start (2020-21) on April 1 at Cincinnati, becoming the 5th Cardinal in history to make multiple Opening Day starts before turning age 26 (after 1901), joining Joe Magrane (3), Dizzy Dean (3), Lee Meadows (2), and Johnny Lush (2).
- Joined Chicago White Sox's Lucas Giolito and Atlanta Braves' Max Fried as Opening Day starters who graduated from Harvard-Westlake School in Los Angeles, Calif.

CAREER

- Sports the 4th-lowest career ERA (2.63) at Busch Stadium III (minimum 200.0 IP).
- Has handled 65 total chances in 68 consecutive games without an error since 6/17/18 vs. CHI when he last made a miscue in the field.
- Has struck out 524 batters over his first 83 career games, the most ever by a Cardinal and 18th-most in MLB history (since 1901).

2020 SEASON

- Had a streak of 22 consecutive regular season starts holding his opposition to three runs or less snapped at MIL (9/15), when he surrendered a career-high nine runs. The 22-game streak was the longest in Cardinals history out-distancing Bob Gibson (19) in 1968 and Lance Lynn (19) in 2014. It came up nine games short of the MLB record by a non-opener held by the Mets' Jacob deGrom (31).
- Held his opposition to three runs or less in eight of his nine starts.
- Threw a career high 43 pitches in the 1st inning at Chicago Cubs (9/4), the most by a Cardinal in the 1st inning that season and the most since Daniel Ponce de Leon hurled 41 vs. CLE (8/28).
- The Cardinals were 5-4 in his starts with three losses coming when he received zero runs of support.
