AT A GLANCE: The Yankees begin a six-game road trip today with the first game of a three-game set at Kansas City (through Wed.)... will also face the Athletics in a three-game series from Fri-Sun... went 3-3 on their rain-shortened homestand after splitting both of their series vs. Toronto (2-2) and Tampa Bay (1-1).

- ▶ Their 31-22 (.585) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best record in the Majors.
- ▶ Snapped their three-game losing streak on Sunday...are 5-10 in their last 15 games (since 5/8) after going 18-5 in their previous 23 games from 4/13-5/7...are still **23-15 in their last 38 games (since 4/13)**.
- ▶ Are in a stretch of playing 25 games in 27 days (5/1-27).
- ▶ Have won or split nine of their last 12 series (6-3-3 since 4/13) and 12 of their 17 series this season (9-5-3).
- ▶ The Yankees'+67 run differential this season is the best in the AL and tied for the third-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees snapped their three-game losing streak with a 2-0 "walk-off" win vs. Tampa Bay on Sunday, marking their third "walk-off" win of the year...**LHP Ryan Weathers** (7.0IP, 4H, 0R, 3BB, 4K) tossed 7.0 scoreless innings and did not record a decision...**RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his fourth career "walk-off" home run with a two-run shot in the ninth inning...**CF Trent Grisham** (2-for-3, 1BB) reached base three times and recorded his second straight multi-hit game...**RHP Fernando Cruz** (1.0IP, 2H, 1BB) tossed a scoreless eighth inning...**LHP Tim Hill** (1.0IP, 1H, 1BB, 2K) earned first win of the season after tossing a scoreless ninth inning.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have not allowed a run in their last 17.0 innings (since the second inning on 5/21)... have posted a 3.08 ERA (289.2IP, 99ER) and 286K in 53 starts this season...have allowed **3R-or-fewer in 45 of their 53 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 53 games of a season**, trailing only their 48 starts in 2022.

▶ **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.316), opponents' OPS (.600) and HR/9.0IP (0.71)**, rank third in ERA (3.08, second in AL), opponents' BA (.212, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.283, second in AL), WHIP (1.11, second in AL) and strikeout rate (24.3%, second in AL), sixth in strikeouts (286, third in AL) and innings pitched (289.2, fourth in AL), seventh in K/BB (2.95, fourth in AL), and ninth in BB/9.0IP (3.01, fifth in AL) and K/9.0IP (8.89, sixth in AL).

GOOD WILL WARREN: RHP Will Warren will make his 11th start of the season today at Kansas City...has gone 6-1 with a 3.61 ERA (52.1IP, 21ER) and 62K in 10 starts this season, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in eight of his starts.

- ▶ The Yankees are 8-2 in his starts...his eight team wins are tied for the fourth-most in the Majors this season.
- ▶ Since 2025, has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 30 of his 43 starts, tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors over that span.

CLOSE CALLS: Each of the Yankees' last seven games (since 5/17) and 10 of their last 14 games (since 5/9) have been decided by 2R-or-fewer.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .282/.377/.624 (48-for-170) with 36R, 10 doubles, 16HR, 33RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 48 games this season...has reached base safely in 36-of-44 starts.

- ▶ Seven of his 16HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including four of his last 5HR and five of his last 7HR.
- ▶ 26 of his 48H this season have been extra-base hits (10 doubles, 16HR).

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham reached base three times and recorded his second straight multi-hit game on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay...has hit **.583/.643/.833 (7-for-12) with 1R, 3 doubles and 2BB over his last four games (since 5/19)**.

CRUZ CONTROL: RHP Fernando Cruz tossed a scoreless eighth inning on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay...has not allowed a run in 13 of his last 14 games (since 4/25), going 2-1 with a 0.68 ERA (13.1IP, 1ER) and 17K during that stretch.

