- Corbin Carroll (OF) and Geraldo Perdomo (SS) each aim to make their second-career All-Star roster since both being named in 2023.
- Eugenio Suárez (3B) looks to make his second All-Star roster (also: 2018 with Reds)

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 10-3 last night vs. Mariners to secure their second series in their last 3.

- Corbin Carroll had his second 2+-triple game.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit his 10th homer (solo in fourth).
- Gabriel Moreno hit his fifth homer (3-run in sixth).
- Alek Thomas hit his third homer (solo in eighth).
- Brandon Pfaadt recorded his eighth win (tied for second in MLB) after allowing 2 runs in 5.0 innings.
- Bryce Jarvis recorded his first career save (3.0 IP).

FOR THE SWWWEEP: The D-backs are seeking their first-ever home series sweep vs. Mariners and second all-time (previous: July 27-29, 2015 @ Mariners).

HOME WIN STREAK: The D-backs are looking for their first home 4+-game win streak to start a month since winning 5 straight home games from June 1-12, 2018...their longest home win streak to start a month is 11 games from May 5-27, 2000.

CARROLL JOINS GEHRIG: Corbin Carroll is the fourth player in MLB history with 19+ homers and 8+ triples within the team's first 70 games of a season, joining Ival Goodman/CIN (1938, 21 HR, 8 3B), Chuck Klein/PHI (1932, 22 HR, 12 3B) and Lou Gehrig/NYY (1927, 25 HR, 8 3B).

TRIPLE THREAT: Last night, Corbin Carroll became the first D-back in franchise history to have multiple 2+-triple games in a single season (also: 2 triples on April 27 vs. Braves)...he is the first MLB player to reach the feat since 2014 (Michael Bourn/CLE) and 15th player since

- · Carroll's 8 triples lead the Majors, ahead of Jarren Duran/BOS (7) and Zach McKinstry/DET (7).
- · Carroll owns the 4 fastest home-to-third times in 2025 (10.87 sec on April 27 vs. Braves, 10.88 sec on June 10 vs. Mariners, 10.90 sec on May 19 @ Dodgers and 11.02 sec on April 27 vs. Braves).

GETTIN' RISP-Y: Since June 1 with runners in scoring position, the D-backs lead the NL in AVG (.313), OBP (.425), SLG (.641) and walks, and are tied for second in RBI (32) and homers (5).

SLUG SURGE: Since May 31, the D-backs' 19 homers rank second in the NL, behind the Mets (23), while their .470 SLG is second, behind the Mets (.504).

NL ON-BASE LEADERS SINCE JUNE 1: Since June 1, Ketel Marte's 21 times reaching base safely rank second in the NL:

1. Juan 3010/1911/1	24 times
2. Ketel Marte/AZ	21 times
2. Manny Machado/SD	20 times

23 STRAIGHT FOR MARTE: Ketel Marte's season-best 23game on-base streak, since May 13, is the third-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Jose Ramírez/CLE (36 G), Vinnie Pasquantino/KC (25 G)...it is the third longest in his career, behind his 30-gamer (April 26-June 1, 2023) and 24-gamer (June 3-July 1, 2023).

- In the span, Marte is hitting .310 (27-for-87)/1.088 OPS with 2 doubles, 9 homers, 17 RBI, 17 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches.
- Since May 13, his 1.088 OPS is fourth in MLB, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (1.238), Cal Raleigh/SEA (1.115) and Jose Ramírez/CLE (1.101).

MARTE'S JUNE BOOM: Ketel Marte ranks among all active players during their careers in June (min. 300 PA) in AVG (4th, .328) and OPS (7th, .973).

• Marte has reached base safely in 16 consecutive June games, dating back to June 23, 2024, batting .355 (21for-56)/1.254 OPS with 3 doubles, 6 homers, 16 RBI, 15 walks and 9 strikeouts.

DEFENSIVE-BACKS: Over their 7 matchups vs. Mariners since 2023, the D-backs have not committed a fielding error (excl. catcher's interference on April 28, 2024).

- · Since May 15, the D-backs are 1 of 8 teams to go errorless in the outfield (also: Orioles, Yankees, Braves, Cubs, Cardinals, Mets and Royals).
- **Alek Thomas** is 1 of 6 primary center fielders (min. 400 inn.) without an error (also: Julio Rodríguez/SEA, Trent Grisham/NYY, TJ Friedl/CIN, Michael Harris II/ATL and Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC).

ON DECK - SAN DIEGO PADRES: On Friday, the D-backs face the Padres in their first 3-game series in 2025.

- Over the last 2 seasons (2023-24), the D-backs and Padres have traded season series...the D-backs went 7-6 in 2023 and 6-7 in 2024.
- · The D-backs rank among all NL teams vs. Padres in triples (1st, 6), runs (2nd, 132), extra-base hits (2nd, 84) and homers (3rd, 32).
- Among active players vs. Padres, Ketel Marte ranks in hits (1st, 102), extra-base hits (1st, 44), home runs (T-3rd, 17) and SLG (4th, .511).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (2-2, 4.60)

- Will make his fifth start and ninth vs. Padres...last started vs. Padres on July 7, 2024 (W; 1 ER in 6.2 IP, 3 H, 5 K).
- In his first career start on Sept. 5, 2022 @ Padres, tied the D-backs record for most scoreless innings (7.0) and strikeouts (7) in a debut.

AT A GLANCE: Second season with the D-backs (10th overall in MLB; did not pitch in 2020).

- Signed a 4-year contract in December 2023 (2024-2027) with a conditional option for the fifth year.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.

2024 RECAP: Went 3-4 with a 5.04 ERA (28 ER in 50.0 IP), 19 walks and 47 strikeouts over 10 starts in his first season with the D-backs.

- Limited to a career-low 10 starts after beginning the season on the 15-day injured list (left shoulder strain) and being transferred to the 60-day on April 17...was reinstated on Aug. 6.
- Earned the win in his first start of the season and debut as a D-back on Aug. 7 @ Guardians in Game 2 of a doubleheader.
- In his first 3 bids with the D-backs, went 2-0 with a 3.94 ERA (7 ER in 16.0 IP), opponent .294 OBP, 4 walks and 11 strikeouts...the D-backs went 4-0 in his first 4 starts.
- Held lefties to a .222 average (8-for-36) with 8 strikeouts.

HOW IT STARTED: Signed by Orioles as a non-drafted free agent in 2010.

 Made his Major League debut on May 28, 2015 for the Red Sox @ Rangers...became the first pitcher in Red Sox history to pitch at least 7.2 innings and allow no runs, yield 3 hits or fewer and strikeout 7+ in a debut.
