#### What a Relief!

Brewers relievers have tossed 20.0 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the sixth inning on 5/24 vs. Los Angeles-NL....it marks the team's longest run since 6/24-6/29, 2024 (20.2ip)....with a scoreless inning today, it would be the team's longest streak since 4/2-4/10, 2023 (26.1ip).

#### They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 119-66 (.643) since 2022 during Interleague Play, which marks the best record in the majors....the team has gone 17-8 (.680) against American League opponents in 2026, also the best record in the majors.

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** RHP Logan Henderson (back), LHP Jared Koenig (left elbow), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left shoulder) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Zastryzny is on the 60-day IL.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy (378g, 224-154, .593) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

**IN THE STANDINGS (65 days):** The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 27, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 4.5 games, third-place Cubs by 5.0 games and both the fourth-place Reds and fifth-place Pirates by 6.0 games.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Brewers are 12-5-1 in series play....the team is 7-1-1 over its last nine series.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 19-11 at home, going 7-3-0 in series play.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 15-9 on the road, going 5-2-1 in series play....the team is 7-1 in its last 8 road games, including a current 4-game winning streak.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 20 replay challenges this season, going 16-4....their last challenge (won) came on 5/25 vs. St. Louis as an out call at second base involving Jackson Chourio was overturned.

**BREWING SUCCESS:** The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY:** The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 797 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (890), Astros (832) and Yankees (823).

**SPROAT AT A GLANCE:** Brandon Sproat, 25, will make his 11th appearance and ninth start of the season.....Sproat last pitched last Sunday in a start vs. Los Angeles-NL and took a 5-1 loss (4ip, 4h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k, 1hbp, 1wp, 89 pitches).....the team is 5-3 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .256 (42-for-164, 9hr).....he was acquired from the Mets with INF/OF Jett Williams on January 21 for RHP Freddy Peralta and RHP Tobias Myers.....he entered 2026 as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.....Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida.

**LAST SEASON:** Sproat entered the 2025 season as the second-best prospect in the Mets organization according to *Baseball America* with his changeup rated best in the system.....he went 8-6 with a 4.24 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Syracuse.....he was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 0.67era).....Sproat was selected by the Mets on September 7 and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts.....he made his Major League debut on 9/7 at Cincinnati and carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k).

**CAREER:** Is 1-5 with a 5.51 ERA in 14 games/12 starts (65.1ip, 60h, 40r, 40er, 34bb, 65k, 9hr).....has pitched for New York-NL (2025) and Milwaukee (2026).

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 1-2 with a 6.33 ERA in 6 games/5 starts, all coming this season (27ip, 19er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 0-3 with a 5.40 ERA in 6 games/5 starts (28.1ip, 17er).....is 0-1 with a 5.09 ERA in 4 games/3 starts this season (17.2ip, 10er).

**CAREER vs. ASTROS:** Sproat has not faced Houston.

### TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI (11gs, 5-2, 1.83)

RHP Jacob Misiorowski will be making his 12th start of the season.....Misiorowski last started last Monday vs. St. Louis and earned a 5-1 victory (7ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 12k, 96 pitches).....he had a streak of 29.1 consecutive scoreless innings snapped, which marked the third-longest single season scoreless streak in franchise history behind **Teddy Higuera** (32.0 in 1987) and **Freddy Peralta** (30.0 in 2025).....he has 100 strikeouts in 64.0 innings (14.06 K/9IP).....the team is 6-5 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .152 (34-for-223, 4hr).....he has not faced Houston.
