#### TODAY'S TILT

...the Mariners continue a 9-game road trip tonight with the last of 3 games against the Texas Rangers (1-1)...following today's finale, they will visit the Los Angeles Angels (3 G, 8/15-8/17) and later the Oakland Athletics (3 G, 8/19-8/21) on the trip...Seattle is coming off a 7-game homestand (4-3) in which they faced the Angels (2-2) and Yankees (2-1)...today's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.**

#### ODDS AND ENDS

...the Mariners dropped last night's middle game to the Rangers by a 7-4 score...despite the loss, the Mariners have won 3 of their last 4 and are 25-11 over their last 36, 28-12 over their last 40 and 33-14 over their last 47 games...Seattle is 50-13 (.794) when scoring at least 4 runs and 12-40 (.231) when scoring 3 or fewer runs this season...they are 31-26 at home and 31-27 in away games.

- **Rubber Soul** - The Mariners are 8-5 in series rubber matches this season.
- **How 'Lo' Can You Go - Logan Gilbert** is 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA (2 ER, 17.2 IP) with 1 walk and 15 strikeouts in 3 starts against Texas this season.
- **4!** - Seattle owns the 4th-best record in the American League (.539/62-53), trailing Houston (.643/74-41), New York (.632/72-42) and Toronto (.545/61-51).
- **Tough Sledding** - The Mariners have played the most difficult schedule in the Majors thus far, according to *Baseball-Reference's* Strength of Schedule (S.O.S.) metric.
- **Flex-ible - Chris Flexen** last night made his first relief appearance with Seattle (2.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 4 BB, 2 SO)...it was his first Major League relief appearance since Aug. 24, 2019 with the Mets.

#### MITCH EXTENDS HITTING STREAK TO 10

...Mitch Haniger went 1-for-4 last night and extended his hitting streak to 10 games (4/14-c), the 5th double-digit hitting streak of his career...during the streak, he is batting .417 (15x36) with 6 runs, 1 double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 4 walks...his career-high hitting streak is 17 games from Aug. 18-Sept. 5, 2018.

#### JULIO'S WORLD

...in 98 games this season, **Julio Rodríguez** is batting .273 (102x374) with 56 runs, 19 doubles, 2 triples, 18 home runs, 59 RBI, 29 walks and 21 stolen bases, getting on base at a .336 clip, slugging .479 with an .815 OPS...in his last 35 games since June 17, he is batting .297 (41x138) with 27 runs, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 10 home runs, 31 RBI and 9 walks, getting on base at a .355 clip, slugging .587 with a .942 OPS...among Major League rookies this season, the 21-year-old center fielder ranks 3rd in hits (102), 3rd in runs (56), 1st in home runs (18), 1st in RBI (59), 2nd in stolen bases (21), 1st in total bases (179), T1st in extra-base hits (39), 1st in fWAR (3.2) and 1st in wRC+ (135).

#### AGAINST TEXAS

...the Mariners have won 9 of their last 10 games against the Rangers and 6 of their last 7 at Globe Life Field...the Mariners are 12-3 (.800) in 15 games against them this season and, despite last night's 7-4 loss, have outscored the Rangers 74-53 in the 15 matchups this season...Seattle is 17-3 over its last 20 games against Texas since Aug. 11 last season.

#### REHAB UPDATE

...Matthew Boyd (left elbow strain) made his organizational debut yesterday, appearing in a Major League rehab assignment with Triple-A Tacoma...the left-hander tossed 1.0 scoreless inning of relief in game 1 of the Rainiers doubleheader at Cheney Stadium, striking out 2 batters...Boyd was acquired by Seattle, along with catcher **Curt Casali** from San Francisco in exchange for minor leaguers Michael Stryfeler (rhp) and Andy Thomas (c) on Aug. 2.

#### TOTAL TEAM EFFORT

...all 9 players in the Mariners starting lineup reached base safely last night...**Julio Rodríguez**, **Ty France**, **Mitch Haniger**, **Eugenio Suárez**, **Cal Raleigh** and **J.P. Crawford** all registered at least 1 hit, while **Jesse Winker**, **Adam Frazier** and **Sam Haggerty** each drew at least 1 walk...it was the 11th time this season that all 9 Mariners starters reached base safely and the first since June 25 at Los Angeles-AL.

