HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 1-4 in this 8-game homestand vs. Padres (1-2), Mariners (0-2) and Rangers (Sept. 7-8).

- ◆ Tyler Gilbert is making his fifth career start...in 4 starts, is 1-1 with a 3.38 FRA (9 FR in 24.0 IP).
- ◆ David Peralta has hit safely in 10 straight starts since Aug. 19, batting .429 (15-for-35)/1.017 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 RBI and 2 walks.
- ♦ Ketel Marte has reached base via hit or walk in 22 of his last 23 games since Aug. 10, batting .319 (29-for-91)/.995 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers, 17 RBI and 8 walks.
- ♦ Nick Ahmed has hit safely in 5 of his last 6 games at a .308 clip (8-for-26).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs selected OF Henry Ramos (No. 14) from Triple-A Reno and optioned OF Stuart Fairchild to Triple-A Reno following last night's game.

♦ Ramos is making his Major League debut after.11 Minor League seasons (2010-19, '21) and 916 games (3,253 AB).

- ♦ Throwing the ceremonial first pitches are Dr. James Williams, a pediatric hematologist oncologist who serves families and treats children with blood cancer, and Mike and Krystal Medina and their son, Casey, in honor of Jacob Medina - their loving son and brother who lost his battle to cancer in March 2020.