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in 21 of his 25 games this season, going 3-1 with a 2.08 ERA (21.2IP, 5ER) and 30K.
- ▶ Has stranded 16 of his 20 inherited runners this season.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. is batting .432/.488/.649 (16-for-37) with 5R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR, 5RBI, 4BB and 2SB over his last 10 games (since 5/13).

- ▶ Has recorded multiple hits in six of his last nine games (since 5/15).

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge hit his fourth career "walk-off" home run with a two-run shot to break a scoreless tie in the ninth inning on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay (also hit "walk-off" home runs on 5/10/22 vs. Toronto, 6/26/22 vs. Houston and 7/28/22 vs. Kansas City)...**marked the seventh "walk-off" home run in franchise history during the regular season that broke a scoreless tie...was the second such home run of his career**...the previous six included his own solo "walk-off" HR in the ninth inning on 7/28/22 vs. Kansas City, Alex Rodriguez's two-run "walk-off" HR in the 15th inning on 8/7/09 vs. Boston, Ruben Sierra's solo "walk-off" HR in the ninth inning on 7/22/04 vs. Toronto, Graig Nettles' two-run "walk-off" HR in the 11th inning on 6/3/81 vs. Baltimore, Reggie Jackson's two-run "walk-off" HR in the ninth inning on 9/14/77 vs. Boston and Joe Pepitone's solo "walk-off" HR in the ninth inning on 5/18/69-G2 vs. California...was the eighth such HR when including the postseason (Tommy Henrich hit a "walk-off" solo HR in the ninth inning in 1949 World Series Game 1 vs. Brooklyn).

- ▶ Marked his eighth career "walk-off" plate appearance and his sixth career "walk-off" hit...was his first "walk-off" PA since a "walk-off" sac fly on 7/10/25 vs. Seattle and his first "walk-off" hit since his "walk-off" HR on 7/28/22 vs. Kansas City.
- ▶ His home run marked his 385th career home run, tying Dwight Evans (385) for 68th place on the all-time HR list.
- ▶ Was the first Yankee to break a scoreless tie in the ninth inning-or-later with a HR since Austin Wells did so on 9/26/23 at Toronto (two-run HR in the ninth inning).
- ▶ Snapped an 0-for-15 stretch with his first-inning single.
- ▶ 25 of his 48H this season have been XBH (8 doubles, 17HR).
- ▶ 10 of his 17HR this season have given the Yankees the lead...since 2019, 146 of his 302HR have either tied the game (21) or given the Yankees the lead (125).
- ▶ Since 2019, has hit .355/.447/.760 (43-for-121) with 28R, 7 doubles, 14HR, 31RBI, 20BB and 3SB in 32 games vs. the Royals...has hit 4HR in his last seven games against Kansas City (since 4/16/25) and 12HR in his last 23 games (since 4/29/22).

MATCHING UP: The Yankees have won each of their last 10 regular season games vs. Kansas City (since 9/11/24), marking their longest winning streak vs. an opponent since 12-game winning streak vs. Boston from 9/7/19-9/19/20.

- ▶ **Including the postseason, the Yankees have won each of their last 11 games vs. the Royals (since 10/9/24) and 13 of their last 14 games (since 9/11/24)...have gone 17-3 against Kansas City since 2024 (14-2 during the regular season and 3-1 in the 2024 ALDS)**.
- ▶ Including the postseason, the Yankees are 28-6 in their last 34 games vs. Kansas City (since 8/11/21)...are also 31-7 in their last 38 games (since 6/23/21) and 36-9 in their last 45 games (since 4/19/19).
- ▶ **Have won 21 of their last 22 series vs. the Royals** (including the postseason) since 5/25/15, going 54-16 in that span...their 52-17 (.754) record vs. the Royals in the regular season since 2015 is the highest winning percentage by any team vs. an opponent in their league over that span.
- ▶ **Are 18-5 at Kauffman Stadium in their last 23 games since 5/19/18 (including the postseason)**...including the postseason, are 28-12 in their last 40 games at Kansas City since 2013.