#### ARM PARTY

...the Mariners bullpen is 15-3 with 19 saves and a 2.28 ERA (41 ER, 161.2 IP) with 57 walks and 175 strikeouts in 47 games since June 21, with the team going 33-14 (.702) during that stretch...Seattle relievers lead the Majors in ERA (2.28), WHIP (0.98), opponent batting average (.181/101x558) and hits-per-9 innings (5.62) in that span...they have allowed just 18.9 percent of inherited baserunners to score in that stretch, lowest in the American League and 2nd-lowest in the Majors (Cubs, 16.4%).

#### ON THE ONE

...the Mariners are 27-14 in 1-run games this season, most 1-run wins (27) in MLB, ranking ahead of the Blue Jays (23), Brewers (22) and Yankees (22)...Seattle's .659 winning percentage in 1-run contests also leads the Majors...Seattle led the Majors in 1-run wins (33) last season and have a chance to become the first team to lead the league in 1-run wins in back-to-back seasons since the Los Angeles Dodgers in 1983-84...since **Scott Servais** took over as Mariners manager in 2016, Seattle leads the Majors in 1-run wins (182), winning percentage in 1-run games (.578/182-133) and 1-run games (315).

#### KING GEORGE

...George Kirby is 4-3 with a 3.39 ERA (32 ER, 85.0 IP) with 12 walks and 86 strikeouts...his strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.17) leads the AL (min. 80 IP)...the 7.17 ratio is the highest in MLB history through a pitcher's first 16 career starts (excluding openers), surpassing Roy Oswalt (7.07) for the 2001 Astros and Masahiro Tanaka (7.06) for the 2014 Yankees...Kirby also extended his streak of 1 or less walks to 16 starts, the longest streak to begin a career in Major League history (excluding openers).

#### AS YOU MAY KNOW

...with a win today, the Mariners would capture a series victory against Texas...Seattle would improve to 12-2-1 (.833) over its last 15 series since June 21, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that it would be the Mariners best 15-series stretch since 2001?...the last time Seattle put together a series record of 12-2-1 or better over 15 series came in the final 15 regular season series of the record-breaking, 116-win 2001 campaign, when Seattle went 14-1 over its last 15 series from Aug. 14-Oct. 7, 2001...**AND FINALLY**...Seattle went 31-13 (.704) during that stretch in 2001, while the current Mariners would improve to 34-14 (.708) during their current stretch (6/21-c) with a win today.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- The 25-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 24th start this season and 4th against Texas in 2022...he will also make the 48th start of his MLB career and 7th career start against the Rangers.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Reached 200 career strikeouts on 6/14/22 vs. MIN with a strikeout of Carlos Correa.

**LAST TIME OUT...**Loss in last start on 8/8 vs. New York-AL...pitching 4.0 innings allowing 7 runs (HR) on 10 hits and 2 strikeouts.

**THIS AIN'T MY FIRST RODEO...**has a 1.02 ERA (2 ER, 17.2 IP) against the Rangers this season, the lowest of any team he's faced in 2022... allowing 15 hits, only 1 walk and 15 strikeouts in 3 games started against Texas.

**FROM WEAKNESS TO STRENGTH...**has tossed 6.0+ innings in 11 starts this season, passing his 2021 total of 6 starts of 6.0+ innings...the Mariners are 7-4 this season when Gilbert tosses at least 6.0 innings.

**QUALITY AND QUANTITY...**recorded quality starts in 7-consecutive starts from 5/17-6/19...7-consecutive quality starts is tied for the 7th-longest streak in the AL this season and tied with teammate **Robbie Ray** (longest: Framber Valdez-HOU, 19)...marks the Mariners longest quality start streak since James Paxton had 9-consecutive quality starts from 6/27-8/10/17.

**TRIPLE SEVENS...**tossed 7.0 innings in 3-consecutive starts dating from 5/17-5/28...3 consecutive starts of 7.0+ innings marks the longest streak in his career, having never done it in consecutive starts prior to the streak...first Mariner with 3-consecutive starts of 7.0+ innings since **Marco Gonzales** had 4 consecutive from 9/11-9/29/19.

**DROP AND GIVE ME NINE...**recorded 9+ strikeouts in back-to-back outings, after striking out 9 against Philadelphia on 5/11 and against Toronto on 5/17...he is the youngest pitcher in the AL to accomplish the feat this season...9 strikeouts tied a career-high which he has now done 4x, most recently 9/13/21 vs. Boston prior to the streak.

**PITCHER OF THE MONTH...**was named AL Pitcher of the Month for April, the first time he has won the award...marks the first Mariners winner since James Paxton in July, 2017 and the 14th different player to win the award (19th instance).

