consecutive season with double-digit homers; became the sixth center fielder in Orioles history (played at least 50% of games at CF in a season) with at least four consecutive campaigns of 10+ long balls, joining **Adam Jones** (10, 2009-18), **Brady Anderson** (5, 1996-2000), **Jackie Brandt** (5, 1960-64), **Mike Devereaux** (4, 1990-93), and **Fred Lynn** (4, 1985-

Ramón Urías collected a season-high three hits and reached base a career high-tying four times (3-1B, BB), last done on July 6, 2024 at OAK (2-1B, 2 BB).

Ryan O'Hearn became the first player in AL history and the third in MLB history to homer, walk twice, and be hit by a pitch twice, joining Pittsburgh Jung Ho Kang on September 16, 2016 at Cincinnati and Cincinnati's Devin Mesoraco on June 23, 2014 at Chicago-NL.

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 60-38 (.612), the Birds own the second-best record in MLB behind the Phillies (.633, 62-36)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 161-99 (.619), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The 0's are 244-178 (.578) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.588, 248-174), Braves (.615, 259-162), and Dodgers (.636, 269-154).

<u>HOMER HAPPY:</u> The Orioles lead MLB with 156 home runs, 16 more than the second-place Yankees (140) and 24 more than the Dodgers (132), who rank third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23,

Baltimore has eight players with at least 10 home runs, the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (28), Anthony Santander (26), Adley Rutschman (17), Jordan Westburg (16), Colton Cowser (13), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (12), and Cedric Mullins (10); the Birds have eight players to 10+ homers before the 100-game mark for the third time in team history, joining the 2000 and 1987 seasons.

Be Henderson and Santander are the only teammates in MLB this season with at least 25 home runs; this marks the third time an O's team has had multiple players with 25+ homers through the first 100 games of a season, joining Brady Anderson (31) and Rafael Palmeiro (25) in 1996, and Boog Powell (27) and Frank Robinson (25) in 1969.

The Orioles lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; Gunnar Henderson has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with Cedric Mullins (2021), trailing only Brady Anderson (12, 1996).

The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson leads MLB with 81 runs scored, the most through the first 98 team games to begin a season in Orioles history...He scored three runs on Friday for the eighth time this year, three more than any other player...His 15 such games since the start of 2023 are five more than anyone else...The O's record for runs in a season is 132, set by Roberto Alomar in

MASHED TATERS: Since the start of June, Anthony Santander is slashing .279/.328/.630 (46-for-165) with five doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 24 runs, 35 RBI, and 12 walks across 42 games...His 17 homers and 104 total bases are the most in MLB during that span, while his 23 extra-base hits are tied with teammate Gunnar Henderson and BOS' Jarren Duran for the most in the AL in that time.

①* With his first home run on Friday, Santander reached 25 home runs; he's the ninth player in 0's history to do so in at least three straight seasons, matching Frank Robinson (1969-71), Lee May (1976-78), and Manny Machado (2015-17), and trailing Eddie Murray (1982-85) and Rafael Palmeiro (1995-98), who did so in four consecutive years, Chris Davis (2012-17) and Cal Ripken, Jr. (1982-87), who had six, and Adam Jones (2011-17), who hit at least 25 homers in seven straight years.

He now has 15 multi-homer games, eighth-most in franchise history behind **Frank Robinson** (16), **Brady Anderson** (17), **Chris Davis** and **Manny Machado** (19), **Eddie Murray** and **Boog Powell** (20), and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (21); Santander is one of 40 active MLB players with at least 15 games of two or more homers; Machado, currently with San Diego, leads active players with 40 such games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip today with the final of three games in Arlington before heading to Miami for the first time since 2021...The Birds went 4-2 on their last road trip against the Mariners (2-1) and Athletics (2-1) from July 2-7...The 0's are a league-best 30-16 (.652) on the road this year and 82-45 (.646) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 during that time.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: The Orioles and Rangers finish a seven-game season series today in Texas...The O's took three out of four in Baltimore from June 27-30, but lost the series finale... Since the start of 2021, the O's are 18-7 (.720) against the Rangers during the regular season, including a perfect 6-0 in 2022...Baltimore is 279-222-1 all-time against the Rangers since the Washington Senators moved to Texas in 1972; the .557 winning percentage during that time is the best by the Orioles among current AL teams and the second-best against all teams during that time behind the .558 mark against the Brewers (min. 100 G).