WEATHERS REPORT: LHP Ryan Weathers tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay (4H, 3BB, 4K)...marked his second scoreless start of the season (also 0R in 7.1IP on 4/19 vs. Kansas City)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in eight of his 10 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in seven of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in five of his starts.

- ▶ Tossed at least 7.0 innings for the third time this season (also 8.0IP on 4/9 vs. the Athletics and 7.1IP on 4/19 vs. Kansas City)...prior to this year, had tossed at least 7.0IP only twice in his first 55 career starts over his first five seasons (2021-25).

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers tossed their sixth shutout of the season on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay (also 3/25 at San Francisco, 3/27 at San Francisco, 3/31 at Seattle, 4/19 vs. Kansas City and 4/21 at Boston)...have posted an AL-best 3.24 ERA this season and rank third in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (3.04) and Los Angeles-NL (3.10).

- ▶ Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in three of their last four games.

SAVED BY THE BELL: OF Cody Bellinger is hitting .314/.417/.581 (27-for-86) with 14R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 3HR, 18RBI, 16BB, 2SB and 1SF over his last 24 games (since 4/28).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP WILL WARREN (6-1, 3.61 ERA)

RHP Will Warren will make his 11th start of the season in today's series opener at Kansas City...the 26-year-old will pitch on extended five days' rest...made his 10th career start of the season on Tuesday vs. Toronto, recording his sixth win of the year (5.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 3K, 0HR)...is 6-1 with a 3.61 ERA (52.1IP, 49H, 26R/21ER, 13BB, 62K, 6HR) in 10 starts this season...**his 30 starts of 2ER-or-fewer are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors since 2025... the Yankees' 25 wins in his starts since 2025 are tied for the third-most in the AL and tied for the sixth-most in the Majors**...last season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR) in 33 starts, allowing 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of those starts...**according to Elias, his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were the second-most by a Yankees rookie in a single season**, trailing only Stan Bahnsen (25GS in 1968)...is 9-4 with a 3.66 ERA (115.2IP, 111H, 60R/47ER, 31BB, 116K, 17HR) over his last 22 starts (since 7/25/25) after going 6-8 with a 5.92 ERA (121.2IP, 129H, 83R/80ER, 57BB, 146K, 16HR) over his first 27 career games (26 starts) from 7/30/24-7/19/25...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 17 of his last 22 starts...saw his first Major League action with the Yankees in 2024, going 0-3 with a 10.32 ERA (22.2IP, 33H, 27R/26ER, 10BB, 29K, 5HR) in six games (five starts) over five stints with the club (7/30, 8/7, 8/14, 8/21-31, 9/28)...was selected by the Yankees in the eighth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeastern Louisiana University.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 10th start of the season on Tuesday vs. Toronto, recording his sixth win of the year (5.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 3K, 0HR).

2026: Is 6-1 with a 3.61 ERA (52.1IP, 49H, 26R/21ER, 13BB, 62K, 6HR) in 10 starts this season...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in eight of his 10 starts.

