AROUND THE HORN

\$106,018 FOR VENEZUELA EARTHQUAKE RELIEF: The Diamondbacks Foundation will donate \$106,018 to support victims of the earthquakes in Venezuela with the generous support from this weekend's D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle supported by Avnet Cares (\$81,018) and a \$25,000 foundation donation.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs' 6-1 record since July 9 ranks third in Majors, behind the Red Sox (8-0) and Orioles (7-0)...since July 4, their 8-4 record ranks fifth in the Majors, behind the Red Sox (12-0), Orioles (8-3), Tigers (8-3) and Pirates (8-3).

- **Nolan Arenado** (1,999 hits) is 1 hit shy of becoming the 297th player all-time to reach 2,000 career hits.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 16 straight games and 35 straight starts...in his last 10 games, since July 6, has 7 multi-hit performances, batting .421 (16-for-38)/1.000 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Mitch Bratt** makes his third career start and first against an AL opponent after starting @ Cardinals (June 24) and @ Dodgers (July 12)...team is 2-0 in his 2 starts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs walked off 8-7 vs. Cardinals in 10 innings in a record-tying comeback after trailing 7-0 entering the sixth inning...scored 7 unanswered runs between the sixth, seventh and eighth innings before **Max Kepler** delivered the 10th-inning walk-off double (12th career walk-off PA).

- The D-backs' 30 comeback wins are the most in MLB, ahead of the Dodgers (29) and Brewers (29).
- In the sixth, the D-backs sent 9 batters to the plate, manufacturing 3 runs on 3 hits and 3 walks.
- In the seventh, **Geraldo Perdomo** (2 RBI) hit his first career inside-the-park home run (7) [22nd all-time by a D-back] to make it a 7-5 score.
- In the eighth, **Nolan Arenado** evened the game at 7-7 with a 2-out, 2-run homer (13)...was his 104th game-tying RBI, most among active players.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Juan Burgos** from Triple-A Reno and optioned LHP **Philip Abner** to Reno following yesterday's game.

ARENADO 1 SHY OF 2,000: **Nolan Arenado** (1,999 hits) will become the sixth active player with 2,000+ hits:

Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (July 7, 2025), Paul Goldschmidt/AZ-STL-NYY (July 26, 2024), Jose Altuve/HOU (Aug. 20, 2023), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (June 25, 2023) and Andrew McCutchen/PIT-SF-NYY-PHI-MIL-TEX (June 11, 2023).

- Will become the third player to record their 2,000th career hit while with the D-backs, joining Steve Finley (Sept. 13, 2002 vs. Brewers) and Luis Gonzalez (May 22, 2004 @ Marlins) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

CALL IT A COMEBACK: Yesterday's D-backs comeback was the first of its kind in the expansion era (since 1961), which included a 1) 7+-run comeback, 2) inside-the-park homer, 3) game-tying homer to even the deficit, and 4) a walk-off plate appearance.

- It was the second instance since 1961 that included 1) a 7+-run comeback, 2) inside-the-park homer, and 3) game-tying homer to even the deficit (sans a walk-off)...also: May 21, 1961 - Pirates won 13-11 @ Phillies after trailing 9-2 into the fifth...Don Hoak hit an inside-the-park homer in the top of the sixth that tied the game 9-9 [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

MORENO'S ON-BASE STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 35 straight starts (C: 28, DH: 7), since June 2, hitting .349 (44-for-126)/.930 OPS with 7 doubles, 3 homers, 14 RBI and 23 walks (15 K).

- Majors' longest active starts streak and second-longest this season, behind 48 starts by Nick Kurtz/ATH (April 3-May 25).
- Is the third-longest streak in club history, behind Jay Bell (39 in 1998) and Corbin Carroll (44 in 2024).

LINEUP 4-9 PRODUCTION: Since July 9, the D-backs 4-9 batters' combined .290 AVG (45-for-155) ranks second in the Majors, ahead of the Padres (.289, 43-for-149) and White Sox (.272, 41-for-151).

50+ WINS AT 100 MARK: The D-backs have reached 50+ wins in their first 100 games for a fourth straight season (also: 50 in '25, 51 in '24 and 54 in '23)...reached feat in 4+ straight seasons only one other time from 1999-2003 (54 in '99, 56 in '00, 58 in '01, 59 in '02, 54 in '03).

INTERLEAGUE: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 6 straight Interleague starts, batting .391 (9-for-23)/.875 OPS with 1 double, 2 RBI and 2 walks.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely 2+ times in 7 straight Interleague games, batting .333 (8-for-24)/.984 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 Interleague games, carrying an .889 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 3 walks.

VS. LEFTIES: **Corbin Carroll**, vs. lefties, is hitting .358 (39-for-109)/1.024 OPS with 7 doubles, 5 triples, 3 homers, 14 RBI, 13 walks and 1 sac fly.

- **Ketel Marte**, vs. lefties, is carrying a .933 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 7 homers, 21 RBI, 7 walks and 2 sac flies.
- **Ildemaro Vargas**, vs. lefties, is hitting .326 (30-for-92)/.909 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 21 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, vs. lefties, is hitting .345 (10-for-29)/.889 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 RBI and 3 walks.

THE PEN: The bullpen, in their last 7 games, has a 1.82 ERA (6 ER in 29.2 IP), opponent .152 AVG (15-for-99)/.438 OPS, 13 walks and 27 strikeouts.

- Among all bullpens this season, the D-backs rank fourth with a 26.2 inherited runners scored percentage (34-of-130) and 1.21 WHIP, seventh with 1.64 runs per game, eighth with a .679 OPS, ninth with an opponent .233 AVG and 12th with a 3.87 ERA.

VS. ATHLETICS: The D-backs have won their last 3 series vs. Athletics (2-1 @ the Coliseum in '23, 2-1 @ home in '24, 2-1 @ Sacramento in '25).

- Tossed 4.0 scoreless innings (ND, 2 H, 1 BB, 3 K) in his Triple-A debut on April 1 @ Albuquerque.
- Earned his first Triple-A win on May 23 @ Oklahoma City with 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing 3 hits and 0 walks with 5 strikeouts.