**PITCH PERFECT...**three of his four pitches have a negative run value this season according to *Baseball Savant*, with his four-seam fastball (-4), changeup (-2) and curveball (-3) grading out in the negatives.

**MONTH OF MARVEL...**his 0.40 ERA (1 ER, 22.1 IP) in April was the lowest ERA in a month in Mariners history, surpassing Mark Langston's 0.50 ERA (3 ER, 53.2 IP) in September 1988 (min. 20.0 IP).

**HE'S LIKE THE ROCKET, MAN...**became just the 2nd pitcher in AL history to strike out 15-or-more batters while allowing no more than 1 walk and no more than 1 earned run over his first 3 starts of the season, joining Roger Clemens (1991) via *Stats Perform*.

**2021 RECAP...**went 6-5 with a 4.68 ERA (62 ER, 119.1 IP) with 128 strikeouts and 28 walks in 24 starts during his rookie season...owned a sub-4.00 ERA in 3 of his 5 months, and a sub-3.00 ERA in 2 of his 5 months (2.79 in June, 2.70 in September).

**SHUT OUT...**W#3 in 4-0 win over the Yankees on July 8, 2021 at T-Mobile Park...struck out 8 over 7.0 scoreless innings allowing just 1 hit and 1 hit by pitch...became the 2nd-youngest pitcher in franchise history to toss 7.0 or more shutout innings while allowing 1 hit or less.

**A NIGHT TO REMEMBER...**Logan Gilbert (#28) and Jarred Kelenic (#4) made their MLB debuts on May 13, 2021 vs. Cleveland, becoming the highest ranking duo to debut in the same game since MLB.com began prospect rankings in 2011...there have only been 2 other instances where multiple top-100 prospects debuted for the same team in the same game...on July 23, 2013, outfielders Jake Marisnick (#70) and Christian Yelich (#13) both debuted for Miami...on Sept. 21, 2016, outfielders Manuel Margot (#45) and Hunter Renfroe (#92) both debuted for San Diego.

**AMONG STETSON ROYALTY...**Gilbert is 1 of 4 active Stetson University players in the Major Leagues, joining Jacob deGrom-NYM, Patrick Mazeika-NYM and Corey Kluber-TB, which places Gilbert alongside 2 Cy Young Award winners...was the first pitcher from Stetson to be taken in the 1st round, and 1st Hatters 1st-rounder since 2003 (Brian Snyder)...drafted as highest pick in Stetson history at #14...during his 3 seasons with Stetson, Gilbert was 23-3 with a 2.48 ERA... started in 33 of his 52 appearances, and pitched a total of 250.2 innings for the Hatters...ranks 1st in Stetson history for lowest opponent batting average (.201), 2nd in most strikeouts per 9 innings (11.24), 4th in most strikeouts (313), and 1st in most strikeouts looking (84)...in final season with the Hatters, he ranked 1st in the nation in fewest hits allowed per 9 innings (5.4), 2nd in total strikeouts (163), 4th in ERA (2.72), and 4th in WHIP (0.80).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP LUIS CASTILLO (5-4, 2.71)

29-year-old right-hander is making his 17th start of the season, 1st against the Angeles in 2022...ND in last start on 8/09 vs. NYY (8.0,3,0,0,2,7)...W#5 and first with the Mariners on 8/03 at NYY (6.2,5,3,3,3,8,1)...W#1 on May 25 vs. Chicago-NL (5.0,4,2,2,1,6)... was named to his second All-Star team this season...tossed a scoreless inning with 2 strikeouts at Dodger Stadium in this year's All-Star Game, presented by Mastercard, in Los Angeles... **CAREER:** Is a veteran of 6 Major League seasons with Cincinnati (2017-2022) and Seattle (2022)...made his Major League debut with Cincinnati on June 23, 2017 at Washington...threw his first career complete game on 9/11/2020 at St. Louis with the Reds...allowed just 1 runs on 2 hits and 3 walks with 6 strikeouts over 9.0 innings, earning the win for his efforts...was named the 2019 All-Star Team for the 1st time in his career after going 15-8 with the Cincinnati Reds with a 3.40 ERA (72 ER, 190.2 IP) while striking out 226 batters...signed by San Francisco as an international free agent on December of 2011...traded to Seattle on 7/29/22...vs. LAA: 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA (2 ER, 7.0 IP) with 13 strikeouts in 1 career starts against the Angels...he will be making his first start against Los Angeles-AL in 2022.