- ★ Has allowed 2BB-or-fewer in eight of his 10 starts this season, including 1BB-or-fewer in seven of those starts...his seven starts of 1BB-or-fewer are tied for the fifth-most in the Majors and tied for the third-most in the AL...has issued just 13BB to 220 batters faced.
- ★ IS tied for fourth in wins (six), ranks ninth in K/9.0IP (10.66, fifth in AL) and 10th in K/BB (4.77, sixth in AL) among Major League pitchers (min. 50.0IP).
- ★ Is holding right-handed batters to a .225/.273/.314 (23-for-102) slash line this season.
- ★ Has recorded at least 6K in seven of his 10 starts this season.
- ★ Recorded at least 6K in six straight starts (4/13-5/12), posting a 12.40 K/9.0IP (45K/32.2IP) over that span...marked a career long streak...was one of only three Yankees (fifth time) in the last seven years (since 2020) to record six-or-more strikeouts in at least six straight games, joining Cam Schlitler (9GS from 9/11/25-4/17/26) and Gerrit Cole (3x: 15GS from 8/8/20-G1-4/30/21, 11GS from 6/22-9/1/21 and 12GS from 6/14/22-8/15/22).
- ★ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in eight of his 10 starts this season, including six starts without allowing a HR.
- ★ The Yankees are 8-2 in his starts, tied for the fourth-most wins in a pitchers starts in the Majors (tied for fourth-most in AL).
- ★ Went 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (37.2IP, 32H, 15R/10ER, 8BB, 46K, 4HR) in his first seven starts of the season (3/28-5/1)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of those seven starts...the Yankees won six of those seven starts.
- ★ Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts this season (3/28-5/1), the most in the Majors in that span (most in the AL)...was only the seventh Yankees pitcher (eighth time) in the last 66 years (since 1961) to allow 2ER-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts of a season (excluding openers), joining Max Fried (first 11GS in 2025), Michael King (first 8GS in 2023), Gerrit Cole (2x: first 8GS in 2021 and first 7GS in 2023), Nestor Cortes (first 7GS in 2022), Michael Pineda (first 9GS in 2014) and Hideki Irabu (first 7GS in 1998).

ROAD TRIPPIN': Is making his fourth road start of the season today...is 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0IP, 5ER) and 15K in three road starts this year...the Yankees have won each of his three road starts this season.

- ★ Made his third road start of the year on 5/12 at Baltimore, recording his fifth win of the season after allowing just 2R/ER in 5.2IP (4H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR, 1WP).
- ★ Made his second road start this year on 4/24 at Houston and recorded his third win of the season after allowing just 2R/ER over 6.0IP (7H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR, 1BK, 1PO).
- ★ Is 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA (46.0IP, 15ER) and 36K over his last nine road starts (since 8/5/25).

VS. KANSAS CITY : Is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (12.2IP, 2ER) in two career starts vs. the Royals.

- ★ Made his fifth start of the season and earned his second win of the year on 4/18 vs. Kansas City after allowing only 2R/ER over 7.0 innings (5H, 0BB, 11K, 1HR, 1PO)...**his 11K tied his career high (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)**...marked his third career double-digit strikeout game (also 11K on 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 10K on 5/20/25 vs. Texas)...marked the second time in his career he has recorded at least 10K without surrendering a walk (also 11K and 0BB 6/17/25 vs. Los Angeles-AL)...no other Yankee had done so since Warren last accomplished the feat on 6/17/25...his 7.0 innings marked the second-longest start of his career (7.1IP on 5/9/25 at the Athletics)...also marked his sixth career start with 0BB and his second this season (last on 4/3 vs. Miami).
- ★ Tossed 5.2 scoreless innings (ND, 4H, 1BB, 4K) in his first career start vs. the Royals on 6/12/25 at Kauffman Stadium.

2025: In his first full Major League season, went 9-8 with a 4.44 ERA (162.1IP, 158H, 90R/80ER, 65BB, 171K, 22HR)...opponents batted .250/.320/418 (158-for-631, 22HR); LH .266/.350/436 (91-for-342, 12HR); RH .232/.283/398 (67-for-289, 10HR).

- ★ Was tied for second in the Majors in starts (33, tied for first in AL)...also ranked eighth in the AL in K/9.0IP (9.48).
- ★ Was just the third Yankees rookie to make at least 33 starts in a season, joining Stan Bahnsen (34GS in 1968), and Russ Ford (33GS in 1910)...was also the first Major League rookie to make at least 33 starts in a single season since 2009 (Nick Blackburn, 33GS with Minnesota in 2008).
- ★ Among Major League rookies, ranked first in strikeouts, starts and innings pitched, and was tied for fourth in wins (tied for third in AL).
