The Mariners and Padres square off for the second time this year...the Padres swept Seattle in a 3-game series at Petco Park last month from April 14-16.

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners welcome the Padres to T-Mobile Park tonight for the 2nd of a 3-game series (0-1)...Seattle is coming off a winning road trip (4-3) against the Chicago White Sox (1-2) and Houston Astros (3-1)...Seattle will see the White Sox (3 G, 5/18-5/20) again on the homestand...today's tilt will be aired live on FOX with Aaron Goldsmith and Eric Karros on the call...the game will be broadcast live on Seattle Sports (710 AM) with Rick Rizzs and Gary Hill Jr. on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners lost yesterday's homestand opener to the Padres by a 2-0 final...overall, the Mariners are 12-9 over their last 21 games since April 22.

- **Ferrer or Foul** - LHP José A. Ferrer made his first appearance since being activated from the Paternity List last night...he ranks T-2nd in MLB with 22 appearances this season, holding a 1.71 ERA (4 ER, 21.0 IP)...teammate Eduard Bzardo is also T-2nd in MLB with 22 appearances.
- **Young and Spry** - Second baseman Cole Young's 10 defensive runs saved lead MLB infielders, tied for 3rd-most in the big leagues among all positions.
- **Brash Decisions** - Right-handed reliever Matt Brash (right lat inflammation) struck out all 3 batters he faced in his rehab outing on Thursday with Triple-A Tacoma...Brash recorded the win for the Rainiers.

SUNDAY NIGHT BASEBALL MOVED TO NBC...tomorrow's Sunday Night Baseball contest between the Mariners and Padres has been moved to NBC (simulcast on Peacock), with first pitch set for 4:20 p.m....Jason Benetti, Jake Peavy and Ryan Rowland-Smith will be on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on both ESPN Radio and Seattle Sports (710 AM) with the matchup beginning at 4:20 p.m. PT...the Mariners were on Sunday Night Baseball during the opening week of the season, beating the Guardians 8-0 in the debut of the Mariners Sunday Steelheads uniforms.

VEDDER CUP 2.0 GOES TO THE PADRES...the Padres yesterday clinched the Vedder Cup after Seattle took the season series in the inaugural Vedder Cup in 2025...as part of the annual series, the Mariners and Padres are supporting the Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB) Research Partnership, a charity co-founded by Eddie and Jill Vedder dedicated to funding research to discover treatments and cures for EB...learn more at ebresearch.org.

WALTER TIME...Logan Gilbert is coming off his best start of the season, tossing 6.0 shutout innings allowing just 1 hit with 9 strikeouts on May 10 at Chicago-AL...it marked the Mariners 4th start of 6.0+ IP and 1-or-fewer hits allowed, tied for the most in the Majors this season (also: Braves) and the 3rd such start of Logan's career...over his last 6 starts (4/12-c), he holds a 2.97 ERA (11 ER, 33.1 IP) with 7 walks and 34 strikeouts.

COOL HAND LUKE...Luke Raley is batting .265 (30x113) with 19 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 10 homers, 27 RBI and 8 walks, getting on base at a .336 clip, slugging .584 with a .920 OPS and 163 OPS+...over his last 9 games (5/4-c), Raley is hitting .333 (8x24) with 8 runs, 5 homers and 14 RBI...Raley's 7 RBI on May 8 at the White Sox marks the most RBI by a player in a game this season.

SOLID ON THE MOUND...the Mariners pitching staff has been among the best in the Majors this season, combining for a 3.58 ERA (163 ER, 409.1 IP), 114 walks and 391 strikeouts...among MLB pitching staffs they rank 1st in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.43), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.51), T-2nd in quality starts (21), 6th in ERA and 8th in WHIP (1.23)...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 263.0 innings.

THIS IS RANDY'S WORLD...over his last 9 games (5/6-c), Randy Arozarena is batting .457 (16x35) with 8 runs, 2 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI, 2 walks, 4 stolen bases and 3 hit-by-pitches, getting on base at a .525 clip, slugging .600 with a 1.125 OPS in 40 plate appearances...overall this season, the Mariners left fielder's .301 batting average ranks 7th among qualified American Leaguers.

NAYLOR LOCKED IN...over his last 23 games since April 17, Josh Naylor is batting .351 (33x94) with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI, 9 walks, 8 stolen bases, a .404 OBP while slugging .500 for a .904 OPS...during that span, he ranks 4th in the Majors in average and 4th in SB...Naylor is 27-for-29 (93.1%) in stolen base attempts since joining Seattle, ranking 2nd in stolen base percentage trailing only James Jones (93.3%) and ranking just ahead of teammate Victor Robles (92.5%) among players with at least 25 attempts in franchise history.

HOT (J)-ROD...over his last 23 contests (4/20-c), Julio Rodríguez is batting .299 (29x97) with 13 runs, 6 doubles, 6 home runs, 13 RBI, 5 walks and 2 steals, getting on base at a .333 clip, slugging .546 with a .880 OPS.

