THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 6
2021 - On his 31st birthday, **2B Jose Altuve** hits a go-ahead, three-run homer in the 8th inning in the Astros 7-4 win over the Yankees in the Bronx...trailing 3-2 in the 8th, Altuve took **RHP Chad Green** deep to flip the game...Altuve has played in a Major League game on May 6 on 10 occasions, with this being his only career homer on his birthday.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Dodgers will play the rubber game of their three-game series today in an afternoon matinee at Daikin Park...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.**, who picked up the win in his last start on April 20 at BAL (3ER/6IP), will make his seventh start of the season today opposite **RHP Tyler Glasnow** and the Dodgers.

LMJ VS. LAD: RHP Lance McCullers Jr. is 2-0 with a 1.14 ERA (3ER/23.2IP) in four career regular season starts vs. the Dodgers, which includes a victory last season on July 4, 2025 at Dodger Stadium (1ER/6IP) in an 18-1 Astros win...McCullers also faced the Dodgers twice in the 2017 World Series, starting Game 3 (3ER/5.1IP) and Game 7 (0ER/2.1IP), both resulting in Astros victories.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY TUVE! The Astros would like to wish **2B Jose Altuve** a Happy Birthday today as he turns a spry 36 years old...Altuve shares his birthday with the late Hall of Famer **Willie Mays** and veteran reliever **Larry Andersen**, who famously netted the Astros **1B Jeff Bagwell** in a straight up trade with the Red Sox in 1990.

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise today's game in English and Spanish with the English broadcast on SCHN featuring **Todd Kalas, Geoff Blum** and **Julia Morales**...the Spanish broadcast will air on SCHN2 with **Danny Gonzalez** and **Gene Flores** on the call.

PLAYING WITH HEART: For today's game, the global healthcare company **Merck** will be on-site at Daikin Park for their in-stadium event **Playing with Heart**, a nationwide educational program about bad cholesterol and the potential risk of heart attack or stroke...in addition to a concourse activation, there will be a ceremonial first pitch and interview opportunities with their spokesman, Astros broadcaster **Geoff Blum**.

LAST NIGHT'S BIG WIN: The Astros and Dodgers played a great ballgame last night with Houston edging LA by a score of 2-1 in a crisp two hours and 15 minutes...the Astros scored their runs on a pair of early solo homers, one each by **DH Christian Walker** and **3B Braden Shewmake**...that was enough for **RHP Peter Lambert** (0ER/7IP), who dominated for 7.0 innings, tossing a career high 104 pitches...**LHP Bryan King** (1ER/2IP) picked up a 2.0-inning save, his third save of the season.

FAMILIAR FOE: After homering last night, **1B Christian Walker** has 30 career homers vs. the Dodgers (in 95 games), which are his most against any opponent...his .879 career OPS vs. LAD is the highest among any active player (min. 300 PA), while his 30 HR rank third among active players.

SHO STOPPERS: Last night, the Astros hung another loss on **RHP Shohei Ohtani**, who's now 3-7 with a 3.77 ERA (32ER/76.1IP) in 15 career starts against the Astros, which are by far his most losses against any single opponent...the Astros two homers last night were the first homers allowed on the season by Ohtani and the two earned runs allowed also were a season high for the perennial All-Star.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have recalled **IF Shay Whitcomb** from Triple A Sugar Land and have placed **IF Carlos Correa** on the 10-day IL with a left ankle tendon injury (retro to May 5)...the injury is expected to sideline Correa for the remainder of the 2026 season.

HIT PAREDES: IF Isaac Paredes has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games dating back to April 19, a span in which he's hitting .339 (19x56) with two doubles, three homers, nine RBI and a .948 OPS... additionally, he's reached base safely in 10 straight games, posting a .442 OBP in that span.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH!: Announced on Monday, **OF Yordan Alvarez** was named the AL Player of the Month for March/April for his third career AL Player of the Month Award...for the months of March and April, Alvarez batted .356 (42x118) with nine doubles, 12 home runs, 27 RBI, 21 walks, 25 runs scored and a 1.199 OPS (.462 OBP/.737 SLG).

A TRADE WORTH REVISITING: When the Astros play the Dodgers, it's always worth revisiting the trade that brought **LF Yordan Alvarez** to Houston... with the Astros teetering in and out of the 2016 playoff picture, the club moved on from reliever **RHP Josh Fields** at the trade deadline, sending him to the Dodgers straight up for Alvarez, who had just signed with the Dodgers months prior and had not played in an official game with the organization...since the trade, the Astros and Dodgers should have no remorse, as both teams have won, with Houston winning two World Series (2017, 2022) and the Dodgers three (2020, 2024-25).