**One Brids are 9-2 (.818) during the regular season at Globe Life Field since the ballpark opened in 2020, the best winning percentage by an AL team in that time.

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the 0's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the Elias Sports Bureau...At 7-7 this month, the Birds will need to go 6-5 in their final 11 games in July to extend the streak...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

ALL-STARS: Five Orioles were selected to the All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX: Corbin Burnes, Gunnar Henderson, Adley Rutschman, Anthony Santander, and Jordan Westburg...Head Athletic Trainer Brian Ebel also represented the O's on the AL staff...Burnes (4x) and Rutschman (2x) were repeat All-Stars while Henderson, Santander, and Westburg were first-timers...Burnes (P), Henderson (SS), and Rutschman (C) all started for the first time in their careers

.. Baltimore became the first AL team with at least five All-Stars, all of whom were under 30 years old at the time of the game, since New York-AL in 2017 (also 5); the Braves did

so with eight such players last year.

Burnes and Rutschman became the first pair of teammates to form the starting battery at the All-Star game since 2016, when San Francisco's Johnny Cueto (P) and Buster Posey (C) did so in San Diego, and the first for the AL since 2006, when Detroit's Kenny Rogers (P) and Iván Rodríguez (C) did so in Pittsburgh.

Santander scored the game-winning run in the fifth inning after recording a single and later scoring on a two-run homer by Boston's Jarren Duran, who earned MVP.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 13th start of the season this afternoon against **QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 13th start of the season this afternoon against the Rangers...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) prior to the game on July 3; placed on the IL on May 24 (retroactive to May 21)...Made three rehab starts with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to an 11.42 ERA (11 ER/8.2 IP) with nine strikeouts and four walks...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his 2023 campaign... The 0's went 24-8 in his starts and his career-high 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, 0F Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on July 14 vs. New York-AL after allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR), two walks, one hit batter, and four strikeouts across 4.2 innings...Has thrown 5.0 innings or less in four consecutive starts... Marked his third start since returning from the Injured List with a right triceps strain...Threw 83 pitches, 47 strikes.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: Owns a lifetime 0-1 record with a 5.17 ERA in his three prior regular season starts against Texas...Suffered the loss in his last regular season outing against the Rangers on May 27, 2023 in Baltimore, allowing three runs on five hits and two walks with five strikeouts in 6.1 innings...Faced the Rangers in Game 3 of the ALDS last season in Arlington; took the loss, allowing six runs on seven hits (2 HR) and are walk (1 IRD) in 13 in in fee. and one walk (1 IBB) in 1.2 innings.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Making his 18th career start and third of the season against the AL West...Owns a 7-1 record with a 2.84 ERA (31 ER/98.1IP) in his 17 career outings against the division...Tossed his only career complete game on September 23, 2022 vs. Houston...Is 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (2 ER/10.1 IP) against AL West foes this season; opponents are slashing .139/.205/.222 (5-for-36).

RIGHTY TIGHTY: In his last nine starts since April 19, Kremer has held right-handed hitters to a .146/.234/.220 (12-for-82) slash line with three doubles, one home run, eight walks, two hit batters, and 25 strikeouts...Has held right-handers to a .610 OPS

GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS: Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...He went 8-4 with a 5.04 ERA (51 ER/91.0 IP) and seven quality starts in his first 17 starts to open the year, allowing 105 hits (19 HR) and 24 walks with 82 strikeouts