BIG TEX IS BACK...Bryce Miller made his season debut on Wednesday night in Houston, tossing 5.1 innings and allowing 2 runs (2 ER) on 8 hits (1 HR) and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts...he was activated off the Injured List prior to the game after missing the start of the season with a left oblique strain...he made 4 rehab starts between High-A Everett and Triple-A Tacoma before being reinstated, where he posted a 1.98 ERA (3 ER, 13.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Logan Gilbert enters play today with 936 career strikeouts, 2 shy of passing Mike Moore (937 SO) for 5th-most in Mariners history, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that when he moves into 5th in Mariners history, he will be 1 of 6 active pitchers to rank in their current team's top 5 all-time in strikeouts?...he is set to join Zac Gallen-ARI (3rd, 1,046), Kyle Freeland-COL (3rd, 975), Justin Verlander-DET (2nd, 2,374), Sandy Alcantara-MIA (2nd, 960) and Austin Nola-PHI (2nd, 1,922) who is the brother of current Mariners bullpen coach Austin Nola.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 16

- **1978** - Ruppert Jones tied a then ML record with 12 putouts by a center fielder in an extra-inning game, during a 4-2 loss at Detroit.
- **1989** - Ken Griffey Jr. makes his first ML pinch-hit appearance count as he hits a game winning two-run HR vs. Milwaukee.
- **1993** - Randy Johnson, trying for his second-career no-hitter, throws 8.1 innings of no-hit ball before Lance Blankenship blooms a single into right field. Johnson ends up with his third-career one-hitter.
- **1998** - Alex Rodriguez has his fifth career two-home run game in an 8-1 win at Toronto.
- **2002** - Mark McLemore ties a career-high and also ties a Mariners club record with five hits in Seattle's 15-2 win at Toronto.
- **2003** - Ichiro belts a second inning double at Comerica Park to collect his 500th career hit.
- **2022**—Eugenio Suárez belts career home run #200 in a 6-2 loss at Toronto.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 10th start of the season and 1st against the Padres...it is the 156th start of his career and 6th career start against San Diego.
Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT...in his May 10 start at Chicago-AL, threw 6.0 inning of 1-hit baseball with no walks and a season-high 9 strikeouts...threw 87 pitches and 58 strikes...marks the 2nd time in his career that he has allowed 1-or-fewer base runners over 6.0 innings (last: 8/8/23 vs. SD)...is 1-of-3 players this season to make a start with 1-or-fewer base runners allowed and 9+ strikeouts.

FACING THE PADRES...over 5 career starts against the San Diego Padres, owns a 1.69 ERA, ranking 9th in MLB among active pitchers while ranking 8th in WHIP (0.84), 16th in opponent average with .159 (18x113), and 6th in baserunners per 9 (7.59) against the Padres (min. 20.0 IP)...his 31 strikeouts against San Diego are 6th most and his 4 wins are tied for 2nd in MLB since 2022...has recorded 3 consecutive starts with 3-or-fewer runs allowed and 6+ strikeouts over 7.0 innings pitched against the Padres...is 1-of-2 AL Pitchers to have a 3+ game streak of such games (also: Félix Hernández, 2x).

HOME IS WHERE THE K IS...has recorded 7+ strikeouts in 24-of-35 home starts since the beginning of the 2024 season...his 24 games are tied for the most in MLB over this span, matching Dylan Cease-TOR/SD (24)... has thrown 7+ strikeouts in 36 home starts over his career to rank 4th in Mariners franchise history behind Randy Johnson (100), Félix Hernández (96), and Mark Langston (45)...also owns the 5th most strikeouts at home in Mariners history with 486, surpassing Mike Moore's 485 in his last start at home...ranks T-4th in strikeouts at home with 34 among the AL in 2026.

LEFTY SPLITS...ranks 6th in K/9 (11.5) against left-handed batters in MLB in 2026 and T-8th in K/BB (3.9) in the AL (min 20.0 IP)...ranks 1st in strikeouts (475), T-7th (.218) in opponent batting average, 6th in K% (27.8) and T-4th in WHIP (1.07) against lefty batters among AL pitchers since 2021 (min. 200.0 IP).

IN COMMAND...made his 45th start with 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks in his last outing at Chicago-AL on May 10...his 45 such starts lead the MLB since 2022...also in his May 10 start, allowed only 1 base runner for his 7th career start with 2-or-fewer base runners allowed over 6.0+ innings... he leads the MLB in such games since 2021.

MASTER OF THE CRAFT...among all-time starting pitchers with over 900 strikeouts, he ranks 6th in K/BB (4.9)...ranks T-7th in the AL in 2026 with a 5.2 K/BB and is tied for 7th in BB% (4.9%) with Emerson Hancock-SEA (min. 40.0 IP)...is 1-of-3 pitchers to have finished the season in the top-10 in the AL in K/BB multiple times in the last 3 seasons (23,25) alongside Bryan Woo (24,25) and Tarik Skubal (24,25).

HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...his 116 swing and misses in 2026 are the 7th most in the AL while his 2,025 career swing and misses rank 5th in MLB since 2021...owns a 43.8 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.

KEEPING COOPERSTOWN COMPANY...ranks 11th in WHIP (1.064) all-time among starting pitchers in MLB that have recorded over 900 strikeouts, trailing Hall of Famer's Walter Johnson's 1.061 and Christy Mathewson's 1.058 WHIP...his base runners allowed per 9 innings (9.86) ranks 10th among all-time starting pitchers with 900+ strikeouts (min. 100 GS), behind Walter Johnson (9.84) and just ahead of Pedro Martínez (9.94).

IN STRIKING DISTANCE...is looking to eclipse Mike Moore's 937 strikeouts with the Mariners to move from rank 6 with 936 strikeouts in Mariners history to rank 5...with a win, becomes the 7th Mariners pitcher to log 50 wins in their first 156 games with the Franchise... among these Mariners pitchers, his .561 win-loss% would be the 4th best behind Jamie Moyer (.667), Freddy García (.626), and Félix Hernández (.582).

AMONG THE GREATS...his 3.61 career ERA (353 ER, 879.1 IP) is tied with Luis Castillo for the 6th-best among starters in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and George Kirby (3.54)...his 927 career strikeouts are 6th-most in Mariners history, behind Mike Moore's 937 strikeouts...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.070), 3rd in K/9 (9.488), trailing James Paxton's 9.545 and Randy Johnson's 10.585 career K/9 mark, and 2nd in K/BB (4.853) only behind George Kirby's 6.286 (min. 500 IP).