VS. THE DODGERS: The Astros and Dodgers will forever be connected by the 2017 World Series, which was won by Houston in a thrilling seven games...since that 2017 season began, the Astros and Dodgers have been the two top clubs in baseball, in terms of regular season wins and playoff wins...since the 2017 World Series, the Astros are 12-10 against the Dodgers in the regular season and have won seven of the last nine games...in their last series, the Astros swept the Dodgers in a three-game set at Dodger Stadium (July 4-6, 2025), outscoring the Dodgers 29-6 in the three games.

DOWN IN THE LAND: Three Astros pitchers were on rehab assignments last night at Triple A Sugar Land as they hosted the Albuquerque Isotopes (COL)...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (arm fatigue) tossed 3.0 innings of one-run ball, **LHP Josh Hader** (left biceps tendinitis) worked 1.0 scoreless inning and **RHP Nate Pearson** (recovery from right elbow surgery) tossed 0.2 of an inning (1ER).

LAST START, 4/30 at BAL (G2): Matched his season-high with 9 strikeouts and picked up his 2nd winning decision of the year in Game 2 of the Astros' doubleheader last Thursday at BAL...worked 6.0 innings, allowing 3 runs on 2 hits and 4 walks (99 pitches-57 strikes)...also struck out 9 batters on March 30 at BOS and is 1 of 13 pitchers in the AL (and the only on the Astros) with multiple games of 9+ strikeouts this season.

VS. LAD: Has a storied and successful career vs. the Dodgers, going 2-0 with a 1.14 ERA (3ER/23.2IP), .217 opponent average, 1.14 WHIP and 9.89 SO/9IP (26 SO/23.2 IP) in 4 career regular-season starts vs. them, including 3 quality starts...last faced the Dodgers on July 5 of last season at Dodger Stadium and hurled 6.0 innings while allowing 1 run on 4 hits with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts, as the Astros notched an 18-1 blowout victory...in the Expansion Era (since 1961), his 1.14 ERA vs. LAD ranks T-5th all-time among starting pitchers (min. 20 IP)...is also the lowest ERA among all active starting pitchers vs. LAD (min. 20 IP).

GAME 7: Got the start in Game 7 of the Astros series-clinching victory of the 2017 World Series at Dodger Stadium and tossed 2.1 scoreless innings...at 24 years, 30 days old, became the youngest pitcher to start Game 7 of the World Series since **RHP John Lackey** (24 years, 4 days) in Game 7 of the 2002 World Series...recorded an RBI groundout in the game, becoming the first AL pitcher ever to collect an RBI in Game 7 of a World Series, and the first pitcher in general since **Jesse Orosco** of the Mets in 1986.

CUT ABOVE: Has thrown his cutter at a 27.4-percent rate, the highest of any of his pitches this season...per Baseball Savant, he only began to throw a cutter last season and threw it at a 4.5-percent rate.

APPROACHING 900: Enters tonight start with 894 career strikeouts and is looking to become the 15th pitcher in Astros history to record 900 strikeouts with the club...is set to make his 153rd career appearance today, and would become the 1st pitcher in Astros history to record 900 career strikeouts within their first 153 career appearances.

SEASON DEBUT: Had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes) on March 30 vs. BOS...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also tied for the longest start by an Astro this season.

2025 RECAP: Made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

GROUNDING: Is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.0 ground-ball percentage ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framber Valdez** (62.1%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (58.0%).

ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.: The 2017 All-Star has made 152 apps. (146 starts) in 9 MLB seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025-26), posting a 53-39 record with a 3.80 ERA (340ER/805.1IP) and 894 strikeouts (10.0 SO/9IP)...missed the 2019 and 2023-24 seasons due to injury.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/4 at LAD): Allowed 1 hit and struck out 3 in 1.0 scoreless inning last night vs. LAD.

FIRST W: Earned his 1st win of the season on Sunday at BOS, allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 2.0 scoreless innings...was his longest outing of the season and his 2nd multi-inning scoreless effort of the year (also: 1.1 IP on April 15 vs. COL)...marked his longest scoreless outing since 2.0 scoreless innings on June 29, 2025 vs. CHC...was also his 1st winning decision since June 26, 2025 vs. PHI.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing RHP Octavio Dotel for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 342.0 IP, with RHP Xavier Hernandez next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (468) and 7th in apps. (330).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Is 2.0 innings from matching RHP Ryan Pressly (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 4 strikeouts from matching RHP Octavio Dotel (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 330 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.89 ERA (110ER/3412P) with 468 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.32 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
